


Why did Trump give 11 (Not 10) Fake News Awards?

This past week President Donald Trump announced his Fake News Awards and there was a lot of anticipation in the media and of course, they tried to debunk it. And people on our side thought it was rather humorous; but Donald Trump said it was very important and I think the reason is because Donald Trump was acting in his role as a prophet! Remember, as I have said before, Donald Trump is both a king and a prophet and he is following in the footsteps of the greatest King / Prophet of all time, in our earthly realm, and that would be King David. And of course, any American, when he sees that number 11, thinks of 9/11 when we were struck by that terrorist attack; or supposed terrorist attack. Was it, in fact, an inside job? So of course, you might ask me, I can see the 11, where is the 9 part of 9/11? Well, let's look at that date:



he announced these awards on Wednesday, January the 17th, and he had been threatening to do it, I guess you could say, for quite a few weeks ahead of time. But he chose that date on purpose. So, what is the

significance of those integers? Well January the 17th, if you add those up you get 1 plus 1 plus 7 is 9. And 2018: if you add those integers up, 2 plus 1 plus 8 you get 11: 9/11. Now, that's not accidental. Donald Trump chose that date on purpose and I think he had two reasons: I think number one, the fake news media was involved in covering up the facts about 9/11; and I think it's possible, remember this is a prophecy from Donald Trump, that he is going to ask for a reopening of the 9/11 Commission; and thousands of architects and engineers have been petitioning Congress to reopen the 9/11 Commission; and it's very possible that Donald Trump, in his role as a prophet, is asking us in the country, through his 11 Fake News Awards to reconsider the 9/11 tragedy.

And 11 is also very important in Bible prophecy, and that's because the number 11 is broken down into 6 plus 5.
