

Billions of Martyrs

In the next eight years, there will be billions and billions of people who will die on planet earth before Armageddon, in the year 2017. In fact Jesus says, that unless I do return, there will be no flesh left on earth. Now many of these billions of victims will be innocent. That is they will be classified as martyrs, and they will go to heaven, and some of these will return with Jesus at Armageddon. So the question is, if you are a victim, in these next eight years, will you be innocent? that is, will you be martyred and go to heaven? and secondly, if you are martyred, will you also return with Jesus when he returns at the battle of Armageddon?

Now in order to discover what the future may have in store for you, we need to look at the three different categories of martyrs as described in Saint John's book of Revelation. Let's take a look at Saint John's secret cryptogram. As you know, Saint John divided up the 15 End Time chapters of the book of Revelation, that is chapter 6 through 20 into 36 sub-sections, and following each of the four horsemen are nine of those sections. And the first section, that is following the White Horse of Apostasy, practically all of these events have already occurred.

For example, the first trumpet has sounded, which announced Henry the Eighth. Over here we had the First Bowl, which refers to the martyrs of Adolf Hitler. Following him came the Fifth Bowl and the martyrs of Communism, and now we are up to the last event following the White Horse of Apostasy; that is the fifth Herald Angel. And the martyrs in this section refer to mainly the martyrs of abortion in America, and in most of the countries of the world, and also Christian martyrs in countries such as China and in the Muslim countries of Africa. All of these martyrs can be found described in chapter 6. These are the martyrs of the apostasy.

In chapter 6, verse 9, 'and when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held.' Now these martyrs are not necessarily Christian, because if they are innocent, they symbolize Jesus. In verse 10, 'and they cried with a loud voice saying: How long O Lord holy and true do you not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on earth. Notice these are not like the early Christian martyrs, who prayed for forgiveness of their enemies, because they ask for vengeance, and we know they are martyrs because 'white robes were given to each one of them'.

The nine events on Saint John's cryptogram which follow the Red Horse of War, primarily deal with World War 3. For example, we find the huge army, the two hundred million man army, which cross the river Euphrates. Over here we find Babylon 'is fallen, is fallen'. This refers to the two nations which will fall in World War 3, primarily England and the United States. Saint John describes several more events in World War 3, 'the drying up of the of the Euphrates River to make way for the kings of the east, and again the sixth Herald Angel announces the fall of Babylon.

Following the world war of course, we come to the black horse of famine, and in chapter number 7, after Saint John describes that twelve tribes of Israel, who will be sealed by the prophet Elijah, he then lists the martyrs of this great war. Chapter 7 verse 9, 'After this I saw a great multitude which no man could number of all nations, kindred, peoples and tongues stood before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes and palms in their hands.'

Now Saint John has already described a two hundred million man army, therefore this great multitude which no man could number must be even greater than hundreds of millions. Undoubtedly he is talking about billions of people. They are from all nations, kindred, peoples and tongues. That means they are not just Christians, and because they are clothed with white robes and palms, that means they are martyrs and they are in heaven. 'And they cried with a loud voice saying: salvation to our God which sits on the throne and to the Lamb.

Now they are praising Jesus, so even though they come from every kindred people nation and tongue, when they get they get to Heaven, they of course acknowledge that Jesus is the Son of God. Following the Red Horse of War, comes the Black Horse of famine, and we find, after Saint John lists the martyrs of World War 3, comes the appearance of Wormwood, who is the False Prophet. At the same time, God sends the two prophets Enoch and Elijah back to earth.

God finds it necessary to send the two prophets, because two of the barriers to the Antichrist, that is the United States and the Roman Catholic church have been destroyed. After the last two barriers to the Antichrist, that is the prophets Enoch and Elijah are assassinated, finally the Antichrist, the beast from the sea comes on the scene. And it's only then that we discover the last martyrs of the book of Revelation in chapter 14. Chapter 14 verse 13, 'and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, write blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from

henceforth: yea said the spirit that they may rest from their labors; and their works to follow them.' Now this is the first time Saint John has used 'blessed' to describe these martyrs. 'Blessed' indicates that these are one of the three groups who will fight with Jesus at Armageddon.

Notice that Saint John says, 'from henceforth'. In other words, the martyrs who came before this, do not qualify to return for the Millennium. But from henceforth, in other words during the reign of the Antichrist, these martyrs will return with Jesus. These blessed martyrs are one of the three groups who will reign with Jesus. A second group are the Protected Catholics. Blessed is he that watches and keeps his garments. This group must watch in the desert for the Antichrist, and the Antichrist's agents.

The third group are the Raptured Protestants. 'Blessed are they who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb'. Thus we see from Saint John's cryptogram that of the billions and billions of people who will die during the next eight years, only a tiny fraction, and that is about 144,000 will return with Jesus at the battle of Armageddon. In chapter 17 verse 14, Saint John describes the three groups who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium. 'These shall war against the Lamb'. Now he's talking about the forces of Antichrist. 'And the Lamb shall overcome them, for He is the Lord of lords and the King of kings: and they that are with him', that is with Jesus at the battle of Armageddon. 'are called chosen and faithful'. This is not just one group. The 'called' are the Raptured Protestants. The 'chosen' or elect refer to the Protected Catholics, and the 'faithful' are the Holy Martyrs which we have been discussing.

Now in Matthew's Olivet Discourse, Jesus talks about these same three groups. 'And he shall send his angels with a great sound of trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect', those are the Protected Catholics, 'from the four winds', that means from on earth, from one end of heaven. Those in one end of heaven are the Raptured Protestants, to the other end of heaven. Those in the other end of heaven are these martyrs of the Antichrist who we have been talking about. Thus we see from Saint John's cryptogram, that only those martyrs, during the reign of the Antichrist, will return and reign during the Millennium. That's what Saint John means by 'henceforth' and you understand what henceforth refers to, when you understand the true chronology of these End Times. The three groups that we have mentioned, the Protected Catholics, the Raptured Protestants and the Holy Martyrs, these are the three groups who will reign with Jesus, when he returns on Mount Sion for Armageddon.
