

Father Alar is Wrong about the End Times, Jews and a Third Temple Pt 2

Welcome to Revelation Unraveled. I'm your host William Tapley and this is the second program in a series I am doing in response to Father Chris Alar, who makes an awful lot of mistakes in his interpretation of the End Times, but his biggest mistake is that he claims to be speaking for the Catholic Church, and that is a huge error.

In the last program I did, he claimed there was no Rapture, and that is false, and there is no Church document. And I asked you my people, please show me one mystic or prophet or saint or pope who has said that there is no Rapture or is there any Church document or any catechism or any apparition of Mary in which she says there is no Rapture, and there are none. So he is not preaching for the church. He is talking for himself alone. He is giving false information. He is no better than any of the other false prophets on YouTube. He also says there's no Millennium, and of course John talks about the Millennium eight times in the Book of Revelation.

So now onto this program, he says that one of the signs of our Lord's second coming, as I mentioned in the last program our Lord actually comes three times in the second half of what I call the football game, three touchdowns; he says that before His second coming the Jews will be converted, and that is another huge error. The conversion of the Jews does not come until our Lord's second coming, so the conversion of the Jews is not a sign of the coming. It is part of the second coming. So Father Alar let's hear what you have to say.

Father Alar: “The universal conversion of the Jews to Jesus and the Catholic Church is amazing. Conversion of all Israelite peoples is Biblical. It's in Romans 11 verse 25.”

So let's read Romans chapter 11, verse 25. **“For I would not have you ignorant, brethren, of the mystery, (lest you should be wise in your own conceits), that blindness in part has happened in Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles should come in.”**

So when does this “fullness of the Gentiles” come in? This does not happen until the very end also. So you can't say the Jews have got to be converted before our Lord's second coming. Saint Paul says it doesn't happen until the fullness of the Gentiles. Let's read verse 26.

Romans 11:26 **“And so all Israel should be saved, as it is written: there shall come out of Sion, he that shall deliver, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob.”**

This is a clear reference of our Lord returning at Armageddon. This is when the Jews are converted. In the Book of Revelation we know that Jesus returns on mount Zion for Armageddon. So the Jews will be converted, but not until at the end of the second coming, as if it's a process, which I believe it is. And this is also

found where the two witnesses, Enoch and Elijah seal the Jews, 144,000 of the remnant of Israel. They do not convert the Jews. Please make that distinction. They seal the Jews. As I say, they are not saved until Jesus returns.

Now Father Alar also makes the false claim that there will be a third temple rebuilt in Jerusalem. This is another huge error. He adopts this from the Protestants. Now the Protestants are right about the Rapture and the Millennium, and Father Alar claims that because they're Protestant, that's their faults, but now he adopts the Protestant view, which is false, and that is that there must be a third temple rebuilt. Go ahead Father.

Father Alar: “And the temple will be built, even though Christ said this temple will be destroyed in the true temple of his body. That's what we've had for 2,000 years. That temple will be built because the Bible tells us that the Antichrist will be seated there. That's Second Corinthians. He will be worshipped in the temple. This is the Antichrist who's yet to come, but he will be worshiped in the temple as the Jewish Messiah.”

No, the temple will not be rebuilt, and I don't think he means Second Corinthians. I think he means Second Thessalonians. Let's read what Saint Paul says in Second Thessalonians chapter 2 verse number 4.

2 Thess 2:4 “Who opposes, and is lifted up above all that is called God, or that is worshipped, so that he” (that is the Antichrist) “sits in the temple of God, showing himself as if he were God.”

So Father Alar claims that since the temple must come before the Antichrist, it would be a sign of our Lord's second coming, but the temple which the Antichrist sets himself up in, is not a Jewish temple, it is the Roman Catholic Church. That's what the Antichrist sets himself up in, and of course Father Alar will never tell you that. He will never quote from La Salette where Mary said Rome will lose the faith, and become the seat of the Antichrist, and I can prove to you that this temple of God is the Roman Catholic Church. To do that, let's look at where this temple is found in the Book of Revelation chapter number 11 verse number 1.

Rev 11:1 “And there was given me a reed like unto a rod, and it was said to me: Arise, and measure the temple of God”; this is the same temple of God, “and the altar and them that adore therein.”

Rev 11:2 “But the court, which is without the temple, cast out, and measure it not: because it is given unto the Gentiles, and the holy city they shall tread under foot two and forty months.”

Now I admit most Bible scholars believe the holy city is Jerusalem. They are mistaken. The holy city in the End Times is Rome, because it is the home of the Roman Catholic Church. And as I say this temple, which John is told to measure, is the Catholic Church, but you're not supposed to measure the courtyard outside because it is given to the Gentiles, and we know that just about all of the public facilities of the Roman Catholic Church have apostatized, for example all

educational institutions. Notre Dame for example is no longer Catholic or any seminary or just about any diocese, most of the bishops and of course Pope Francis. They have apostatized. As I say, Rome has become the seat of the Antichrist or very soon will. It is right now the seat of the False Prophet.

So how do we know that the holy city is Rome? Well a few verses later, John describes the great city and it is not Rome. If at John's time, the holy city was Jerusalem, the great city was Rome. Those rules are completely reversed in the End Times. Let's look at verse number 7.

Rev 11:7 **“And when they shall have finished their testimony,”** this is the two witnesses Enoch and Elijah, **“the beast that ascends out of the abyss,”** this is the Scarlet Beast, also we know it as the Deep State, **“shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.”** ; the two witnesses, Enoch and Elijah.

Rev 11:8 **“And their bodies shall lie in the streets of the great city”**, this is not Rome, **“which is called spiritually, Sodom and Egypt, where their Lord also was crucified.”**

So John is clearly indicating Jerusalem here, and by extension Israel, and Israel is great in these End Times. A lot of people consider them the center for finances in the world. In any event, John has juxtaposed Rome and Jerusalem. The great city in John's time was Rome. The holy city was Jerusalem. In the End Times, it's just the opposite. Rome is the holy city and Jerusalem is the great city. Therefore the temple of God is in Rome, and that is where the Antichrist will set himself up.

And this is also verified in Zechariah chapter 12, and not necessarily about the temple, but about the Jews converting before the second coming. And he says that the Jews will convert when they see him who they have pierced, chapter 12 verse number 10.

So you see, Father Alar is not relying on a true interpretation of scripture, and he ought to check with me. I have done many programs explaining that the temple which the Antichrist sets himself up in is the Roman Catholic Church, and he never by the way, in his whole series, which has gotten like 300,000 views, he never mentions the False Prophet. The False Prophet is just as important as the Antichrist. In any event, I wanted to correct the situation and my video will probably only get about a thousand views and he's getting hundreds and hundreds of thousands of views, but what's new. I mean he feeds you pillows and cushions, saying you don't have to worry about the second coming of our Lord until the Jews are converted. That's false. You don't have to think about our Lord's second coming until a third temple is built. That is also false. Our Lord can come at any time. Are you prepared? Don't listen to Father Alar. He has joined the false prophets. He is deceiving you. He is part of the great deception of these End Times.
