Mary's School of Prophecy Kim Clement Prophecy - Mary Will Save America - Pt 1

Today's class refers to Volume 4 pages 100 and 300. Let's go through this program and that is Kim Clement's prophecy that Mary is going to save America, and he talks about the U.S. being saved by a beautiful woman, and what's interesting is that he does not say Jesus is going to save America. He does not say the Church is going to save America and remember this is a Protestant prophet. Now he doesn't call her Mary, he calls her a beautiful woman, but even then, even if you don't recognize this is Mary, that's who it is. It's still surprising that nobody has picked up on the fact that he did not say that Jesus will save America, or that the Church will save America, but rather this beautiful woman, and I think I can show pretty clearly that the beautiful woman can only be Mary.

Now when I first became acquainted with this prophecy, and remember this prophecy was given March 25th 2011, and of course that's the Feast of the Annunciation; Kim Clement did not understand this; at least he never mentioned it before or after, and none of the people who are continuing his websites, none of them understand it either, but it's very significant. So what I did when I first found out about this prophecy is that I know Tomasio Venditti on YouTube did a video on it and I put a link to that video under my original video. Then I went to Kim Clement's website and there are transcripts of all of his videos there, and I looked at the transcript and I realized that it could be apocalyptic literature and I will show you the first part of his prophecy, as taken off the website, and I'll show you why I was alerted immediately that it was apocalyptic literature.

Now before we start we should say the prayer. Our Lady of All Nations has become our guide. We always pray to her to begin this program, so let's say the prayer to Our Lady of All Nations. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations, that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary, be our Advocate, Amen.

So I was looking at the prophecy and I began to realize that it could very well be apocalyptic literature and here's why; because he puts four or five very important time markers in the prophecy. I should say the Holy Spirit does. I think the Holy Spirit guided Kim Clement, but the time markers are out of chronological order. So let me give you an example of what I mean by that, and this is the very first part of his prophecy.

I divided his prophecy up into chapters and verses and I got three chapters and 15 verses, and of course that is a reference to Genesis 3:15 which is about Mary crushing the serpent. Now some people might disagree with my division into three chapters or into 15 verses, but I challenge anyone to come up with a better system. I think it's exactly the way it's supposed to be. And the first chapter is about Donald Trump and the United States. The second chapter is an introduction to Mary, the beautiful woman, and the third is that the people will accept Mary or at least we have to accept her. Kim Clement challenges us to accept Mary. So let's look at this chronology again.

- 2 And then in the **middle of the restoration** of America rapidly because of a source of energy that shall come, quickly, because of medical breakthroughs, and because of agreements between nations, specifically China.
- 3 God said, they shall say, 'we never dreamed this would happen. They said that this in Japan would never happen'.
- 4 God says, listen to me. At the **beginning of the restoration**, as it begins, there shall be a woman that shall rise up. A woman that shall be strong in faith; virtuous. Beautiful in eyes and her eyes shall be so beautiful. Her eyes shall be round and big.

If you look at this first verse, this is chapter 1, "There is a president who will come", and of course that's Donald Trump, but now look at verse number 2, "in the middle of the restoration", and then look at verse 4, "at the beginning of the restoration". So those are very notable time markers, but as you can see, verse 4 should be ahead of verse 2, so that told me right away that the chronology, just like in most apocalyptic literature has to be rearranged. The verses and the chapters have to be rearranged in order to understand the chronology. And what I did was I took those 15 verses and I rearranged them. I didn't arrange them according to any particular pattern. Now with Daniel they're always arranged by a pattern, and so in the same way with Zachariah and Ezekiel. There may be a pattern here but if there is I haven't discovered it yet.

I just took the five chapters that had to do with the United States or Donald Trump and put them first, then the five verses that were an introduction to Mary, I put them next, and finally the five verses that had to do with Mary being accepted. So let's look at the first verse which has to do with President Donald Trump. We just looked at the first verse, and you'll see that these verses are not in correct order.

The first verse is, "There is a president who will come." That is the first time marker and he came in 2016 and 2017 and Donald Trump was elected in November 2016, and he took office in January 2017. "And God says he will have absolutely no fear, absolutely no fear. Will be decisive, make decisions." So that's an amazing prophecy right off the bat. Obviously this is Donald Trump. I can't think of anyone else who fits that bill, certainly not Hillary would, even if she had won, so I think that indicates that the rest of the prophecy is true also about Mary saving America.

So let's look at the next verse. Now as I say, I rearranged these verses, and I rearranged them simply the way they seemed to make more sense.

A PRESIDENT WILL COME

1 There is a president who will come (2016-17). And God says he will have absolutely no fear, absolutely no fear. Will be decisive, make decisions.

11 For I chose this nation before it was founded, before anybody came here, I chose this entire nation - all 50 states, every one of them, to send my gospel to the entire earth. Do you think I have changed my mind?

So the next one is verse number 11: "For I chose this nation before it was founded, before anybody came here, I chose this entire nation - all 50 states, every one of them, to send my gospel to the entire earth. Do you think I have changed my mind?"

And of course when Kim Clement gives this prophecy, he's always much more animated than I am. I mean it's very interesting to hear him give a prophecy. Now if you read this again, notice that there are four different ways of expressing the United States, and this is typical of apocalyptic literature is to give more than one expression, and of course 4 is an End Times number. The most important number here is the number 50. So let's look at that again.

"For I chose this nation", that's the first one, "before anybody came here, I chose this entire nation", that's a second description. "All 50 states", the third description, "every one of them", the fourth description, and of course the number 50, as far as you and I know, refers to the 50 Hail Mary's in a complete five decade Rosary. It's the same as the 50 cubits which was the height of the scaffold in the Book of Esther, where King Ahasuerus hangs Haman who prefigures the Antichrist. It's the same 50. In fact I think that's why we have 50 states. We have 50 states and three Protectorates, and that symbolizes the additional three Hail Mary's in a complete five decade Rosary. So now let's look at the next verses about President Trump and about the United States.

Verse number 10: "Where they have said, 'we will make history without God.' No you will not, no you will not, says the Lord." Well, making history without God, that's exactly what man is trying to do now, and under the Antichrist, he is the epitome of man ruling mankind, man ruling other men, and that's what World War 3 is about. We've been talking about World War 3 on here and God says you will not succeed in these plans.

Verse number 3: "God said, they shall say, 'we never dreamed this would happen. They said that this in Japan would never happen."

- 10 Where they have said, 'we will make history without God.' No you will not. No you will not, says the Lord.
- 3 God said, they shall say, 'we never dreamed this would happen. They said that this in Japan would never happen'.
- 12 Therefore, the healing that is necessary for this nation shall come at a time in the middle of the presidency (2020-21).

So, what happened in Japan that did not happen anywhere else in the world? The only thing I can think of is the atomic bomb was dropped on Japan; two atomic bombs, and nowhere else. I'm sure that this is a hint from Kim Clement that America will be involved in nuclear warfare. Let me read that again now that we all understand what I think he's talking about.

God will say, "they shall say, we never dreamed this would happen", in other words nuclear war. "They said that this in Japan would never happen." So the same thing will happen to America that has happened to Japan. I believe that is what Kim Clement is prophesying about.

So now let's read the last of those verses, verse number 12. 'Therefore the healing that is necessary for this nation shall come at a time in the middle of the presidency." So notice this middle of the presidency is the next time marker in this section, and this first chapter, and I said this year, 2020 or 2021 and that's because the middle of his presidency if he is re-elected, which certainly looks like it now, he would have an eight-year presidency, and the midway point would be after November, when he is re-elected or in January when he takes his oath of office. That would be the midpoint somewhere in there.

Let me see what he says, "Therefore the healing that is necessary for this nation shall come at a time in the middle of the presidency." So what are we going to be healed from? The bad things, the nuclear war that he just spoke about must come before this midpoint, in other words, before November this year. Now we have to understand of course that Jesus can shorten the days, but as I understand this prophecy, it sure looks like the healing begins in the middle part of his presidency, but you could also say that next February, March or June or maybe even into the next year would be the mid part of his presidency. Prophetic times are not exact, so it's possible that nuclear war begins next year, maybe in the spring of next year, but it shows that we're very near.

So now let's look at chapter 2, which is about the beautiful woman, and that verse number is "God says, listen to me." And I call this chapter by the way, "A woman shall rise up", and I take all these titles from the prophecy. He did not put these titles in, but I take the titles from the prophecy itself.

A WOMAN SHALL RISE UP

4 God says, listen to me. At the beginning of the restoration (2020-21), as it begins, there shall be a woman that shall rise up. A woman that shall be strong in faith; virtuous. Beautiful in eyes and her eyes shall be so beautiful. Her eyes shall be round and big.

13 There shall be a woman that shall come and God said there shall be oil that shall be poured upon the nation and they shall suddenly feel the healing and they shall say, 'it is well with my soul, it is well with our soul.'

"God says, listen to me. At the beginning of the restoration"; now the beginning of the restoration would be the same as what we just heard, in other words at the midpoint of his presidency. And, "as it begins, there shall be a woman that shall rise up. A woman that shall be strong in faith; virtuous. Beautiful in eyes and her eyes shall be so beautiful. Her eyes shall be round and big."

When I did my video on this, I talked about Our Lady of Guadalupe, that image showing Mary with large round eyes. In fact it took me a while to realize it that Our Lady of Guadalupe could be the woman he's talking about, or it could be Our Lady of America which is the statue in Washington that the bishops are supposed to bring into the National Cathedral, and they're dragging their feet. Either one, but I do think it will be a specific image. Now here's Donald Trump holding a statue of Mary and I've showed this many, many times.



I believe that's Our Lady of Fatima. Maybe Our Lady of Fatima will be our manifestation. I wouldn't be surprised if Mary appears to Donald Trump. She appeared to our first president George Washington. Maybe she will appear to our last president.

Verse 13: "There shall be a woman that shall come and God said there shall be oil that shall be poured upon the nation and they shall suddenly feel the healing and they shall say, 'it is well with my soul, it is well with our soul."

Now what is meant by Mary coming and Mary rising up? Is this the same prophecy? Are there two different manifestations or is this the same thing? Let me read those again because I'm not too clear on this myself. Verse number 4: "as it begins, there shall be a woman that shall rise up", and verse number 13, "There shall be a woman that shall come", so, he's probably speaking both about Mary, but what do you suppose Kim Clement means by that, "a woman that

shall rise up"? Will everyone see Mary? I know a lot of other people say that, "well no. this is someone like I Melania Trump", and we'll see later on that that can't be. For one thing Kim Clement said that the Protestants will say, "Before we hated her, but now we love her", and I can't think of anyone who fits that description better than the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Verse number 6: "For she shall have the oil of gladness for the pain and the mourning that has taken place, and she shall pour out the oil on this nation."

So we're getting the chronology here. It's becoming clearer and clearer. The nuclear war that he suggested previously, that has got to be the pain and mourning that he's talking about here. "And she shall pour out the oil on this nation. For the soul of America has been corrupted; the soul of this nation has been corrupted with bitterness and anger. And God said she shall say, 'no more bitterness, no more anger, no more division."

And it's interesting when Kim comment quotes this from the woman, from Mary he is very forceful when he says it. It's like Mary is giving a command towards children. Stop this fighting. I think that's what she's saying. No more bitterness, no more anger, no more division. We have tremendous division right now in this country, as we can see with us idiotic impeachment going on.

So let me continue though. I think we're at the last section here, verse 8: "Cartels shall be afraid of a woman - a woman anointed by God; a woman set aside. And God says, they will say, 'before we hated her, but now we love her."

And I think cartels in this case, refers to any evil organization that would oppose Christianity, for example. I would say the Southern Poverty Law Center would be a cartel for example or any organization like that or the American Civil Liberties Union, there is a good example. I would call those cartels in this definition. Okay I think we can stop right there and we'll go through the rest of this tomorrow, and I'm following pretty much what's in volume 4 page 300, but I think I will look at page 100 also.
