

Pope Francis Concludes Bishop's Synod

Today is Tuesday, October the 21st, 2014 and this past weekend, Pope Francis concluded his Synod of Bishops in the Vatican. However, as I have been saying for the last 6 months, you must discount everything that comes out of the Vatican because Rome, the holy city in Revelation 11: 2, is being trampled under by the Gentiles; and the Gentiles in this case simply refers to those who are unfaithful to our Lord, Jesus Christ.

However, I can report two items of good news. Pope Francis did not achieve his total agenda. First of all, the bishops did not vote to accept homosexuality nor did they vote to give the Holy Eucharist to divorced and re-married Catholics. The bad news is Pope Francis is only going to consider that a temporary setback. I am very sure that once the smoke settles, he is going to implement those two agendas and I think you will find that he will allow bishops to accept homosexuality in their dioceses and allow divorced and re-married Catholics to receive Holy Communion.

The most important of these two objectives is the second in which people who are living in mortal sin will be allowed to receive the Eucharist. This is Satan's real objective. The homosexuality issue was primarily a smokescreen. Of course the news media were far more interested in promoting their gay agenda but, Bible Prophecy says that taking the Daily Sacrifice away from the Prince is what concerns Jesus Christ much more and that is the reason He says that the Great Tribulation will be the worst time in the entire history of mankind.

On this program I want to explain how giving Holy Communion to people living in mortal sin, if that becomes the official policy of the Church, will result in the Abomination of Desolation as prophesied by Daniel and warned about by our Lord in the Olivet Discourse. The taking away of the Daily Sacrifice from the Prince does not refer to ritual animal sacrifice in some kind of rebuilt Jewish temple in Jerusalem as the false prophets like to loudly proclaim. The temple which the Antichrist sets himself up in, in the End Times, is the Roman Catholic Church.

For many years, in fact, ever since I was a youth, I assumed the taking away the Daily Sacrifice would simply be some kind of law passed by the civil authorities: they would simply close the churches. We now

see, however, that it is the bishops who are closing the churches and I believe it is also the bishops who will take the Daily Sacrifice away from the people and this is how it will be done. If the intention of the priest, who is consecrating the Body and Blood of our Lord out of bread and wine, is to give that Communion to people living in mortal sin, at the direction of his bishop, our Lord will not enter into the sacred species: He will not honor that consecration.

As you know, there are three requirements for a valid consecration. You must meet the requirements Jesus Christ Himself established. First, you must use the same matter that He did. You must use wine and unleavened bread. As I've said many times, a priest cannot consecrate strawberry shortcake, for example. Secondly, you must use the same words that Jesus did. You cannot say, *'this might be my body'* or *'this could be my blood'*. And thirdly, you must have the same intention as Jesus. You must intend to consecrate his Body and Blood and you cannot intend to give the Eucharist to someone living in mortal sin.

And I have explained on this program before, Jesus did not give the Eucharist to the traitor, Judas. In fact, he specifically sent Judas away from the Lord's table before He consecrated His Body and Blood. It's interesting to note that those three requirements of the priest also reflect the Divine Trinity. In other words, the matter, the bread and wine, reflect God the Father. The words reflect the Word Himself, that is Jesus Christ. And the intention of the priest reflects the Holy Spirit. That's why it is much more mysterious, much more difficult to pin down.

In other words, it would be quite obvious if the Pope or the Bishops changed the matter. Even now, there are reports of priests changing the matter and not using unleavened bread, for example. That would be very obvious to the lay people in attendance at Mass. Secondly, changing the words would be quite obvious: everyone could hear what the priest is saying. But the intention of the priest is much more secretive, much more mysterious. How can we know what the priest's real intention is? I suspect there are instances today where a priest may not intend to consecrate the Body and Blood of our Lord. He may be in apostasy or he may have doubts. I believe in those instances, our Lord still honors the consecration because there is no way for the lay people in attendance to know what the priest's hidden intentions are (1).

But, thirdly, what if the Church publicly announces what the priests' intentions will be? What if Pope Francis were to say, for example, that it will be up to local bishops to determine if they will allow divorced and re-married Catholics to receive the sacraments? In that case, we would know the priest's intention. We would know they are intending to give Communion to well, for example, politicians who support legalized abortion. In my own state, that would be Governor Andrew Cuomo. He is also living openly with his mistress in the governor's mansion. This would include, as I said before, divorced and re-married Catholics. They could receive Communion and our Lord specifically said, **'any man who leaves his wife and marries another commits adultery'**.

And what would the Pope do about previous excommunications? For example, let's go back to Henry VIII. King Henry wanted to marry six different women. He wanted to behead his wives. Is the Pope posthumously going to take away the excommunication of Henry VIII?

So in conclusion, the Church has given us a year to make a final decision. I don't believe the Pope is going to wait that long, however. In the meantime, as he is lobbying bishops to promote his position on giving the sacraments to divorced and re-married Catholics, we as lay people, faithful to the Magisterium of the Church, must lobby our bishops to uphold the Sacrament as given by our Lord, Jesus Christ at the Last Supper. It was our Lord's demonstrable intention to not give His Body and Blood to Judas. And I hope to do my next program showing very clearly from Scripture that Jesus did not have an open Communion table.

If the Church now intends to give Communion to anyone and everyone, they are doing exactly what our Lord warned against. He said: **'do not give that which is holy to the dogs. Do not cast your pearls before swine.'** Some of you may claim that our Lord never actually called human beings animals but, he specifically referred to Herod as a fox.

And so finally, the upstart of all this will be that if your local diocese, and your local bishop or even your local pastor decides to give Communion to divorced and re-married Catholics, and you are told of this publicly, then you are going to have to seek out another parish because any Eucharist that those priests and bishops attempt will be invalid. One of the three requirements will not be in conformity with what Jesus did. Jesus said at the Last Supper: **'Do this in**

remembrance of me. And if you do not do it as Jesus commanded then none of us will be receiving the true Body and Blood of our Lord.
