

Mary's School of Prophecy God's Trinitarian Universe – Pt. 2 The Wonders of God's Trinitarian Universe

On this program I'm going to continue looking at the trinities in the universe and how Almighty God expressed Himself through many trinities and I talked with my little group here in Upstate New York with Father Ward. We always have a meeting after the Wednesday Mass and Father said he didn't like what I was doing because it limited God the Father or Almighty God. And I was thinking about that, and I think any one expression of the trinities would be limitation of Almighty God, but because there are so many trinities if you put them all together, I think you do get a pretty good picture of Almighty God, in other words it's just like a snapshot. Each trinity is a snapshot maybe of one aspect of God. Maybe you get a face on view or a profile view or right side view and so on, or maybe a picture of God is young or it's old or as middle aged and so on. It's like with each one of us, it takes a lot of snapshots before you get a more complete picture. I didn't think to mention that to Father but I will this coming Wednesday. This coming Wednesday by the way is Ash Wednesday.

I'm just going to do a quick review so that we know what we're talking about, and we have discovered that the Divine Trinity, the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit have different characteristics. The Father would be like a father in the family, and I used the term stability for God the Father. The Son is vitality or activity, like a son, like youth, and the Holy Spirit would be like the mother in the family, and I say mystery. You could say femininity if you wanted to for the Holy Spirit, although the Holy Spirit is not a female and we'll see that in a minute.

And then we went through the various trinities, the states of matter, solid, liquid and gas and the three primary shapes. All shapes in the universe are made out of these three shapes, square, triangle and circle. Time; all time can expressed as past, present or future. We see the primary colours. All colours are expressed as red, yellow or blue or in combinations of those three, only those three. Space is a combination of length, width and depth. There are three dimensions in space, and in music we found there are three aspects of music, melody, harmony and rhythm. The melody stands for God the Father. The harmony works with God the Father; that represents the Son. The rhythm represents the Holy Spirit. We looked at the Sun Moon and stars. There's another example of a trinity. The Sun would be God the Father, the Moon is God the Son and the stars are mysterious; that represents the Holy Spirit. So that I think gets us up to the trinities I wanted to talk about today.

Those trinities are mostly all structural trinities and therefore they refer to God the Father. His trinities are structural trinities. Now some of those trinities are also Holy Spirit trinities and gradation trinities. God the Son is associated with gradation trinities like small, medium and large. That's probably the most obvious gradation trinity. Small would be the Holy Spirit. That would be feminine, mysterious. Large would be God the Father. The father is the largest remember the family, and if you look at those as extremes, the tiniest of the tiny, small to the point that it's almost invisible and the large to the huge, to the greatest size in the universe, in other

words, the Holy Spirit is almost invisible. God the Father would be huge and massive, solid, stability and the whole range in between would represent God the Son, and we see that in quite a few different types of gradation trinities. I've got soft to hard for example. On each side notice that on one side tends to be feminine and the other side tends to be masculine; small to large, soft to hard. The centre area would represent God the Son. Smooth to rough, you get very, very smooth to very, very rough, feminine to masculine. In the middle is God the Son. Quiet to loud for example, and there are many others. Now some trinities are, as I say gradation trinities and a good example of that would be the structural trinity of water. Ice would be solid and steam would be like gas, mysterious, the Holy Spirit, but there are a whole range of temperatures for water, from very cold to very hot, and that range would refer to God the Son.

Now, let me just review an example of a Holy Spirit Trinity. Now the Holy Spirit Trinity is, as I say I call it reproductive trinities or the two plus one trinities, and you can't say the Holy Spirit is feminine but rather reproductive is a better term. The Holy Spirit is the Lord and giver of life and there's no doubt that a woman's body for example, the whole body represents the characteristics we just saw in the Holy Spirit, soft, smooth, small, quiet and so on. Those are all feminine characteristics and the woman would represent all those characteristics better than a man. On the other hand, a man's private parts represent the Holy Spirit also and it actually exhibits most of those characteristics except it's also two plus one, the Father and the Son would be similar. The Holy Spirit is much different.

And we see that expressed in a good example which is the three primary shapes, being square, the triangle and the circle. This is a structural trinity but it's also a Holy Spirit Trinity because the square and the triangle are very similar to each other. They both have straight edges. They both have acute angles. The circle is obviously much different than the other two, and we also, on our last program broke it down because each of these can be broken down into trinities. The square can be broken down into a square, a rectangle and a trapezoid. A triangle can be an equilateral triangle, which would be God the Father because it's all equals. It's I would say stable or represents equilateral I guess you could say. Anyway that to me is God the Father and a triangle with two sides equal and one different, an isosceles triangle, that would be a Holy Spirit, and a scalene triangle with all three sides different, that would represent God the Son, vitality, change in other words.

And the circle, there are three different types of circles. A circle, if you put it on its side like this, it becomes an oval as you can see. If you take a circle and you break it in half and look at it at an angle, you can see what it becomes. It becomes a heart shape, and of course that represents God the Son. So those are the three types of circles. They represent the Trinity also. There's one more trinity. This is one I don't think I've covered, and that's the three comings of our Lord Jesus Christ. His first coming was, I call His liquid coming and we think about Jesus very often in terms of water, and fishermen, and miracles at the sea, and calming the storm, and the woman at the well, and curing people's blindness with spittle, and his bloody crucifixion. His first miracle was changing water into wine and so on. So I would say His first coming was as a liquid coming. Now when he returns on Mount Zion, that would be his solid coming, in other words He comes on a mountain. When He comes at judgment, He comes on the air. Remember He will

return as He came, as He went up. He comes down with the angels, so that would be the three comings of our Lord. And in the End Times, there's the false trinity, as we all are aware. The Antichrist is the beast from the sea, the False Prophet is the beast from the earth, and the dragon is from the air or a spirit in other words. So there you have your solid, liquid and gas trinity, just as the real Trinity, the perverse trinity or the mimic trinity. The trinity that mimics the true Trinity also follows the same pattern.

And I was thinking in the End Times, four is the new three, as I have mentioned many times on here, and that's why we have for example four mysteries of the Rosary now. We had the original mysteries a thousand years ago, the Sorrowful, the Joyful and the Glorious, and now we have the Luminous also. St. John Paul II gave us that as a warning that we are in the End Times. In fact it's possible those three mysteries of the Rosary, the Sorrowful, the Joyful and the Glorious, also represent the Trinity. Four is the new three and you can express God the same way. God equals Father plus Son plus Holy Spirit.

A lot of people say that there are four parts of the universe. You have solid, liquid and gas, the three states of matter, but you also have plasma which some people say is a different state of matter. Actually I think it's a combination of solid, liquid and gas. It's like God equals Father, Son plus Holy Spirit. Plasma equals solid plus liquid and gas, and there are four beasts in the Book of Revelation, actually three beasts and one dragon. The Antichrist is the beast from the sea, the False Prophet is the beast from the earth and Satan is the dragon, but there is a fourth beast and I wonder if that represents the plasma or God. The beast from the abyss would be sort of a combination of the Antichrist, the False Prophet and Satan. It's actually the One World system. And I also mentioned knife, fork and spoon. I don't know if anybody came up with an answer to that or not, so if you have any other trinities I think that would be worthwhile for us to talk about.

The three dimensions of space represent God the Trinity. Every point in the universe, in fact where you are right now, your point where you are on; you had that point for all eternity. Do you realize that? We are all in a point and if we know our longitude, latitude and height above sea water, you can take a smart bomb and you put those coordinates into a smart bomb, and they can bomb you right where you are and take you out, the smart bomb. All you do is write in three coordinates, the latitude, the longitude and the height above sea level on this earth and that's where you are right now, and the smart bomb could take you out if you put in three dimensions, so every point in the universe has three dimensions, and your three dimensions, where you are right now, that's yours for all eternity even in Heaven, you will have that spot. God gave you that spot. He gave up the spot. He owns all the spots in the universe and He very generously gave each one of us a spot which he doesn't intrude on. That's our spot. That's kind of a gift from God, and the horizontal would be like the latitude that represents God the Father because it's stability. God the Son is the vertical, up and down, and then the point right through the middle where those two lines cross, that's the mysterious one, because you can't see it. That's the Holy Spirit.
