The Two Priests Dream

Welcome to Mary's School of Prophecy, One of our WFRN regulars, a young lady who uses the YouTube handle, "Snowland" received a new prophetic dream in January of this year, 2024, and on this program, I will try to decode that dream which I call, "The Two Priests Dream". In this first slide Snowland is speaking.

1) "In the dream, I was walking inside of a hotel lobby. I went upstairs (second floor) to a room with a priest to do Mass, but I wasn't paying attention to the situation. My mind would keep thinking about other things rather than paying attention to the Mass".

I contacted Snowland several days ago to ask some questions about her dream. First I asked her, was this a Sunday or a weekday Mass? And she said it was a weekday Mass. I asked Snowland, was it a nice hotel or a rundown hotel? She said it was a nice hotel and also the room was very nice. She said the altar setup in the room was quite small and she was standing next to the priest for the Mass. However, there was room for more people but they never showed up.

There was a bed in the room and a long brown desk and a window. The window was behind Snowland and the priest as they both faced the altar. Snowland did not recognize the priest because she never saw his face but he was an older gentleman with white hair. Snowland noted that the room had been rented for the Mass. She said the Mass was in English, probably a Novus Ordo Mass and I believe we will discover this old, white haired, hotel priest symbolizes the failing Roman Catholic Church of today, or the very near future. 2) "I looked outside the window to see a small gathering of roughly ten people (all men). The priest had a mic and was preaching the word of God. When I looked away to see that priest, the hotel priest had to end the services because I wasn't paying attention. I helped him by putting the items away."

Snowland had to turn around to look out the window behind her, and she said the most intriguing aspect about the sidewalk priest outside: he was dressed all in gold with gold vestments. He also was using a golden microphone to address the passers-by and about ten men, no women, had stopped to listen to him. Of course, 10 is a Rosary number and I think the gold color indicates that his sidewalk preaching was more pleasing to God than the Mass of the hotel priest. Snowland did not recognize the sidewalk priest either but he was younger than the hotel priest and had dark colored hair.

I asked Snowland if she had wanted to join that priest outside but she had no feelings one way or another. I believe we will discover that this younger, sidewalk priest, symbolizes our Remnant Catholic Church, in other words, the "Stone cut out from a mountain" as described in Daniel. The older, hotel priest symbolizes the Roman Catholic Church of today, in other words, the mountain from which the small stone is cut out from. Next slide:

3) "When I was about to leave, a group of people (all women, no men) came and asked the priest how many people attended the Mass today. He said 1 person. The group was disappointed only one person came."

I asked Snowland if she recognized any of the women but she did not. I asked her, how could you tell they were disappointed? She said she felt they were disappointed. She said they reminded her of the foolish virgins in the Bible who missed the arrival of the Bridegroom.

So, in conclusion, the two priests in Snowland's prophetic dream provide two sharp contrasts: one between the nice hotel with the older priest, indoors who has a tiny congregation of one person versus the younger, golden attired sidewalk priest who was street preaching outdoors, to a larger group, albeit still a small crowd. Thus, the hotel priest symbolizes the failing Roman Catholic Church of today while the outdoor preacher symbolizes the future of our Remnant Catholic Church. Neither priest seemed to have a regular parish church. Is this dream a prophecy of the soon coming persecution when ALL Catholic Churches will be closed?

Snowland's dream is telling us that God would prefer that we respond to this upcoming persecution of Catholics with a radical form of street preaching rather than trying to maintain a traditional church format. The hotel room is a mini Catholic Church but it fails to restore the Church. Downsizing like this is the current, losing strategy of the Roman Catholic Church, as it has been at least for the last 60 years. Installing women on the altar and allowing them to serve as deaconesses, or perhaps very soon as priestesses, will not work either. All of this so called progress only attracts a certain type of woman who is basically a feminist but attracts very few, if any, men, except perhaps priests of the James Martin variety.

However, the new Church that will survive into the Millennium is exemplified by the gold attired street preacher with the golden microphone. Being dressed in gold reminds me of the golden halos around saints in famous paintings or perhaps the golden rays of the sun around the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Also, the sacred numerology, as expressed by the number of ten passers-by on the sidewalk, tells us that Mary will be with us if we are brave enough to confront our decadent society on the streets, not in some comfortable hotel room.

In reaching out to the lost, the sidewalk priest with a microphone reminds me of the very few priests or even fewer bishops I have known who are willing to assist in sidewalk counseling at abortion mills. You may question whether ANY bishops ever pray a Rosary in front of Planned Parenthood, for example, but I can personally attest that several times I personally have provided the sound equipment to just such a bishop.

It's interesting that in Snowland's dream, all the passers-by on the sidewalk were men while the group who arrived late for the hotel Mass was all women who evidently preferred a Mass concelebrated with deaconesses as symbolized by Snowland.
