

## Unsealing the Abomination of Desolation Part 8

This will be part 8 in my series on the Abomination of Desolation, as spoken of by Daniel the prophet, and which Jesus said we must read and understand if we are going to join Jesus in the Millennium. And so far we have found out there are actually four different Abominations of Desolation and they are precipitated by four different individuals and they affect four different groups: the same four groups who will reign with Jesus during the thousand years of peace.

Those four Abominations of Desolation are found in the last six chapters of Daniel, which are also known as the vision chapters. And Daniel sealed up his prophecy, at the direction of an angel, by using hidden verse and chapter structures. Many of these include Hebrew literary devices, such as pairs, parallelism, chiasms, and so on. Now I have substituted x's in place of the words, in these verse charts, so that we can concentrate on the amazing structures which Daniel used to hide his prophecy. And I want to compare the structures in all six of the vision chapters and we will begin by looking at chapter 7, which is the first of the six vision chapters.

Although chapter number 7 is not an Abomination of Desolation chapter, it is the first of the six vision chapters, and remember, the angel told Daniel to seal up his vision. And we rearrange these verses in order to unseal the prophecy, by first noting that in verses 6, 17 and 23, Daniel uses the word 'four' twice, in each of those three verses. And he does not do that in any of the other verses. Therefore we know that there is a relationship between those three verses, and when we put them on a horizontal line, and let the other verses fall where they may, around those verses, then we understand the prophecy (see chart below).

For example, we know that verses 2 - 28 are related to verses 7 - 11. And there is also a prophecy in the verse structure itself, because there are 6 verses, 6 verses and another 6 verses above, followed by 5 verses and another 5 verses below. That tells us the Antichrist, whose number is 666, will be defeated by Mary's Rosary, which number is 555. And we are going to discover that hidden numerical prophecy is found in all of Daniel's six vision chapters, and in fact, it coincides with our Lord's prophecy in Matthew's Olivet Discourse and also in Ezekiel, chapters 38 and 39, that 666 is always followed by 555: the Antichrist is always defeated by Mary's Rosary: that is the weapon Jesus will use, just as David chose five smooth pebbles against Goliath when he only need one pebble.

And now, let's look at Daniel, chapter number 8, which is the first of the Abomination of Desolation chapters. In this chapter, the Abomination of Desolation is personified by the Antichrist, and he brings death and destruction to the holy martyrs, who are one of the four groups, who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium. In verse number 25, the Antichrist kills many people.

Daniel has arranged the verses in pretty much a straight chiasm. On the left hand side, we see verses 1 - 13; verse number 14 is sort of like a hinge verse at the bottom, and then verses 15 - 27 are printed in reverse on the right. And therefore we see a relationship between each side of the chiasm. For example, in verses 1 and 2 on the left and 27 and 26 on the right, the word 'vision' is repeated three times, and the rest of the structure is accomplished by changing the topic (see chart below).

In other words, verses 3 - 8 are about the war between the Ram and the Goat, and verses 9 - 13, are about the Antichrist. And once again, the verse structure helps to understand the prophecy, and also the structure itself, contains the same prophecy, we saw in chapter number 7, and that is 6 verses, 3 - 8 and 20 - 25 are followed by a set of 5 verses; 9 - 13 and 15 - 19. In other words, 66 the number of the Antichrist, is followed by, and defeated by 55, the number of Mary's Rosary. The 4 verses at top refer to the United States and the single verse at the bottom refers to the Millennium.

Next, let's look at chapter number 9 which is a warning from Daniel to the nation of Israel and Jerusalem, and it is for the converted Jews, another one of the four groups, who will reign with Jesus during the thousand years of peace. And, in this third different type of structure he uses pairs and parallelism to hide and to seal up his prophecy. On the left hand side, we see 6 pairs of verses, on the right hand side we see

5 pairs of verses, and we see 5 verses in the middle, which stand apart (see chart below).

And we find out that Daniel is telling us that the last two verses in each column are related. These are the prophetic verses: 26 and 27 and 11 and 12 are actual prophecies, while 16 and 17 are exhortations. And since we know that these 6 verses are prophecies from Daniel for the End Times, to the modern nation of Israel, and Jerusalem, we know that this destruction will be caused by the Prince, in verse 26, who is the Prince of Persia. And Daniel's solution is the same as he has given before: 6 pairs of verses are followed by 5 verses and 5 pairs. In other

words 66, the number of the Antichrist is followed by 555, the number of Mary's rosary.

Chapter number 11, is a warning from Daniel to the raptured Protestants, that they must be ready at all times; and this coincides with what Jesus Himself said in the Olivet Discourse, that He will come like a thief the night. And the person who personifies this particular Abomination of Desolation is Antiochus Epiphanes, who is the fifth of the six kings of the north, and therefore the warning for the raptured Protestants has already come and gone, thousands of years ago. That's why we know, they must be ready at all times.

And now Daniel organized these verses in a very interesting fashion. The first four verses talk about six ancient kings. Therefore he sets up two sequences of the number 4, and the number 6, but we don't understand the pattern until we look at the last 15 verses, and Daniel sets these out, by listing 4 items in verse 33, 4 items in verse number 38 and 4 items in verse number 43. Therefore, he is setting up two more patterns; a set of three 4s, and a set of three 5s, and a pattern of things, as well as verses (see chart below).

Therefore we go back to the first four verses, and we realize it's very likely that the four verses would be followed by two more sets of four verses, 5 - 8 and 9 - 12. And when we do that, we find that there are 18 verses in the middle, and therefore they are very likely also, to set up in a pattern of 6-6-6. And this is the only one of Daniel's chapters in which the three 6 verses, 6-6-6, which are again followed by three sets of 5 verses, 5-5-5, indicating that the Antichrist will be defeated by Mary's Rosary, because in this chapter, there are three sets of 4s at the beginning, and that is a warning to America specifically, and to Barack Obama, because 444 is his number in Bible prophecy, and the number of the United States. And what Daniel is telling us with this verse structure is that America, 444 and Barack Obama, will be defeated by 666, that is the Antichrist, who in turn will be defeated by 555, Mary's Rosary.

Now let's look at one of the most interesting chapters, and that is, 10 and 12 combined. We've already seen how the Abomination of Desolation affects three of the groups: the raptured Protestants, the holy martyrs and the converted Jews. And here in chapter 10/12, we will see how it affects the fourth group, who will reign with Jesus during the thousand years of peace, and that is the protected Catholics. And we will find out, who it is that causes the Catholics to flee into the desert: the False Prophet. And we noticed this new chapter is pretty much arranged as a regular chiasm with chapter 10 on the left; that is

verses 1 - 17, and chapter 12 on the right, verses 1 - 13, on the right, and also the last four verses of chapter 10, 18 - 21 (see chart below).

Daniel reveals one of the most important prophecies in this new chapter 10 / 12, because when he talks about the continual sacrifice in verse number 11, in chapter number 12, on the right, he reveals what he is talking about, through the corresponding verse in chapter number 10, verse number 3, on the left. In other words, the continual sacrifice in 11, is explained when Daniel says ***'I ate no desirable bread and neither flesh nor wine entered into my mouth.'*** In other words, the continual sacrifice must be the Holy Eucharist, and that's extremely important for us to understand in these End Times, because chapter 10 and 12 is a warning to the protected Catholics and the one who brings in the Abomination of Desolation is the False Prophet, and what he will do is remove the holy sacrifice of the Eucharist from all Catholic masses throughout the world.

But what is the solution to the False Prophet taking away the Holy Eucharist from all Catholics, and in fact, from all Christians. The answer is the same as Daniel has given in all these other chapters: Mary's Rosary will defeat the Antichrist. In this case there are four 6s, 6 verses, 6 more verses, 6 verses, 6more verses, all followed by 5 verses and 5 verses. It should be fairly obvious that Daniel is telling us what we must do to defeat the Antichrist in these End Times.

And, in fact we see this same answer, in the way Daniel has arranged his 12 chapters. The first six chapters, that is, the Historical chapters, are followed by the five Vision chapters. Don't forget there are only five Vision Chapters, because 10 and 12, are the same chapter. None of this is accidental. Daniel's message should be fairly clear by now.
