

Dual End Times Prophecy in Jeremiah 23, Pt 5

First of all, I know a lot of you will want to ask me if I watched the debate last night and no, I did not and that's because I can't stand looking at Hillary Clinton but I understand that it went very well for Mr. Trump whom I am supporting and endorsing in this presidential contest. Now, I know some of you will say that I have claimed for eight years here on YouTube that Barack Obama would be our last president and that's true, but in Daniel chapter number seven, the Leopard is followed by the Antichrist and I've always said that would be true also.

And now, this program will be part five in my series on Jeremiah's chapter number 23 which is an amazing End Times prophecy and that's because it is a dual End Times prophecy. Jeremiah is giving a prophecy of the Jews returning to Israel which has almost completely been accomplished. It began about seventy years ago when the United Nations sent forth the notice that Israel would be a sovereign state and those 69 years of Daniel's great 70 year prophecy are almost up. It will be up this November 29th and I want to warn you, especially about what Natan said, he said World War 3 would break out with a nuclear attack before then. Natan has said that World War 3 is already going on and I've told you that many times also. And, in fact, I follow the prophecies of Bayside where Mary said that **'Syria holds the key to world peace'** and how true that prophecy is turning out to be!

But, let's get on with this program. I want to talk about Jeremiah's chapter number 23 and in order to understand it, Jeremiah sealed up this chapter through a cryptogram very much the way John did in the book of Revelation. And, if you look at Jeremiah's cryptogram, we have already studied line number one, and we discovered that four of those verses have to do with the false Protestant prophets of these End Times. On line number two there are four verses about the false Jewish prophets; they're in Israel today trying to tell the Jewish people that Iron Dome and nuclear missiles will save them: that is a lie! They are trying to tell the Jewish people in Israel they don't have to follow Torah any longer and they can promote Tel Aviv as the gay capital of the world. That's another lie from the false Jewish prophets.

And next, we've already looked at the first two verses of line 3, that is verses 3 and 8, and they talk about the remnant Catholic Church which will have to respond to the false Catholic prophet of the End Times,

and that would be the False Prophet of all time, the Beast in the Book of Revelation who comes up from the earth, Pope Francis. But, before we continue on with line three, I want to give you an example of how Jeremiah is giving two different End Times prophecies simultaneously. Let's take a look at verse number 7 which is on line two and, of course, in your Bibles it is followed by verse number 8. In Jeremiah's cryptogram, however, it stands alone. Let's look and see how you must interpret verse number 7 completely different in the two different versions.

Verse number 7: ***‘Therefore, behold the days are coming*** (now, that indicates that Jeremiah is talking about the End Times in both prophecies) ***says the Lord that they shall say no more the Lord lives who brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt*** (verse 8) ***but the Lord lives who has brought out and led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country and from all countries where I had driven them, then they shall dwell in their own land.*** Now, that is a tremendous prophecy from Jeremiah about the Jews returning to Israel. And historically, from a Jewish perspective, the Jews in Israel can very well say to each other, we can believe in God because he not only brought our ancient ancestors out of Egypt but he has brought us out of the lands which he has driven us and we have reassembled in the nation of Israel.

But, that is not a very good fulfillment of the first sentence of Jeremiah 23: ***‘Woe to the pastors’*** and that's why, in order to understand the

very End Times fulfillment of Jeremiah 23, you have to read verse number 7 as it stands alone on line number three in Jeremiah's cryptogram: ***'Therefore, behold the days are coming, says the Lord, that they shall say no more the Lord lives who brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt'***. In other words, at the present time, the Jews in Israel no longer believe in the Lord who brought them up out of the land of Egypt; the Jewish rabbis today in Israel are leading the people astray. Thus, there are two completely different interpretations of verse 7; but the prophecy from Jeremiah's cryptogram much better fulfills the first sentence in Jeremiah's chapter 23, ***'woe to the pastors'***.

So now, let's move on to verse number thirteen, on line three, the next verse, and this is a description of Who is giving both of these amazing End Times prophecies to Jeremiah: ***'And I (Almighty God) have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria, they prophesied in Baal and deceived my people Israel.'*** So what God is saying is that He has had a lot of experience exposing false prophets and we should believe Him! He knows what the false prophets in the End Times will be like also, the Protestant, Jewish and Catholic false prophets. Once again, notice how God uses the phrase ***'my people'***, that is Jeremiah's code word for the Jewish people.

The next two verses are very interesting verses: God asks three rhetorical questions: verse number 18, ***'for who has stood in the counsel of the Lord and has perceived and heard his word?'*** Of course, no one has stood in the counsel of the Lord; that's question number one. Question number two: ***'who has considered his word and heard it?'*** And question number 3 in verse 23, ***'am I think you a God at hand, says the Lord, and not a God afar off?'*** It's interesting that these three related rhetorical questions are only found next to each other in Jeremiah's cryptogram. They are separated by five different verses as printed in your current Bibles.

Next, God tells Jeremiah that there are also some good Christian and Jewish prophets in these End Times: verse number 28, ***'The prophet that has a dream, let him tell his dream.'*** This word 'dream' means that God is talking about true Jewish prophets (like Natan or Elijah). Remember, I told you about young men having visions and the old men dreaming dreams and that separated the younger denomination, that would be the Protestants, from the oldest denomination and that

would be the Jews, therefore God is here talking about the true Jewish prophets of the End Times.

'And he that has my word let him speak my word with truth.' Now, in this case, God is talking about the true Christian prophets (Enoch?) of the End Times. There may not be too many on YouTube but there are some and, by the way, it is you who must test the spirits. This week one of my subscribers asked me, how do I know you're the 'Third Eagle of the Apocalypse'? Well, it is not my job to convince you of that. You have to test the spirits. For example, in Matthew's Olivet Discourse, did Jesus separate the verses into a 6-6-6 pattern followed by a 5-5-5 pattern which indicates that Mary's Rosary is the weapon he will use to defeat the Antichrist? Yes, he did! And my discovery of that sealed up prophecy is one example of how you can tell I'm the Third Eagle. No other Catholic, Protestant or Jewish Bible scholar has ever told you that true interpretation.

However, it doesn't really matter whether I am or not; what's important for you to understand is that we need to pray Mary's Rosary if we are going to prevent that fourth Beast from taking over the entire world following the Leopard who is Barack Obama. And now, God continues talking about the false prophets, **'what has the chaff to do with the wheat'**; and he is saying that the false prophets have nothing to do with a good prophets of which there are some on YouTube.

Verse number 33: **'If therefore this people** (that's God's and Jeremiah's code word for the Jews) **or the prophet** (that's Jeremiah's code word for the Protestants) **or a priest** (that's Jeremiah's code word for Catholics) **shall ask you** (who is the 'you' in this instance? Well, God is speaking to Jeremiah but Jeremiah is not alive at this time; therefore he is prophesying to you and me: what must we do about these false prophets all around, the false pastors found in that first sentence: **'Woe to you pastors'**. We have to tell them: 'woe to you') **saying, what is the burden of the Lord? Then you shall say to them what burden, you are the burden for I will forsake even you, says the Lord'**. It's up to us to call out these false Catholic, Protestant, and Jewish prophets all over YouTube, for example.

Verse number 38: **'But you say the burden of the Lord therefore thus says the Lord because you say this word the burden of the Lord and I have sent unto you saying you shall not say the burden of the Lord'**. In other words, all these false prophets are

saying that they receive their messages from the Lord, whether it's in dreams or visions or whatever, and most of them are lying. And Jesus warned us about the false prophets in the End Times. He said there would be many of them and He said they would come in his name, in other words, claiming to be Christian.

And I want to recommend to you the Jewish teenager Natan's vision. I think that he received true word from Almighty God and according to him we're at the very last days. He said a year ago that we had about a year left before all hell breaks loose. And now I want to close by telling you that you can go on my website, you can download Jeremiah's cryptogram. You can see how the verses must be arranged so that you can understand the real far End Times interpretation, the correct interpretation of these verses so that they fulfill the very first sentence: ***'Woe to the pastors'***.
