

New Prophecy! Jeremiah Warns Protestants Pt 1

On this program I am beginning a new series on an amazing End Times Bible prophecy which I discovered just a few weeks ago in chapter 23 of the Book of Jeremiah which you can only understand by unraveling the secret structure in what I call Jeremiah's Cryptogram, which I will explain in a few minutes. When I first discovered quite a few years ago that the book of Esther and the book of Tobias contain hidden Bible prophecy, something which no other Bible Scholar had ever understood, neither Catholic, Protestant or Jewish, I never thought I would discover any more End Times prophecy in Scripture; but that all changed a couple weeks ago when I realized that Jeremiah, chapter 23, is one more incredible example of Apocalyptic Literature.

I made this discovery somewhat by accident because initially I was looking for more verification that Pope Francis is the False Prophet and one of the searches I made in several Bible concordances was for the word 'Wormwood' which is another name for the False Prophet as found in the Book of Revelation. Long ago I had previously underlined 'Wormwood' in verse 15 of Jeremiah, chapter 23, in my own personal use Bible but this time, as I read over chapter 23, it dawned on me the

significance of the chapter number, number 23. And of course, as you my subscribers already know, the number 23 is another number for the Antichrist because, 2 over 3, as a fraction, yields the decimal .666.

$$17 + \text{Wormwood} = 18$$
$$18 = 6 + 6 + 6$$

And, in addition to the word 'Wormwood' representing the False Prophet, Jeremiah uses the word 'prophet' or 'prophets' 17 more times in his chapter 23 and, of course, that means that 17 'prophets' plus one 'Wormwood' yields the number 18 and

18 is another number for the Antichrist: 6 plus 6 plus 6 and it's interesting that you won't find that word 'prophet' in either the preceding or succeeding chapters of Jeremiah. In other words, in chapters 22 or 24, no 'prophets' are ever mentioned. That is one way that God is signifying the importance of this particular chapter. But I think the real clincher in this chapter 23 of Jeremiah can be found in verse number 20 where he writes ***'in the latter days you shall understand his*** (that is Almighty God's) ***counsel***'. In other words,

Jeremiah is telling us this prophecy will be unsealed or unraveled in these End Times and it has fallen upon me, your 'Third Eagle', to do the unsealing.

It's interesting that these two key verses, 15 and 20, follow each other, as we will discover, in chapter 23 and, of course, both 15 and 20 are very important numbers in Bible prophecy regarding Mary's Rosary because, as you my subscribers know, Mary's Rosary is the weapon Jesus will use to defeat the Antichrist. Now, just as references to Mary's Rosary and sacred numerology are two important features in the hermeneutics of all Apocalyptic Literature, other features which are on display here in chapter 23 are that symbolic interpretation takes precedence over literal interpretation and you need a Co Prophet to understand the prophecy.

All previous Bible scholars have misinterpreted Jeremiah 23 because they did not realize it was End Times Apocalyptic Literature and as such it needs to be unsealed, in other words, very much like Daniel and Ezekiel and Zachariah, who hid their prophecies by sealing them up. And in chapter 23, Jeremiah used a hidden verse pattern very similar to the cryptogram in Saint John's book of Revelation, which he used in chapters 6 through 20, which is why I also call this secret arrangement of verses in chapter 23, 'Jeremiah's Cryptogram'.

Here's how his cryptogram works: Jeremiah wrote out the prophecy on 5 horizontal lines of 8 verses each as shown on the chart somewhat like the weeks and days of a calendar but then he printed out the verses vertically and numbered them accordingly. In other words, if this were a calendar, the Sundays would be numbered vertically in the far left column, 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, and in order to understand the prophecy however, you must reverse the process and read the verses in their original sequence. In other words, verse 6 follows immediately after verse 1; then verses 11, 16, 21 etc. In other words, you read the days of the week in their regular sequence horizontally, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday etc but you keep the numbering as found in your bibles. It's a really very simple cryptogram even though no one has ever discovered it before.

Now, the correctness of this solution will become obvious as we go through chapter 23 verse by verse. For the past several months I have

been warning Catholics especially about the False Prophet, Pope Francis; and before that I had been warning Jews in Israel that the Jewish teenager, Natan, was giving them true and accurate warnings from Almighty God. On this program, I must warn primarily the Protestants because the amazing hidden prophecies of Jeremiah, as found in his cryptogram, chapter 23, are aimed primarily at those denominations. However, Jeremiah also exposes fake Catholic and fake Jewish prophets and he even warns you and me, in another words, everyone, and that's because we have to warn the many false prophets! That's our job!

So, now, let's begin our analysis of this amazing End Times prophecy in chapter 23 of Jeremiah in verse number 1: **'Woe to the pastors** (the very first word is 'woe'; that tells you what this chapter is all about) **that destroy and tear the sheep of my pasture, says the Lord.'** This opening verse is a very concise summary of what Jeremiah's chapter 23 is all about. The word 'pastors' is a general term and it includes all religious clergy, Catholic, Protestant and Jewish. The 'sheep' here represent all of mankind and the Lord's 'pasture' is all of God's green earth. Next, the actual second verse of the prophecy in the original verse sequence, before Jeremiah sealed up his prophecy in a cryptogram, is the current number 6 as printed in your Bible.

If you remember Jeremiah's cryptogram, which I just told you about, the vertical column on your left contains the verses 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, as printed in your Bibles but they must be read as on the top line. In other words, 1, 6, 11, 16, 21, 26, 31 and 36. So, let's look at verse number 6: **'In those days Judah shall be saved and Israel shall dwell securely; and this is his name whereby he shall be called: the Lord our Righteousness.'** Here we discover what days Jeremiah is prophesying about in his chapter 23. They are the days when Israel dwells securely and that can only refer to our own time when Israel has once again become a nation. The reference to Judah and Israel in this verse does not mean that verse 6 is a prophecy about Israel or the Jews. That comes later on in this chapter. How do we know? Because there is no 'woe' or warning to the Jews or Israel as first mentioned in verse number 1. That means that the only reason Judah and Israel are mentioned here is to indicate the time frame which Jeremiah is prophesying about. Also very interesting is the title of God here, **'Lord our Righteousness'**. That title is only found in this particular verse and chapter of the entire Bible! That is one more way that God is

indicating the uniqueness and importance of this End Times, prophetic chapter.

So, we see that the first two verses, that is verse 1 and 6 on Jeremiah's cryptogram, in our new way of arranging it, follow each other perfectly. The first verse tells us who this prophecy is directed at, that is all 'pastors' and the second verse tells us when we are to give them the warning. Now, moving on to the next verse, which is actually the third verse of the original prophecy but which is numbered 11 in your Bibles, on the top line of Jeremiah's cryptogram, verse 11: **'For both prophet and priest are defiled even in my house I have found their wickedness says the Lord.'** So now, whereas the first verse addresses all pastors, here Jeremiah narrows his focus to the false Christian pastors. 'My house' refers to Christianity, the body of Christ, which is separated out from my pasture as expressed in verse number 1. The term 'prophet' is Jeremiah's code word for 'Protestant' and the word 'priest' is his code word for Catholic and this is very similar to the code words in the book of Revelation where St. John refers to Catholics as 'saints', to Protestants as 'prophets' and to Jews as 'servants'.

Moving on to verse number 16: **'Thus says the Lord of hosts hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you, they deceive you. They speak a vision of their own heart and not out of the mouth of the Lord.'** So now here, Jeremiah is narrowing his focus even further. He leaves out the word 'priests', which refers to Catholics, as found in verse number 11, and refers here specifically to just the false Protestant prophets. And I will get to those in part number 2. I'm going to eventually go over all of these verses; they are all very significant in these End Times. They are very important. I am very privileged that the Lord has revealed to me the real meaning Jeremiah chapter 23 and I'm going to give it to you as soon as I get the complete prophecy. It's very important in these times. No one has ever understood it before and I hope you stay tuned to part number 2 and probably parts number 3 and 4.
