

SIGNS OVER OSAGE, IOWA

FIRST SIGN – At 8:30 on the morning of February 7, 2021, Sister Renee Mauser was praying on the prayer porch of her refuge, when she happened to look out the window at the sky above the distant forest. To her amazement she saw, in the open space between bands of horizontal clouds, a solitary vertical column of cloud in the form of a crucifix. Notably, it appeared on Super Bowl Sunday during the Covid-19 pandemic. WFRN was, in fact, expecting some sort of sign that day, and they were not disappointed.

The supernatural cloud was very likely an answer to prayer that Glenn Flavin had prayed on behalf of Sister Renee. (Glenn's obit is under *In Memoriam*, on this website; tragically, he succumbed to Covid.) Previously, he had asked GOD to repay Sister for composing the little “St. Michael, St. Michael” traveler's prayer, which he dutifully prayed while driving with his family and which he had attributed to saving them from a potentially serious car accident. He had shared this testimony while visiting Sister's refuge.

Although there is a difference of opinion as to the interpretation of elements on the periphery of the miraculous cloud formation, the main shape plainly shows Jesus on the Cross (facing to our right).

SECOND SIGN – Providentially, almost three and a half years later, on Sunday evening July 7, 2024, Sister Renee witnessed a double rainbow in the same spot where the Crucifix Cloud had appeared. The duration between the Crucifix Cloud on Sunday 2/7/21 and the Double Rainbow on Sunday 7/7/24 is 1246 days (or exactly 3 years 5 months or 41 months).
