Mary's Rosary, Plane Crashes, Numerology and WW3

On this program I want to talk about how both God and Satan are communicating to mankind through the use of numerology.

As you know, just this year Satan has attacked six airplanes associated with the number 1 5 3. 1 5 3 is the number of Hail Marys in a complete Three Mystery Rosary. Yesterday, on my most recent video which was about the helicopter and small plane crash over the Hudson River, Lyn from the United Kingdom asked me the following question, 'Could you tell me where in scripture it tells you about the Rosary?' I answered back and said the Rosary is found in the bible under hidden symbolism, and the example I gave was the verse structure in Saint Matthew's Olivet Discourse. Lyn immediately answered back and said, 'Hi William, I had the King James Version and verses you gave me are not about the Rosary. Help.' So I promised Lyn I would do a video explaining how our Lord in the Olivet Discourse reveals that the Rosary will defeat the Antichrist, and he speaks to us through numerology.

Let's look at Matthew chapter 24 verses 9 through 14. Beginning in verse number 9, there are 18 verses which are divided up into a 6 6 6 pattern. These are the Tribulation verses, and our Lord is telling you that the Antichrist number of 6 6 6 represents the Tribulation. 'Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and then shall many be scandalized and many false prophets shall arise and because iniquity shall abound the love of many shall grow cold, but he that shall persevere to the end shall be saved and this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness to all nations, and then shall come the end.'

In the next six verses, that is 15 through 20, Jesus changes his topic and talks about the Abomination of Desolation and the four groups who will reign with him during the Millennium. 'When therefore you shall see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet, then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains then him who is on the house top not come down to take anything out of his house, neither let him who is in the field go back to take this cloak. Woe to them who are pregnant and pray that your flight be not in winter or on the Sabbath.'

Those who are in Judea refer to the Converted Jews. Those who are on the house top refer to those who will be raptured, the Raptured Protestants. Those who are in the field refer to the Protected Catholics

and those who suffer the woes are the Holy Martyrs. In the next six verses, that is 21 through 26, Jesus changes topic again, and he talks about the Great Tribulation, which is the second half of the seven years of Tribulation. 'For then shall be Great Tribulation, such as was not from the beginning of the world until now nor ever shall be again and unless those days are shortened, there shall be no flesh saved.

Then if any man shall say to you Lo, here is Christ or there, believe not, for their shall arise false Christs. Behold I have told it to you beforehand. If therefore they say to you, behold he in the desert, do not go forth or behold he is in the chamber do not believe it. It should be really obvious the Jesus has divided these 18 verses into a 6 6 6 sequence, thereby indicating that the Tribulation and the Antichrist go hand in hand. But, we will find that the solution to the 6 6 6 problem is 5 5 5. 5 5 symbolizes Mary's Rosary because there are five Joyful Mysteries, five Sorrowful Mysteries and five Glorious Mysteries.

In the first five of these 15 victory verses, that is 27 through 31, Jesus talks about his third coming at Armageddon. 'For as lightning comes out of the east and shines even to the west, so also shall the coming of the Son of Man be. Wheresoever the body is, there shall the eagles be gathered together. Now these eagles are three groups who will be with Jesus at Armageddon. 'And immediately after the Tribulation of those days the sun shall be darkened and the moon shall not give her light and then shall appear the sign of the Son of Man in Heaven and he shall send his angles with great sound of trumpet, and they shall gather the elect from the four winds from one end of heaven to the other.

Now this is not one group which Jesus is referring to here. The elect are the Protected Catholics. The four winds means from on earth. From one end of heaven are the Raptured Protestants and in the other end of heaven are the Holy Martyrs. These three groups are the same as the eagles who are gathered together. In the next five verses, that is 32 to 36, Jesus changes topic again, and He gives us the timing of Armageddon. 'Now learn a parable from the fig tree; when its branch is still tender, and it puts forth its leaves, you know that summer is near, so likewise when you see all these things know that it is near even at the door. And then I say to you this generation shall not pass until all these things be fulfilled.'

Now the fig tree symbolizes Israel and it puts forth its leaves, when the United Nations declared Israel to be a Sovereign State in November of

1947, and when you add a generation, that is 70 years, you come to the timing for Armageddon in October or November of 2017, and Jesus adds, 'But of that day or hour no one knows, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.' When Jesus says, 'you do not know the day or the hour', he is indicating that you can figure out the season and the year for Jesus return at Armageddon. In the last five verses of this 15 verse victory sequence, that is, numbers 37 through 41, Jesus talks about the Rapture.

Chronologically the rapture will occur before the Tribulation, but Jesus talks about it here, to emphasize that you cannot know when the Rapture will occur. 'And as it was in the days of Noah, so also shall the coming of the Son of Man be'. Now this is Jesus coming at the Rapture, 'and they knew not until the flood came and swept them all away, so also shall the coming of the Son of Man shall be. Then shall two be in the field, one shall be taken and one shall be left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill, one shall be taken and the other shall be left.

All five of these verses are again a new topic and Jesus is talking here about the Rapture. Up until now, no Bible scholar has ever understood this amazing sequence of verses. In fact they've never even noticed it, but it should be obvious that the 6 6 6 Tribulation verses, are followed by the 5 5 Victory verses. This is not accidental. Jesus is telling us, through this hidden symbolism, that the Rosary is the weapon of his choice to defeat the Antichrist.

Many people are beginning to wake up to the fact, that the powers that be, want a nuclear war between Russia, the United States and the United Kingdom, and we need to understand that both Jesus and Satan are telling us in their own ways that the solution to this problem is Mary's Rosary. 5 5 5 symbolizes Mary's Rosary and 1 5 3 indicates the number of Hail Marys in a complete three Mystery Rosary.

We all need to begin praying the Rosary with great sincerity, humility and reverence, if we ever hope to defeat the Antichrist, and possibly even prevent World War 3.
