

## **Trump's Peace Plan – Pt. 6**

### **Will False Prophets Lead Evangelicals Away From Trump?**

I decided to talk a little more about President Donald Trump's Peace Plan and the problems this is causing in the evangelical community, because of the false prophets. The false prophets for years and years and years have said that any peace plan in the Middle East will be brought about by the Antichrist, and that's all due to a misinterpretation of Daniel 9:26 and 27. And I've told you all along that its life and death when you mistranslate the Bible or if you have bad translations.

So today I am going to refer to a video by JD Farag. I think he's located in Hawaii. He's very popular and I'm not picking on him as against any of the other false prophets. The reason is that he enunciates as a false prophet as well as any of them, and they're all the same, and they say for example in Daniel 9:26 and 27, the Antichrist confirms a covenant with Israel or forms of peace treaty as they usually say, and that's the stand also of Irvin Baxter. He's also very popular and I think John Hagee is in the same category. So I want to play a little bit of JD Farag's most recent video on the peace plan, and he tries to tippy-toe around. Instead of blaming Donald Trump, he blames Jared Kushner. That's because he knows that Donald Trump is still popular with the evangelicals, but if he continues with his type of interpretations, the evangelicals will turn against Donald Trump, and I guess some already are.

Besides bad interpretation, the false prophets also often have to rely on bad translations, and that leads to bad interpretation, and the only translation that is the best in practically all cases is the Catholic Douay Rheims Bible. It is far superior to any of the others. Once in a great while I pick the King James, but it's rare and few and far between are the times in which I discount the Douay-Rheims.

What I want to talk about today is the how the false prophets are going to eventually turn the evangelicals against Trump, unless of course they convert as Kim Clement prophesied, and that may very well happen. And in fact it will happen according to the prophet Isaiah, in Isaiah 45.

So first I'm going to play a little bit of JD Farag's video which he calls "Bible Prophecy Update - February 2<sup>nd</sup>". He published it on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, that would be yesterday, and I want to go over some of the points he makes, because they're completely wrong, and I want to demonstrate where he is wrong, and if he understood the prophecy, he would realize that Donald Trump's Peace Plan is almost perfect, and of course he doesn't realize that. When I say almost perfect, I'm saying that it's the Israelis who are going to reject the peace plan, that's what's important. Now that's what I'm afraid is going to happen. Donald Trump has given Benjamin Netanyahu practically everything he wanted.

Okay, so let's play this. This is JD Farag and I'm going to show you where he is mistaken.

**“Let’s turn another corner and let’s answer two questions, the first of which is whether or not this is the peace plan in Daniel’s prophecy, specifically Daniel 9:27. Let me read the prophecy (NIV). “He”, speaking of the Antichrist, “will confirm”, I want you to hang onto that word just for a moment, “he will confirm a covenant with many for one ‘seven’. In the middle of the ‘seven’ he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.”**

**So in other words, this is a prophecy about the Antichrist confirming a seven-year peace agreement, and it seems to indicate that early on or even as part of the peace agreement the Jews will be allowed to rebuild their temple, because the temples there at the midpoint, three and a half years, when this Antichrist sets himself up in the temple and demands to be worshipped, we're going to be seeing this again in 2nd Thessalonians, but he demands to be worshipped as God, and he commits an abomination many believe the sacrificing there in the temple of an unclean animal, and it will cause desolation. That's the abomination of desolation, and this is when the Jews will realize this is not our Messiah.”**

Okay, so I want to go over Daniel 9:26 and 27, and the reason I'm going to include Daniel 9:26, and we've done this quite a bit, and it's to show you that he is wrong in many, many cases. First of all, it is not the Antichrist who confirms the covenant. It is the good guy in Daniel 9:26 and 27. So let's take a look.

Before we start let's say the prayer to Our Lady of All Nations. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth, Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary be our Advocate, Amen,

Okay so now let's look at Daniel 9:26 and 27 so that you understand the mistakes that he makes. It's not the Antichrist, it's the good guy. There are two people in 9:26 and 27. There's a good guy and a bad guy. He confuses the two. It's the bad guy who sets up the abomination of desolation, not the good guy. The bad guy is not the Antichrist either. He is the prince who shall come, and as far as the abomination of desolation, it has nothing to do with ritual animal sacrifice as he suggests. There will be no ritual animal sacrifice and there will be no third temple. The third temple does not come until after Armageddon, and then he says that the Antichrist sets himself up in a Jewish temple. That's not what will happen. The temple which the Antichrist sets himself up in, is the Roman Catholic Church. That's the temple. It's symbolic. All of Daniel is symbolic, and of course we have a false prophet now who is preparing the way for the Antichrist to set himself up in the Vatican, and lead the One World Religion.

So let's look at Daniel 9:26 and 27. I've showed you this many times before. Daniel 9:26 is on the left and 27 is on the right, and I've broken down both the verses into four separate sections which relate to each other. And in **A)** on the right; **“And he shall confirm the covenant with many in one week.”** This is accurate but the

covenant which is confirmed is the Abrahamic Covenant, and that is, that Israel has been given the land of Canaan for all generations.

And then **B)** “**After sixty-two weeks the Anointed One shall be cut off but not for himself.**” The Anointed One is the exact same as the, “he shall confirm the covenant”. Of course in the near time fulfilment this was Jesus. In the End Times I am predicting that it's Benjamin Netanyahu.

And now comes the bad guy in part **C)** “**And a people of the prince who shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary.**” **D)** “**and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease.**” Notice that this bad guy does two things in both **C)** and **D)**, whereas the Anointed One does one thing in **A)** and **B)**. And then we can read the following verses at the end, **E)**, **F)**, **G)** and **H)**.

**E)** “**and there shall be in the temple the abomination of desolation:**”; the temple in this case symbolizes Judaism in Israel;  
**F)** “**and the end thereof shall be with a flood,**”  
**G)** “**and after the end of the war**”, this is the Daniel 9 war, not the Ezekiel 38 war, “**the appointed desolation.**”  
**H)** “**and the desolation shall continue even to the consummation and to the end.**”

And to prove that there is no temple, remember 9:26 and 27 have a near times fulfilment. In the near time, it referred to Jesus, and the prince who came was the Roman General Titus, and he did cause the abomination of desolation in the temple. “And after the end of the war the appointed desolation”, in other words the temple is destroyed; “and the desolation shall continue even to the consummation and to the end.” The temple will remain in a state of destruction until the end, so there can't be any third . Now they may try to build a third temple. The Deep State may bring in a third temple, but that won't fulfil the prophecy.

Okay so now, I want to show you another problem with the false prophets, and this is typical and not just of JD Farag, and that is that they have bad translations. So now he also in this video refers to Zechariah 12 verses 1 through 3. He doesn't realise the verse structure. He thinks that all three of these first three verses are talking about the same event and they're not. If he understood the structure, he would know that verses 1 and 2 describe the same event, but verse 3 describes a different event. And not only that but he relates that he's using I believe the NIV translation which is a terrible translation. Anyway let me find that on his video, and we will play what he says about Zechariah 12, verses 1 through 3.

**“Is this the fulfilment of Zacharias prophecy? Let me read Zechariah's prophecy chapter 12 verses 1 through 3. “1: A prophecy: The word of the Lord concerning Israel. The Lord, who stretches out the heavens, who lays the foundation of the earth, and who forms the human spirit with a person, declares: 2: I am going to make Jerusalem a cup that sends all the surrounding peoples reeling. Judah will be besieged as well as Jerusalem. 3: On that day, when all the nations of the earth are gathered against her, I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock for all the nations. All who try to move it will injure themselves.”**

Okay, so now I'm going to show you the way Zechariah 12 verses 1 through 3 should be interpreted. In the very first verse he says “The word of the Lord”, and he should say, “The burden of the word of the Lord”, in other words this is a warning to Israel in these End Times. He leaves that word out in this NIV translation. Even the King James is correct. All the false prophets leave that out because they want you to think that in all of Zechariah that Israel will be a burdensome stone to all the nations round about, but there are three different wars described in Zechariah. If you understand the structure and the prophecy, then you will realize that verses 1 and 2 are the same situation. So let's read Zechariah 12, verses 1 through 3.

**Zech 12:1 “The burden of the word of the Lord upon Israel. Thus says the Lord, who stretches forth the heavens, and lays the foundations of the earth, and forms the spirit of man in him.”**

So JD was correct about all of that, except he left out “the burden of the word of the Lord” because this word that God is going to give in Zechariah 12, 13 and 14 is a burden to Israel.

**Zech 12:2 “Behold I will make Jerusalem a lintel of surfeiting”, not a cup of reeling; a lintel of surfeiting means a doorway to excess or luxuriousness, “to all the people round about and Judah also shall be in the siege against Jerusalem.”**

So with his translation, he is obviously going to interpret this wrong but Jerusalem being a lintel of surfeiting coincides with exactly what John says in the Book of Revelation, that Jerusalem is a Sodom and an Egypt, not a cup of reeling as his translation says, and notice here that Judah is also in the siege against Jerusalem.

All of the false Bibles say that the siege is against both Judah and Jerusalem. That is the huge error in Zechariah 12:2.

Now, the next verse is correct, but it does not have anything to do with verse 12:2. Verse 3 tells of a different warning. This one tells of Armageddon. Verse 12:2 is the same as the Daniel 9 war. Verse 12:3 is the same as Armageddon, completely different.

**Zech 12:3 “And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will make Jerusalem a burdensome stone to all people: all that shall lift it up shall be rent and torn, and all the kingdoms of the earth shall be gathered together against her.”**

Notice the difference here that in Zechariah 12:3, **all** the kingdoms of the earth are gathered against her, whereas in 12:2, all the people **round about**; it's a completely different war.

So, I just wanted to mention how the evangelicals follow people like JD Farag or Irvin Baxter, John Hagee or Paul Begley or well, all the people we've been talking about. Eventually they're going to turn against Trump, because they will either think he is the Antichrist or they will think Jared Kushner is the Antichrist. I've seen that all over YouTube, and they will discard this peace treaty. And I am predicting, I hope this isn't true, that on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, Israel will not re-elect Benjamin Netanyahu. In other words they are going to accept the Deep State and this will be their downfall. Donald Trump has done everything he possibly could for Israel in this peace plan, but there needs to be a lot of prayer and repentance. As the Jewish teenager Natan says, Israel must repent, They must accept Judaism. They don't have to become Christian. They have to convert to Judaism and the Jewish teenager Natan is correct. They must do two things; accept Torah, read Torah and perform mitzvah, which means good works.
