

Will Your Church Accept the Pope's Abomination?

This is a follow-up to my last program where I asked you my subscribers who are Catholic to report back on to how your priests or bishops are responding to Pope Francis' initiative to allow divorced and remarried Catholics to receive Holy Communion. As I have stated many times, that will invalidate the consecrations of any priests or bishops who go along with what Pope Francis is trying to do and that is to take the **'daily sacrifice away from the prince'** as prophesied by Daniel and this, of course, causes the Abomination of Desolation, as it refers to Catholics. The Church has taught for 2000 years that anyone living in mortal sin cannot receive Holy Communion. ***'The church has long allowed this type of exception through the Internal Forum Solution'***. Well, I don't know what he means by 'long allowed'; I've never heard of this myself. ***'Should I take it that he sides with Pope Francis?'*** Here's my response, I might as well read it: ***'if he hasn't fallen over the precipice yet, he sure is tottering on the edge. You probably need to look at other parishes. Are there any others in your parish, rosary prayer groups, for example, who agree with you?'*** Scripture prophesies that Remnant Catholics will be scattered.
