

Catholic EWTN Bungles Genesis 3:15

On this program, I want to challenge EWTN. You need to start putting true Catholic interpretation of End Times prophecy on your radio programs, your television programs and in your newspapers, because yesterday you made a grievous error; you misinterpreted Genesis 3:15 which is a crucial and extremely important, End Times Bible prophecy.

And I got an email this morning from one of my subscribers, Clive James, and I want to read this for you because he brought my attention to this terrible error. *"I'm so frustrated that so-called Catholic experts get Genesis 3:15 wrong."* Well, I suppose we shouldn't be surprised, Clive, because Pope Paul VI said that Satan, the smoke of Satan, had entered into the Church and, of course, it entered into the Protestant denominations hundreds of years ago. *"Don't they know how crucial this passage is?"* Well it is extremely crucial, as I said, this is the first example in the Bible, of End Times Bible prophecy. Although many Bible scholars think it is predicting Jesus' defeat of Satan, it doesn't; it predicts Mary's defeat of Satan.

"They seem to be former Protestants, Jimmy Akin, for example, and I feel this is why they get it wrong." Very likely! *"Look at this link from the Catholic show, Called to Communion on EWTN"*. And I believe this was on EWTN radio yesterday afternoon, although you can see it on YouTube because they also tape it; *"where they say Genesis 3:15 is 'he' and not 'she'."* Well this is totally false!

I can't believe EWTN claims to be Catholic when they are giving a totally false interpretation of this important passage. *"I'm disappointed that there was given no room for discussion. The show's host was a former Calvinist"* and his name is Dr. David Anders and I'm not sure it's his fault, because he was raised in the Protestant tradition and since Vatican II, the Catholic Church has adopted the King James translation of Genesis 3:15. So, where is he going to get the truth? I mean, is he going to watch my program? Because that's, as far as I know, the only place you're going to find out the truth. *"The show's host was a former Calvinist"* as I said, *"he is not totally familiar with the Bible pre-Reformation."* And the Church taught for 2,000 years that it is "she", that is Mary, who will crush the serpent.

Well anyway, let's take a look at this brief clip from EWTN. *"Here is Steve in Sandy Hook, Connecticut. Steve says 'I continue to listen and*



enjoy your show. I would like your opinion about different translations of Genesis 3:15. Older Catholic translations have the verse saying "she" will crush the head of the serpent, while newer ones seem more in line with Protestant translations that say, "her seed will crush the

head of the serpent". I asked a Catholic friend of mine. He hadn't realized newer versions had changed the wording, so I looked it up in some Catholic theology websites; I could not really get a concise answer on the topic, so I would like your opinion. Thanks for your show. Steve in Connecticut.' Yeah it's 'he'. It is 'he'? It is 'he'. Yeah, he will crush the head of the serpent. The prophecy refers to the seed of the Virgin, namely the Messiah. Okay, very good."

Well, I do say Dr. Anders did not seem too sure of himself when he said "he". Maybe he knows that he is not familiar with the passage and that he is kind of shooting in the dark. In any case, let's take a look at Genesis 3:15 and how it should be interpreted.

"I will put enmity between you and the woman". Now, this is Almighty God speaking, and it's the Trinity because we know earlier in the passage it says "we will create man in our image and likeness". So this includes Jesus;. **"between your seed and her seed:"**. Now I used to think that the woman's seed, who is Mary, was Jesus but that is not true. Jesus is the one telling this. He is the one putting the enmity between the serpent and the woman. "I will put enmity" and he's not talking about Himself. Mary's seed is the remnant Catholic Church, and of course Satan's seed is the One World Tyranny which we will defeat, **"she will crush your head and you will lie in wait for her heel"**.

So, EWTN, I hope you correct Dr. Anders. I think he will accept correction. If he knows the Protestant tradition, he knows, for example, he should be familiar with the book of Judges where Jael drives a tent peg into Sisera's forehead and kills him. That is a prefiguring also of Mary crushing the head of the serpent. There are two different types of prophecy in scripture. One has to do with Jesus being crushed for our sins, and the other has to do with Mary crushing the serpent and Queen Deborah calls Jael "blessed among women of the tent". That

also prefigures Mary's title "blessed among all women". And Jesus refers to his mother as "the woman". That's because she is the woman back in Genesis, the first book of the Bible and the woman in Revelation 12:1
