

Decode of Heidi Begley's Blood Moon Prophecy Dream

I do have a quite an interesting program I think today and that is about a prophetic dream that Pastor Paul Begley's wife received. Her name is Heidi Begley and she received this dream I think four days ago, so the Begley's put out their dreams a lot quicker than Dana Coverstone does. Dana Coverstone takes sometimes two or three weeks, but his dreams are of course, a lot more complicated.

This is a very short dream, but it's still I think it's prevalent with a lot of deep meaning and neither Paul nor Heidi Begley understood the dream, but that's to be expected. I mean prophets don't understand their prophecies. We know that from Daniel. The prophet Daniel in the Old Testament; he complained to the angel. He wanted the angel to explain his vision to him, and the angel said, "Go your way

Daniel. The vision is for another time." In other words, our time, and Dana Coverstone does not understand his dreams either, so this is a very short dream and I will go through it right now, and I have quite a bit to say about it.

We as Remnant Catholics; we are involved in this dream. It's really about us being taken to our refuges, so that's why I was very interested in it. So here is the dream.

"I dreamed I was going to see my friend, a priest, and he had with him an Orthodox priest as well. When they saw me they both collapsed on me weeping because of the persecution that was coming. And I said, "It's okay", and I started jumping up and down hard on the earth" As Heidi said, she jumped up and down on the earth, she said "and an underground room opened, and I said to them, 'the Earth will help you now'."

And that's all of the rest of the dream; a very short dream. Well now what is this underground room? Doesn't it strike you that this is a refuge? That's the first thing I immediately thought of. This is protection and we'll see that this is referenced in the Book of Revelation in a few minutes. In fact the Lord told Heidi to look at the Book of Revelation.

And in this dream, it seems to me that Heidi is kind of taking Mary's place, as I've often said that the woman who flees into the desert is Mary and she represents the remnant Catholic Church. That's us in other words. And she is the one that protects us in the desert, and here we see that Heidi is kind of taking Mary's place in this dream, which is kind of interesting.

And I got to thinking; well how many letters are there in Heidi's name? And you notice there's H-e-i-d-i, five letters. Well that's Mary's number in Bible prophecy. And I've got another question for you; do you know what the name Heidi means? Heidi means "graceful", in other words, full of grace. Would you believe that? When I read that, I said, "This is amazing", and of course that's Mary's title, Hail Mary, full of grace. "Heidi" means full of grace. I couldn't believe that.

Anyway I did learn something interesting in this and that is that the Orthodox priest is included. Now I've always thought that only the remnant Catholic Church would be protected in the desert, but according to this dream the Orthodox are included and I got to thinking. I said "Could this is this possible?" And the Orthodox do have a tremendous reverence for Mary. Is Mary going to protect them also in the desert? The desert of course is what we all flee to.

So I thought I would look up a few of the amazing icons which the Orthodox use. Now you won't find anything like this in any Protestant church. I always grouped the Orthodox in with the Protestants, and that may have been a big mistake on my part. For example here's a typical icon.

I'm not sure if this is Eastern Orthodox. There are quite a few different Orthodox groups. I don't know if this is Russian Orthodox or Eastern Orthodox. Let me show you another one.

And images of Mary, I don't think you'll find them in any Protestant church. I was reading about these icons which the Orthodox have and the article I read said that, for example every Russian home has a picture of some Russian icon; some famous icon, very much like we Catholics have pictures of Jesus, Mary and Joseph for example. So we

do have, I think, more in common with the Orthodox than with the Protestants for example. The question I want to ask is, do you think the Catholics and the Orthodox are going to unite?



Paul Begley says that this Friday there is a Blood Moon, and I didn't know about that until I saw Begley's program. And this is the longest Blood Moon in a thousand years he said, and it lasts for three and one half hours, which is really long. He asked the question, "Do you suppose the three and one half hours symbolizes the three and a half years of Great Tribulation?" That's very possible.

He said the last Blood Moon that was almost as long as this one, occurred in 1054, and he said, "Do you know what happened in 1054?" Well that was the Great Schism between the Catholics and the Orthodox. Isn't that interesting? Maybe there is something tremendously significant about this Blood Moon and maybe it's the healing between the Orthodox and the Catholics.

I want to go over now to look at the Book of Revelation, because Paul said that Heidi asked the Lord right after she received the dream, to explain it to her, and God told her to look at the Book of Revelation chapter 12. So let's look at that.

Revelation 12:14 "And they were given to the woman two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the desert unto her place, where she is nourished for a time, times and half a time, from the face of the serpent."

So we see here quite a few of the elements that are in Heidi's dream already. "The woman", whom I think Heidi represents; I've always said that was Mary; the two wings of the eagle represent Mary's rosary and scapular; we see the time frame, three and a half years, possibly symbolized by the three and a half hours of the Blood Moon, and we will be protected from the serpent.

Let's look at the next verse.

Revelation 12:15 “And the serpent cast out of his mouth after the woman, water as it were a river; that he might cause her to be carried away by the river.

12:16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the river, which the dragon cast out of his mouth.”

So, this certainly seems like what Heidi saw. The earth opens up and that is very much like what Heidi saw; a great opening in the earth, which struck me like a cave and Heidi called it “a room”. And I've read this passage about the earth opening her mouth and swallowing up the river which the dragon, that would be Satan, cast out of his mouth. I always recognize it as persecution or lies, but I never understood exactly how the earth was involved, but now I think this is a passage in the Bible that describes a refuge, but at least that's the way Heidi describes it.

Okay let me continue with one of the groups. I thought what we could do is, we could look and see the other groups and there are 144,000 people in each of the groups, who are going to reign with Jesus during the Millennium. Now I claim that what Heidi saw was one of those groups, and that is the protected Catholics. Let's look and see if any of the other groups of whom there are 144,000; let's see if they might be what Heidi is referring to. I think we'll see that they are not. So, in Revelation 7, this is the next group I'm going to look at. Now this is after John sees the 144,000 Jews who are sealed.

Revelation 7:9 “After this I saw a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and tribes, and peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne, and in sight of the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands:”

So the key group here is that this group is not numbered. So this group is not one of the four groups who reign with Jesus during the Millennium. This is I guess you could call it, the fifth group, because this group are in Heaven, and they are of all nations, tribes, peoples and tongues and so on, so they're not Catholics or the Orthodox. And they wear white robes

and they wear (carry) palms, but I have said all along, they suffer a dry martyrdom. These are not the martyrs who are beheaded by the Antichrist for example.

Revelation 7:13 “And one of the ancients answered, and said to me: These that are clothed in white robes, who are they? and whence came they?”

7:14 And he said to me: These are they who are come out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and have made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.”

So, they are martyrs in Heaven but they are made white by the Blood of the Lamb, not their own blood. And the Great Tribulation in this passage is the period that we are now entering, and Jesus uses that same term by the way in Matthew 24, the Great Tribulation. And He says it's the worst time in the entire history of mankind. So let's look and see what these martyrs do die from.

Revelation 7:14 “And he said to me: These are they who are come out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

7:16 They shall no more hunger nor thirst, neither shall the sun fall on them, nor any heat.”

So now we see what they do die from. They die from famine. And why did they die from famine? Because they don't take the Mark of the Beast. They flee into the desert, but they die. They're not protected by Mary. So this is a huge group according to the Book of Revelation. They die from heat or fire, because they are in the desert, and it says the sun falls on them. They don't have to worry about the sun falling on them anymore. I suspect that the sun falling on them, was the End Times comet.

So this is not the group that Heidi saw, because this is a group of unnumbered. It's not numbered. We don't know how many there are; a huge group. In other words, most the people, even though they do not take the Mark of the Beast, they are going to be forced into the desert,

but they still are not going to survive into the Millennium, even though they have an honored place in Heaven. They wear white robes and palms in their hands, but they were not protected by Mary as the Orthodox priests and the Catholic priests are. So let's look at the next verse.

Revelation 7:3 “Saying: Hurt not the earth, nor the sea, nor the trees, till we seal the servants of our God in their foreheads.”

Now this is another group, and these are the converted Jews.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them that were sealed, 144,000 were sealed, of every tribe of the children of Israel.”

So now is this the group that Heidi saw? Obviously not, because these are the 144,000 sealed of the children of Israel. These are the Jews who are saved in the End Times, the remnant of Israel. Notice that they are sealed but they're not converted at this time. I used to think that they were converted at this time, but they are not converted according to Zechariah until they see the wounds in Jesus' hands and feet, so obviously this is not the group.

We're looking at the various groups that might be represented by who Heidi saw, and they are not the huge group that's in Heaven, nor are they this group of Israel. So now let's look at another group of 144,000.

Rev 14:1 And I beheld, and lo a lamb stood upon Mount Sion, and with him 144,000 having his name, and the name of his Father, written on their foreheads.”

So this is a different group of 144,000. You can look at hundreds of false videos on YouTube saying that these 144,000 are the same as the converted Jews and they're not. And how do we know that? Because they have the name of God the Father and the Son on their foreheads. As I say, the Jews are not converted until later when they see the wounds in Jesus hands. Now here's another group. Now this is the same group that we just saw. This is the 144,000 who are returning with Jesus on Mount Sion.

Revelation 20:4 “And I saw seats ... and the souls of them that were beheaded for the testimony of Jesus, and for the word of God, and who had not ... received his mark on their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.”

So, this group does reign during the Millennium and this is another group of 144,000. They have the name of the Lamb and the Father written on their foreheads. They are not the Jews but they are martyrs. Now these don't suffer a dry martyrdom. They are beheaded. This is what we call a wet martyr. These are the martyrs who do survive into the Millennium, because they are martyred by the Antichrist, and John says they do not take the Mark of the Beast. These Martyrs who are killed by the Antichrist, they are not protected, so they can't be the group that Heidi sees. That's the point I'm making here.

So we've seen two groups so far. We've seen the 144,000 converted Jews. They are not the group that Heidi saw, and we've seen the 144,000 who are martyrs; martyrs of the Antichrist. So far neither of these is the ones that Heidi saw. So now we're going to see another group of 144,000.

Revelation 14:2 “And I heard a voice from Heaven, as the noise of many waters, and as the voice of great thunder, and the voice which I heard, was as the voice of harpers, harping on their harps.

14:3 And they sung as it were a new song, before the throne, and before the four living creatures, and the ancients, and no man could sing the song, but those 144,000 who were purchased from earth.”

So these are not the 144,000 martyrs who are standing with Jesus on Mount Zion returning for the battle of Armageddon. And how do we know that? Because they are in a different location. This group is in Heaven, and that term “purchased” tells us who they are. 144,000 were purchased from Earth. “Purchased” is John's code word for “Raptured”. In other words, these are the raptured Protestants. Okay let's look at that verse,

Revelation 14:4 “These are they who were not defiled with women for they are virgins. These follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These were purchased from among men, the first fruits to God and to the Lamb:

14:5 And in their mouth there was found no lie; for they are without spot before the throne of God.”

So there's the code word for raptured and that is “purchased”. So we know that these are the raptured Protestants. And now why does John say that they go wherever the Lamb goes? Well that's kind of interesting because they are in Heaven and the 144,000 martyrs are with Jesus standing on Mount Sion. The reason John adds that they follow the Lamb wherever he goes is because they are not yet with Jesus on Mount Sion. I suspect that they're late to the party because they're at the party, the marriage supper of the Lamb, and what John is doing is, he is reassuring us that this group will soon be with Jesus at the Battle of Armageddon.

Again there are three groups of 144,000 who join with Jesus at the Battle of Armageddon. Now was this the group that Heidi saw? I don't think so. This is also not the 144,000 that Heidi leads to protection. And I thought I would show you where these three groups are that who do join with Jesus. The Holy martyrs that are standing with Jesus on Mount Sion; 144,000 of them, the 144,000 raptured Protestants who are about to join Jesus at the Battle of Armageddon and the 144,000 protected Catholics, They are the group that Heidi leads to protection.

So those are the three groups of 144,000 each who are with Jesus at the Battle of Armageddon. Now I've mentioned before, the converted Jews there's 144,000 of them also. They are not at the Battle of Armageddon, because they do not convert until after Armageddon.

Now the reason I say that there are 144,000 of the protected Catholics (and Orthodox I have to add now), is by extrapolation. In other words, in the other two groups there are 144,000 of them, and there are 144,000 of the converted Jews. By extrapolation I believe there will also be

144,000 protected Catholics and Orthodox in the desert. So now let's see where Jesus refers to it, and I've done this many times on this program. I've shown you where these three groups are found in Matthew 24.

Matthew 24:31 “And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of Heaven to the other.”

So did you get that? Jesus' angels are going to gather those who are under the four winds. That would be the protected Catholics. This is the group that Heidi sees. They are on this earth. They are in fact in the ground. Heidi sees them. That's their refuge. They will be gathered from the earth. They are not the huge number who went to Heaven probably because of the comet or the sun or the heat or whatever sends them up there. They are protected in the ground.

Those in one end of Heaven would be the raptured Protestants. They are the ones that are about to join Jesus, and the Holy martyrs who are with Jesus on Mount Sion. So those are the three groups that Jesus says will be with him at Armageddon. And we see the same group referred to, in that second passage here.

Revelation 17:14 “These shall fight with the Lamb,” that is, they fight with Jesus, alongside the Lamb, **“and the Lamb will overcome them”**, that is the forces of the Antichrist, **“because he is Lord of Lord and kings of kings and they that are with him are called elect and faithful.”**

So there's more verification of the three groups. Who are the three groups who are with Jesus at Armageddon? The Called, the Elect, and the Faithful; the Called are the raptured Protestants. They are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb, The Elect, those are the ones that Heidi saw, the ones who are protected by Mary in a refuge in the desert, and the Faithful are those who are faithful to death, and that would be the Holy martyrs,

Okay so that is my conclusion of my interpretation of Heidi's dream. I went a little off topic. Well it's not really off topic, but I wanted to go over, to kind of eliminate the groups that Heidi did not see, and therefore the group that she had to see, would be the protected Catholics. And she saw us in one of our refuges; in a room, in the ground.

So thanks so much to Paul Begley for our reporting on this, and letting us know about Heidi's dream and thanks to Heidi for receiving this dream. I do believe it came from the Holy Spirit. I think it's very significant for all of us in these End Times, and I'm not sure if we will see a reunification of the Orthodox and the Catholics during the Blood Moon coming up, I believe this Friday, but maybe that's one of the meanings to Heidi's dream.

I hope you enjoyed that dream. Weren't you amazed at what the word "Heidi" means? I couldn't believe that when I looked that up. I said I wonder what "Heidi" means, and I looked it up and it said "graceful" which is "full of grace". So she was taking Mary's place in this dream. She was showing safety to the remnant Catholic priest and the Orthodox priest, both of whom will face persecution.
