

Mary's School of Prophecy Hermeneutics of End Times Prophecy Pt 2

This will be part 2 in my series on the Hermeneutics of End Times Prophecy and how it is different from every other type of prophecy in Scripture, and in fact there's a subsection which I guess you can call hermeneutics of apocalyptic literature, which is even more complicated, and we will cover most of that I hope in this program. I was reading some of the comments and someone thought we were going to start with Isaiah 45, and I have not prepared that yet. I think that will be a complicated session and I want to look at it quite carefully especially because it's pertinent to Donald Trump today, and when Donald Trump, or I should say Q-Anon says, "It's going to be Biblical", I think he is referring to Isaiah 45 and Micah 5. Now yesterday we looked at some of the characteristics of End Times prophecy.

This lesson is in volume 2 chapter 12 of my books. The volume is "My People Perish Through Lack of Knowledge", because I'm going to use those charts in that chapter to illustrate how the prophecies are sealed up and that's part of the attributes of End Times prophecy. Now let's look at this chart. I have listed the attributes of interpreting the hermeneutics of End Times prophecy. Hermeneutics simply means the rules for interpretation, and as I say they are different than the rest of the Bible and the rest of prophecy in the Bible. So here is what I came up with and I went through some of these yesterday, and I added a few more and we're going to go over a specific one today. So here are the seven that I have enumerated.



I think there might be one or two more which I have discovered, and the first is sacred numerology. As I mentioned John mentions in the Book of Revelation that you need wisdom and understanding and he is talking about sacred numerology. The second: the symbolic interpretation always takes precedence over the literal interpretation. Number 3: Mary's important role in End Times prophecy is usually designated by the number 555 defeating the number 666 which represents the Antichrist. Number 4: you need a co-prophet because End Times prophecy is a work of the Holy Spirit, and you need two people. The Holy Spirit always works through two people. Now 5 is extrapolation: I haven't discussed that yet; maybe I will do that tomorrow rather than to go into Isaiah 45, because as I say I want to

study that a little more. Number 6: you have to rearrange the chapters and verses. Now that is for apocalyptic literature, which as I say is a subset. And number 7 is kind of a vague term in it in a way. It describes all the previous ones, and that's because one of the characteristics of the Holy Spirit is mystery.

So let's start in with Daniel and how he rearranged the chapters and verses, and we already did this for Daniel chapter number 9. First of all there are 12 chapters in Daniel. In the Catholic bible, chapters 13 and 14 are **about** Daniel. They are not **by** Daniel, and this is one place where I think the Protestant bibles are correct. Some of them leave them out. I don't think you should leave them out, but I think they should be separated, so that people don't confuse them. The 12 chapters of Daniel are prophecies. They are by Daniel, not about him. The first six chapters are called the history chapters. The last six chapters are called the vision chapters.

Now the first six chapters, that's End Times prophecy but it is not apocalyptic literature. In other words you don't have to rearrange the chapters and the verses. The last six chapters are. And you have to rearrange the chapters and verses to understand the prophecy, and we discovered that already in Daniel. So let's take a look at Daniel 7, and you'll see what we mean.

Now this is the Daniel 7 Verse Structure Chart, and on the left-hand side, you have the first 11 verses of Daniel 7, and notice that in verse number 6 the word "four" is mentioned twice. And we discovered that the word "four" is mentioned two other times in verse 17 and in verse 23. So I did a lot of experimenting figuring out what is the correct way to do this. For example there are 28 verses total, and the first thing I looked at was four columns of seven verses each; seven columns of four verses each, and I did various permutations and combinations, and then I noticed that those three verses have the word "four" in them and none of the other verses do, and by lining them up, ..four..four..four..four.. and ..fourth..fourth, you come up with a lot of interesting prophecies.

In order to get those verses to line up, 6, 17 and 23, you have to start a second column with verse number 12 down to 17, and then you have to start a third

column with 18 down through 28. In that way the three lines, line up. And do we count those verses? And you'll see that once again 666 is followed by, in this case 55. Let's take a look at that. Notice how in the left column, verses 1 through 6 and the **sixth** verse is ..four..four.. and in the second column 12 through 17, **six** verses, the 17th verse, it has those two words in it, and in the third column 18 through 23, **six** more verses. And at the bottom, you have 7 through 11, **five** verses and 24 through 28, **five** verses.

So once again we see quite a few of the requirements of interpreting the hermeneutics of End Times prophecy. You have numerology; you have Mary indicated and you must rearrange the chapters and the verses, but that's not the only reason to rearrange the chapters and the verses. I'm not going to go into this on this program, but for example, if you're reading down the verses, verse number 7, and you look over to the verse that follows it horizontally, that's verse number 24, you will discover that verse 24 follows verse 7 much better than verse number 8. In the same way with verse number 8. Verse 8 is followed by verse number 25 much better, and the same with 9, 10 and 11 and 26 and 27 and 28. And that's how we know that this is the correct organization of these verses.

So let's look at some more of Daniel. Let me first show you how I am going to indicate these verses, and I did all of these vision chapters this way.

I have the numbers of the verses on the left, just as you saw before, and then for the writing part, I just put in X's. I'm not sure if this is the best way to do it, but this way I organized all the chapters the same way, so that you will know what I'm talking about and how I am doing it.

So let's look at now the next chapter which is chapter number 8, and we'll look at how the verse chart for that chapter is arranged.

And as you can see, verses 1 through 13 are on the left. At the bottom verse number 14 is a hinge verse, and on the right as a chiasm, starting with verse 15, the verses are all backwards, 15, 16 and 17 and so on up to verse number 27. And once again with 27 verses, there are other possibilities.

I could have had nine columns with three verses each or three columns with nine verses each and I'm not sure if I'd ever discovered a chiasm before, but that's a typical Hebrew literary device, and I worked it out that way. I tried it, and sure enough that is the way Daniel sealed up his prophecies. What we are doing is we are unsealing Daniel. We are doing the first part of that wisdom that John says you may need; wisdom and then you need understanding.

So let's look at that chart again. Verses 1 and 2 are related to 17 and 26 on the right; 3 through 8 are related to 25 through 20 on the right; 9 to 13 on the left are related to 19 through 15 on the right and 14 stands alone at the bottom. So let's just interpret just on the face of it, what does that structure mean? While it's interesting that on the top you have four verses, 1, 2, 26 and 27. Just below that in the two columns you have 12 verses, in other words 66. Below that you have 10 verses, in other words 55, and below that you have one verse, verse number 14.

So this is kind of unique, and this includes the number 4 and the number 1, and I believe that this is more of a complete prophecy of the End Times in other words 4 would be mankind; 2 + 2. I think it also could refer to the third beast, the beast that comes just before the Antichrist in Daniel 7, and that would be Barack Obama. He's the 44th president. The leopard has 4 heads and 4 wings. I think that's what the four verses stand for.

Just below that of course are the 12 verses; 6 + 6. That refers to the reign of the Antichrist. He's the fourth beast, the last beast in Daniel 7. He comes immediately after Barack Obama, and then as usual, there are 10 verses which are 5 and 5 indicating Mary's Rosary, which will defeat the Antichrist, and then there's one verse at the bottom. And I believe that continues the prophecy into the Millennium, where there will be one flock and one shepherd. In other words we will eventually

have a One-World Government and One World Religion all under the leadership of Jesus Christ and I think that's what the 1 stands for. So this is kind of unique. The verse structure indicates all of the End Times.

So now let's look at chapter number 9. Now this we've done before so I'll just do this very briefly. We've gone over the structure of Daniel quite a bit and he used pairs rather than chiasm as I'm sure you know.

On the left-hand side, that left column, there are six pairs. In the center those are not paired. They are separate and then he resumes a paired construction for the last ten verses, and this does two things. It shows us that again 66, that is the first 12 verses are followed by five verses, followed by ten verses on the end in pairs, which would be 55. So we see 66 the number of the Antichrist, followed by 5 5 5. And the other purpose of this verse structure is to show that 11 and 12, 16 and 17, 26 and 27 on the bottom; those are the End Times verses. So once again this is how Daniel sealed up his prophecies through hidden verse structures. It not only indicates that Mary will defeat the Antichrist, but it shows us that those six verses at the bottom of those columns, those are the End Times prophecies.

So now I'm going to jump up to chapter number 11 which is very interesting. We haven't discussed that yet on this program, and this is another complicated, very interesting system. On the right-hand column, verses 33, 38 and 43; they are the key to understanding the structure, because there are four items in each of those verses. Those four items separate and mark off the verses around them, so that you have a sequence of 5 5 5. It also indicates that the first four verses are marked off and therefore the first 12 verses are in the left-hand column 4 4 4, followed by the 18 verses in the middle, 6 6 6, followed by the 15 verses at the end which indicates once again, Mary's Rosary.

So this also brings in the number 4 4 4 which indicates Barack Obama and the United States and mankind, 2 + 2 indicates mankind, followed by the Antichrist, 6 6 6. The reign of the Antichrist is next followed by Mary's Rosary which defeats the Antichrist.

So now we're going to look at the two chapters we haven't looked at which are chapters 10 and 12 and this is really unique because chapters 10 and 12 are actually the same chapter. And I'm not the only one who discovered this. In fact I think Joe deCephas may have discovered it before I did, and he said that chapter 12 must follow chapter number 10 and he's right. I'm not sure if he understands that chapters 10 and 12 are actually the same chapter, and I don't think he understands that chapter 12 must be printed in reverse as a chiasm. Let's look at that.

On the left hand side you have 17 verses and we have six verses at the top followed by six more verses followed by five verses at the bottom. And on the right hand column, you have six verses at the top, followed by six verses, followed by five verses. In other words four sixes followed by two fives. So once again the verse structure indicates Mary's Rosary defeating the Antichrist, and if you study the verses, it also explains the prophecy. And perhaps the most important prophecy of this whole chapter number 10/12 is chapter 10 verse number 3 near the top of the left-hand column where Daniel says, "I ate no desirable bread and neither flesh nor wine entered into my mouth and neither was I anointed with oil", and that is of course about the False Prophet taking the daily sacrifice away from the prince.

And we know that's what it is if you read the verse in the right-hand column. That would be verse number 11 of chapter 12, which talks about the daily sacrifice being taken away from the prince.

So now what's interesting is since 10 and 12 are the same chapter, that means there's only five vision chapters. We know that there are six history chapters, and now we know there are only five vision chapters, and of course what does that tell you?

So when we look at the chapter chart, that gives us the exact same message as all of these other charts and all of these other rearrangements of verses.

So now let's look at the chapter chart .and as you can see, there are six verses followed by five verses. So even the chapter numbers themselves indicate that Mary's Rosary is the weapon Jesus will use to defeat the Antichrist.

So now from the Hermeneutics of End Times prophecy, we looked at number 6, and we will be looking tomorrow at extrapolation, one of the characteristics of End Times prophecy. And I have never done a video on extrapolation but it is extremely important. That's how we know for example in Jeremiah 23 that the False Prophet, who would be Cardinal Wormwood is a Catholic priest, and that's through

extrapolation. That is a legitimate characteristic of End Times prophecy.
