

How to Understand Bible Prophecy

I am starting a new series today, today is Saturday, November the 1st, on 'Understanding Bible Prophecy'. And I doubt if I am going to get it finished before my channel on the Internet is shut down but it is still important for you to understand how to understand the End Times prophecies in Scripture. The reason it's important is because once the Antichrist takes over and the Catholic Church and the United States and Britain are all taken down, many people will want to understand the Bible, who are completely in the dark now. And then you will have a tremendous advantage over others because you will know the basic rules even though my channel will not be around. There will be a lot of false prophets around but they will not have the true answers that you will have.

And there are seven basic rules: three rules that always apply and four more rules that very often apply. The first of these seven rules on my list is 'Symbolism' and you must understand that the symbolic interpretation of End Times Bible Prophecy takes precedence over the literal interpretation. For example, in the Book of Revelation, there are 15 End Times chapters, that is chapters 6 through 20. In those chapters the symbolic interpretation takes precedence over the literal.

By contrast, In the first five chapters, this is not true. Then the literal interpretation takes precedence, for example, the seven churches that John writes letters to are real churches; but in the next 15 End Times chapters the Church is still present but it's not so obvious. Don't listen to the false prophets; the entire Church will NOT be raptured and the 'left behind' Church is still to be found in these chapters but under hidden symbolism.

The second very important characteristic is 'Sacred Numerology'. The reason I say 'Sacred' is because Satan has hijacked numerology and if I use just the word 'numerology', I get criticized because people say all numerology is satanic. The four most important numbers in Bible Prophecy are 4, 7, 12, and 28, as I have mentioned many times on this program, and that's because those are the last numbers in chronological sequences. The fourth week of a month is the LAST week. The seventh day of a week is the LAST day. The twelfth month of a year is the LAST month and the 12th hour is the LAST hour of a day, and 28 is a multiple of 4 and 7.

And there is a corollary to numerology being very important: you cannot add or subtract to the literature and Saint John points this out very well in his book of Revelation when he says, '***If you add or take away from the words in this chapter, the plagues in this chapter will fall upon you.***' It's important to note he is not talking about interpretation, he is talking about numerology. And I always give the example of the Navarre Bible translation which has five 'blesseds' in those 15 End Times chapters and that is a huge error because there are only four 'blesseds'. Those four 'blesseds' refer to the Raptured Protestants, the Protected Catholics, the holy martyrs and the converted Jews.

And the third rule which is always enforced is that you need a Co-Prophet to understand End Times Bible Prophecy. That's because End Times prophecy is a work of the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit always requires two people, very much the same as speaking in tongues. Saint Paul says: '***speaking in tongues has no edification for the church unless someone interprets***'. In other words, it takes two people and the same way with prophecy, even with the words of our Lord Himself in the Olivet Discourse. His prophecies must be interpreted by a Co-Prophet. And I've never said I am the only Co-Prophet; for example, Jody Sephus understands that the chapters in Daniel must be rearranged and very few, if any, other scholars understand this. But, once the Internet is taken away, YOU will have to be a Co-Prophet and that's exactly why I am doing this series.

Now that you know those three rules which are always true, let's look at four more rules which are almost always true and the first of these is 'Dual Meaning'. And sometimes there's even more than two meanings, sometimes there are three or four meanings, and I'm going to talk about, on this program, a prophecy that has four fulfillments. Sometimes the prophet tells you what those interpretations are, for example, the Scarlet Beast in the book of Revelation has seven heads and John tells you that those seven heads symbolize seven kings and they also symbolize seven mountains.

And there's a corollary to the dual meaning rule: there are two or more fulfillments very often to verify the End Times Prophecy and this is especially true with Daniel. The near time fulfillment of the prophecy occurs near to the time the prophecy is given and for us has already come true, historically speaking, therefore promising that the End Times fulfillment will also come true.

And the next rule which is not always true but almost always true is that the chronology of End Times Bible Prophecy is not quite correct. For example, in Daniel's six vision chapters, he even indicates in the beginning what king is reigning at the time of the prophecy. Thus, all you have to do is to rearrange the chapters so that historically we know in which sequence they should be read. And there is a corollary to the chronology not being in its correct position: you must rearrange the chapters and the verses. This helps you understand the chronology but also very often gives you an End Times Prophecy in and of itself.

And that End Times Prophecy rule very often leads to rule number six: Mary's Rosary will defeat the Antichrist (1). Now, I've never said that Jesus does not defeat the Antichrist: but the weapon He will use is Mary's Rosary just as David chose five, smooth pebbles to defeat Goliath.

And the seventh rule is 'Mystery'. End Times Bible Prophecy is a work of the Holy Spirit and one of the chief characteristics of the Holy Spirit is mystery. And all you have to do is look at, for example, statues that are made out of gold and silver and bronze and iron and clay. All you have to look at the image of a **'Woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and on her head a crown of twelve stars'**. Or look at the beasts in Revelation which have seven heads and ten horns. All this mysterious imagery not only helps in our understanding but it helps to etch those memories into our mind. Those images become very real and the Holy Spirit knows exactly what he is doing.

And so, in conclusion, as I said, I am going to do a video program on each of the seven rules, the three rules that are always in place and the four rules that are almost always true and believe me, you will need to know how to do this because there will be very few people in your community after all of these things come about, after the Whore of Babylon is burned with fire in one hour, after the Internet is shut down. People will be clamouring for information and hopefully you will know yourself how to understand Bible Prophecy. You will be the Co-Prophet in your community.

Hold everything, I forgot to tell you about the prophecy that has four different fulfillments and that is when our Lord says, **'Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up again'**. So I will give you that as an assignment rather than discussing it here on this program

and I will review your answers and my answer in the next program because it is a very amazing prophecy with four different fulfillments.

1) I am not downgrading Mary by putting this specific rule as low as number six because Mary is often found hidden within the other rules as well.
