

## Bishops Respond to Heresy of Pope Francis

This past week several more groups of bishops have come out either supporting Pope Francis and his initiative to give Communion to divorced and remarried Catholics or in support of the Gospel and 2,000 years of Church teaching.

So let's begin. This is from LifeSiteNews and they are a very valuable resource for information on this topic; I check them out every day.

And this is datelined Friday, September the 9th, and this is a quote from Pope Francis: '**No other interpretation of Amoris Laetitia then allowing Communion for divorced and remarried in some cases.**' Pope Francis is finally coming out and clearly supporting his heresy. And let me just read a few paragraphs from this interesting article: '**In a letter reportedly leaked by a priest in Argentina, Pope Francis writes that there is no other interpretation of Amoris Laetitia other than one admitting divorced and remarried Catholics to Holy Communion in some cases. The letter, dated September 5th, comes in response to a confidential document by the bishops of the Buenos Aires pastoral region to priests instructing them on the application of the Pope's controversial apostolic exhortation.**' In other words, these bishops in Buenos Aires are doing exactly what Tim Staples said in my last program; they are going to allow Communion for divorced and remarried. '**The leaked document is the first time there is explicit confirmation that Pope Francis interprets Amoris Laetitia as allowing Communion for divorced and remarried Catholics without the condition that the couple in the irregular situation live as brother and sister without sexual relations, as was always required by the Church.**'

This is a huge, sea change, and only the False Prophet would come up with this idea. In fact, I've been telling you all along that the entire purpose of those two bishops synods was to bring about this desecration of the Eucharist so that it would be invalid, just as King Henry VIII did in England 500 years ago. And now, I'm going to read paragraph 6 from this document from the bishops in Buenos Aires and you can see that this is almost exactly the same arguments that Tim Staples used on his Catholic Answers program.

**'In other, more complex circumstances** (they love complex circumstances) **and when it is not possible to obtain a declaration of nullity** (in other words, an annulment) **the aforementioned option may not in fact be feasible. Nonetheless, it is equally possible to undertake a journey of discernment.** (This is like the internal forum. Priests can now give annulments, basically) **If one arrives at the recognition that, in a particular case there are limitations that diminish responsibility and culpability, particularly when a person judges that he would fall into a subsequent fault by damaging the children of the new union, Amoris Laetitia opens up the possibility of access to the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist.** (And the bishops here note the footnotes 336 and 351, that devilish footnote with the number opposite of Mary's Rosary number, 153) **These in turn dispose the person to continue maturing and growing with the aid of grace'.** They are treating the Eucharist as a sacramental rather than a sacrament. Anyone can receive a sacramental but you must be qualified to receive a sacrament in the Catholic Church.

And now, this is datelined Monday, September 12, '**Vatican Radio** (this is also from LifeSiteNews) **Vatican Radio confirms Pope's leaked letter on Amoris Laetitia is authentic. On Friday, LifeSiteNews published leaked documents showing for the first time the Pope's own opinion on the matter of Holy Communion for divorced and remarried Catholics who do not qualify for annulment.** (Like Henry VIII. He did not qualify for an annulment. If he lived now, during the time of Pope Francis, it wouldn't matter) **The letter set off an explosion of comments since many held that the Pope did not agree with the thesis of Cardinal Walter Kasper of Germany which was that in certain cases Holy Communion could be administered for such couples. Many comments suggested that the letter could not be authentic.** (It turns out it is authentic) **Now, however Vatican Radio has itself reported the letter as authentic including specifically in its most controversial aspects that of allowing Communion to divorced and remarried Catholics in some cases and that there is no other interpretation other than that.** (That's the Pope's own words) **Says the Vatican radio report: Pope Francis has written a letter to the bishops of the Buenos Aires region of Argentina praising them for their document which spells out ways in which priests should apply the teachings of his apostolic exhortation, Amoris Laetitia'.**

But, not everything is bad news. Next, we'll hear from the bishops in Alberta, Canada. They are turning thumbs down on Pope Francis' suggestion of going against 2,000 years of Church teaching and going against the words of Jesus. They are opposing footnote 351 of Amoris Laetitia and this is datelined Thursday, September's 15th: **'The Catholic Church has not changed her practice towards divorced and civilly remarried Catholics despite what the faithful may have been led to believe through the media or other sources, the Alberta and Northwest Territory bishops stated in pastoral guidelines released Wednesday.** (That was this past week) **It is erroneous to conclude that divorced and civilly remarried Catholics can receive Holy Communion if they simply have a conversation with a priest, stated the guidelines signed by the six bishops responsible for over 1 million Catholics in five dioceses.**' As you can see, bishops are going to have to come out one way or another. And this is where we're getting the great schism of these end times. A lot of bishops are going to oppose Pope Francis. They are going to be the remnant Catholic Church, '**the stone cut out from a mountain**', which is going to destroy this one world tyranny and the one world religion being set up by Pope Francis.

And this article continues: **'The Alberta bishops letter is highly significant, however, because it does not mention the infamous footnote, 351 to paragraph 305 in Amoris Laetitia in which the Pope states that in certain cases this integration of divorced and civilly remarried Catholics can include the help of the sacraments. The Alberta bishops letter also stands in stark contrast to the directive from the bishops of the pastoral region of Buenos Aires in Argentina called 'Basic criteria for the application of chapter 8 of Amoris Laetitia'.**

Now, let me read from this document from the Alberta bishops. This article I got from Church Militant.com. They also cover this issue quite well.

**'If they are unable to separate for the sake of the care of children they will need to refrain from sexual intimacy and live in chastity as brother and sister.** (And then they referred to Familiaris Consortio,

paragraph 84. Well sure, they are referring back to the words of a saint, Saint Pope John Paul II. His guidelines are accurate and faithful to the gospel, unlike the False Prophet, Pope Francis) ***Such a firm resolution to live in accordance with the teachings of Christ, relying always on the help of His grace, opens to them the possibility of celebrating the Sacrament of Penance which in turn may lead to the reception of Holy Communion.***'

And I want to note that all bishops are going to have to come out one way or another. The people are going to demand it. There are going to be many divorced and remarried Catholics who are going to force the bishop's hands on this. So stay tuned. Every week I think I will probably have a report on this.
