Mary's School of Prophecy The Jaycee Dugard Parable

As previously announced I'm going to switch gears tonight and instead of talking about a famous prophet such as Daniel or Ezekiel or someone else in the Old Testament, I'm going to talk about the parable of the abduction of Jaycee Dugard, and this occurred about ten years ago. I did a <u>video</u> at the time, but a lot of people have forgotten about it and they don't understand the significance of it.

And just this week I was chatting with Carla Cacciatore here on the chat, and she said that she did not think that World War 3 would break out until after the Great Warning and I disagreed. I said Almighty God has given us many, many warnings. We don't deserve another warning. We deserve the punishment that He gives, and the parable of Jaycee Dugard I think is a good example of how God has warned us. Just because people did not listen to the warning doesn't mean that He did not warn us. It will be after the chastisement that people will understand that Almighty God has given us many, many warnings.

Well first of all, let's say the prayer that we usually begin with. I think this is a good prayer Catholic Crusader sent this, so let's join together.

The Prayer of the Lady of All Nations. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations, that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary, be our Advocate. Amen. Thanks for sending me that, and please note that Mary says she's the Queen of All Nations, plural, not the Queen of the One World Government.

Our lesson tonight I call the parable of Jaycee Dugard, and there are many indications that this is from Almighty God and a warning. So the young girl was kidnapped at the age of 11 and Phillip Garrido made her a sex slave, and her name to me is very significant. JC is a slang expression for Jesus Christ as we all know, and even her last name Jaycee Dugard sounds like JC of God. "Du" would be French for "of", Jaycee Dugard. I don't think that's accidental. That's a very clear clue that this kidnapping has prophetic significance. And she was kidnapped for 18 years, and as you, my regular subscribers know, 18 is another number for the Antichrist, 6 + 6 + 6.

Now I don't see any significance in the name Phillip Garrido. He is a pre figure of the Antichrist, but he had delusions of being a religious figure. He had a blog which he called God's Desire Church. He called himself a pastor. He had religious services for his slaves. When I say slave, Jaycee Dugard was the one who was kidnapped, but she had two daughters by Phillip Garrido. It's interesting that she named her daughters, Angel and Star something *(Starlet)*. Again names with a religious

significance. And all this happened in Antioch. Antioch is of course a name right out of the bible. Antioch was a very important city in Turkey, and as I've been saying for a long time here on YouTube, I believe Turkey is where the Antichrist will come from. And I want to read about Antioch and this is from Wikipedia. "Antioch was called the cradle of Christianity as a result of its longevity, and the pivotal role that had played in the emergence of both Hellenistic Judaism and early Christianity. The Christian New Testament asserts of the name "Christian" first emerged in Antioch."

And as I say this occurred in Antioch, California of all places. Now let me read what St. Paul says in Acts 11:26. **"And they conversed there in the church a whole year; and they taught a great multitude so that at Antioch the disciples were first named Christians."**

And, I want to show you in Daniel where a precursor of the Antichrist is called Antiochus Epiphanes, the most famous in the Old Testament precursor of the Antichrist, and we find this in Daniel chapter 11 verse 31: **"And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall defile the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the continual sacrifice, and they shall place there the abomination unto desolation."**

That's one of four places where Daniel speaks about the abomination of desolation, and that particular abomination applies to the Protestants who are raptured. All the other abominations of desolation in Daniel applied to different groups, four different groups in fact. And Jesus says, when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet, and then He gives four different flights. The first one is those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. That refers to the abomination of desolation as it affects Jews. And the second one is, let those who are on the rooftop not down for any reason. The only other direction would be up. That refers to the rapture, the raptured Protestants, and **that** is the one that Daniel's talking about when he refers to Antiochus, and the reason is because that happened 2,000 years ago. In other words the Protestants must be prepared to be raptured at any time. You can never give a date for the rapture.

So let me see if I have covered all the points I wanted to make. I mentioned that Phillip Garrido had a blog called God's Desire Church and here is another quote from Wikipedia about this kidnapping. *"Garrido made her listen out for the voices he said he could hear from the walls,"* obviously demonic *"and often professed the belief that he was a chosen servant of God."* Very interesting and it's also interesting that he was visited many times by FBI agents, by policeman, by parole officers. They could never find, they were not we're not especially looking, but there were many complaints. He was often taken to jail, in which case his wife would take over as a keeper of the captives. It wasn't until 10 years ago, in the 18th year of her captivity that several police women were alerted, and they're the first ones that knew something was not right. This is comical. He had gone to the University of California and he told them he wanted to give a lecture, and he mentioned again his pastorship, and they were alerted that something did not seem right. So anyway these two women, <u>Ally Jacobs and Lisa Campbell</u>, they said later that they followed a mother's intuition. Well to me that's very interesting that it was a mother's intuition that finally arrested Phillip Garrido. And of course we know in these End Times it's going to be a mother, Mother Mary who was going to defeat the Antichrist.

As you know in the Book of Esther, Haman and his ten sons who symbolized the ten kings of the Antichrist are hung on a scaffold that is 50 cubits high. Those 50 cubits symbolize the 50 Hail Mary's in a five decade rosary.

So I think I've gone over all the points I wanted to make on the parable of Jaycee Dugard. I said JC of God, Jaycee Du-gard and Phillip Garrido was a precursor of the Antichrist. So thank you Joanie Fingals for agreeing with me and if you want to find this in my books, it's in volume 1 page 148, and I have not added too much to what I discovered back then, but I know the Lord does use contemporary events to give warnings, and I believe that was a very significant warning. It made big headlines at the time, but no one connected the significance of their names, so society missed a huge chance. We missed a huge chance of understanding how the Antichrist will be defeated.

And the whole kidnapping was a case of the Antichrist, Garrido removing JC, Jesus Christ from society, and that's what the Antichrist does. Jesus in the Eucharist is removed from society, and that's what this parable was all about.
