

When Will Protestants be Raptured?

'When therefore you shall see, the abomination of desolation as spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place let him who reads, understand.' This will be my fourth program on the Abomination of Desolation. And, so far we have discovered that each of the four times that Daniel describes the Abomination of Desolation, he is addressing one of the four groups who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium. And, so far we have looked at the protected Catholics and the holy martyrs. On this program we will be looking at the raptured Protestants.

First, let's review where those four groups who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium are found, this time in Revelation 11, verse number 18, where John says God will 'render a reward', and the 'reward' he is talking about is the thousand years of peace. God will render reward to your '**servants**'. The servants are the converted Jews. Render reward to your '**prophets**'. The Prophets are the raptured Protestants. Render reward to your '**saints**'. The saints are the protected Catholics. And render reward to '**those who fear your name**'. And those who fear God's name would be the holy martyrs. Each of these four groups must respond to the Abomination of Desolation at a different time, because there is a different Abomination of Desolation for each group.

We've already looked at the protected Catholics and their timing was twelve hundred and ninety days until Armageddon. We looked at the holy martyrs. Their time was eleven hundred and fifty days to Armageddon. On our next program, we will look at the converted Jews, and their timing is twelve hundred and sixty days until Armageddon. So, this is great news: now we are going to be able to figure out when the Rapture occurs, because we will find out how many days it is between the Rapture and Armageddon. There's only one catch; yes, Daniel does give the number of days for most of the groups, except in one chapter: and that's chapter number 11. In fact that's how we know that chapter number 11 refers to the raptured Protestants, because Daniel does not give a date.

Let's look at Daniel, chapter 11, verse number 31: '**And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place there the abomination that makes desolate.**' Please note there are no

days mentioned here until Armageddon. And the reason is this is an historical event; this is not an End Times prophecy. The ‘his part’ in this case, is not the Antichrist nor is it the False Prophet. This is referring to an historical figure known as Antiochus Epiphanes. And this polluting of the sanctuary of the strength and taking away the daily sacrifice occurred more than twenty five hundred years ago. And the ‘abomination that makes desolate’ was in fact, Antiochus Epiphanes, himself.

So what is Daniel and our Lord telling you Protestants who are going to be raptured? He is telling you that the sign for you has already occurred twenty five hundred years ago. Please don't wait for some kind of covenant between the Antichrist and Israel or maybe the starting of a third temple with animal sacrifice. Your abomination, your warning has already occurred. You must prepare now for the Rapture. In fact, this coincides exactly with what Jesus said, that He will come like a thief in the night. You cannot know the timing of the rapture. You must prepare now. You must have your lamps full and your wicks trimmed at all times.

Now, let's take a look at the structure of Daniel chapter number 11. And I've already done this in depth on previous programs, so this will be just a quick review. And although Daniel does not use a chiasmus in this chapter, as he did in chapters 8, 10 and 12, the structure still tells the same story and that is, that Mary's Rosary will defeat the Antichrist. There is a rather startling additional prophecy however, in the structure. And that is, before Mary's Rosary defeats the Antichrist, the Antichrist will defeat Barack Obama and the United States of America.

Let's look at the first four verses of Daniel, chapter number 11. In the first four verses of Daniel chapter number 11, the prophet describes six ancient kings. Now, we are not aware of the significance of either the six kings or the four verses until much later in the chapter when we come to verse number 33, and that's where Daniel describes four items. He mentions '**sword, fire, captivity and spoil**'. This alerts us, that there may be some more important and significant numerology in this chapter. And sure enough, five verses later, Daniel lists four more objects, '**gold, silver, precious stones and things of great price**'. Five verses later, Daniel describes '**treasures, gold, silver and precious things**'. So through this numerology of four items, exactly in the middle of five verses, verses 31 through 35, 36 through 40, and 41

through 45, Daniel is setting up two different numerological sequences. A sequence of four items, 444 and a sequence of 5 verses, 555.

So now, we go back to verse number 1 and we understand the significance of the six kings and the four verses. We simply extrapolate that the four verses would be repeated twice more, 444, and that leaves 18 verses in the middle. And therefore we divide those up in the same type of a pattern 666. And, of course, what this indicates is that 666, which is the number of the Antichrist, will be defeated by the number 555, that is, the following fifteen verses, which signify Mary's rosary.

So, once again, when we read and understand, as Jesus told us to do, the Abomination of Desolation, as spoken of by Daniel, here in chapter number 11, the message is the same. Even though he is talking to Protestants, the hidden verse structure tells us, that Jesus will use Mary's Rosary to crush the Antichrist. And, the Rosary is not just for Catholics. I know Protestants who also pray Mary's rosary. In fact, I had a Baptist acquaintance once who received a locution from the blessed Virgin Mary. So, now is the time to take up our weapons. We will very shortly need them in very serious tribulation.

And now, let's take a look at the significance of those six ancient kings. The six ancient kings in the first four verses indicates that there is another 666 combination somewhere. In other words, the kings of the north, which we know there are five of, and the kings of the south, of which we know there are five, indicate that there must be one more king of the north and one more king of the south. And we find them in verses 36 through 40. Therefore we see many different 444, 555 and 666 combinations in chapter number 11.

This is the only one, however, of Daniel's End Times chapters in which the 444 sequence is found. And that indicates the destruction of the United States, because that is followed by the 18 verses in an Antichrist pattern. The reason Daniel may have included this warning to America, that it will be defeated by the Antichrist and the One World Government, is because America is a Protestant nation. And, as I said before, the Abomination of Desolation which Daniel speaks about in this particular chapter, is a warning to Protestants that they must prepare and be ready at all times for their Rapture.
