

Bible Prophecy in New Geico Commercial

I received another very interesting comment on my last video. It actually didn't have to do with the video but let me read this to you nonetheless. And this is from Bobbie Bacha and I'm not sure how she pronounces her last name. It's Bacha, that could be Backa or Bacha and here's what she wrote: ***'I found another unusual Geico number 44 confirmation just out; the man dancing was wearing a shirt with number 30 but he was dancing to number 44.'*** And then she added, ***'It's definitely a sign of 44, the Leopard King,'***

And as you my subscribers know full well, Barack Obama's number and the United States' number in Bible Prophecy is 44. That's because the Leopard has 4 heads and 4 wings in Daniel chapter 7, verse 6, and of course Obama is the last King of the South in Daniel 11, verse 40, and he will lose World War III to Vladimir Putin, the last King of the North.

And Bobbie continues: ***'but why was the number 30 dancing to 44? It was a red shirt with number 30 on it.'*** Without any further ado, let's take a look at this new Geico commercial: ***'Huh, 15 minutes could save you 15 percent or more on car insurance. Everybody knows that. Well, did you know that former pro football player, Ickey Woods will celebrate almost anything? Number 44. Woooooooh! 44, that's me! Get some cold cuts, get some cold cuts, get some cold cuts. Woooooooh, give me some! Geico. 15 minutes could save you 15 percent or more on car insurance. 44, ladies, that's me! Whoooo! Gonna get some cold cuts today.'***

Now, I doubt very much if the people who made this Geico commercial realized they were verifying Bible Prophecy, but that's what is happening here. First, let's take a look at the man dressed in white behind the meat counter. What's very interesting is his name because he is doing the work of an angel. That's why he's dressed in white and his name is Justin and you can't really see the 'in' part: in other words, this is a 'just' pronunciation.





But who does Ickey Woods, number 30, the man in red represent? Well, it's interesting that he does his victory dance when he hears the number 44. And in Daniel 11, the last King of the North, Vladimir Putin of


Russia, is provoked by the last King of the South, number 44, who represents Barack Obama and the United States. But I also believe that number 30, the man in red, symbolizes another beast.



Remember the Whore of Babylon in the book of Revelation, which is primarily Britain and America, is destroyed in one hour by the Scarlet Beast and the Scarlet Beast symbolizes International Communism. However, I

think Ickey Woods symbolizes yet a third beast. Notice the number 30. In this case, I don't believe the zero is significant. The Bear in Daniel 7, one of the three beasts which come up out of the sea, has three ribs in its mouth and those three ribs symbolize the all three beasts: the Bear, the Lion, and the Leopard. But what kind of meat is this? Let's take a closer look at the sign over Ickey Woods' head. Notice the sign says 'Kosher Meats'. This meat that Ickey Woods throws to the ground, that he 'spikes in the end zone', represents the Nation of Israel. Israel

will also be destroyed in these End Times because she has accepted the support of the Whore of Babylon. She has adopted all the decadence of the West.

And so, we see that Ickey Woods represents a fourth beast. This time another bear, a she bear that comes out of the woods, notice 'out of the woods,' in 2 Kings and that bear mauls 42 youths. That is an End Times prophecy of how the Russian bear will maul the Nation of Israel. None of this is accidental. This is a prophecy from Almighty God, a verification of His words in the Bible.

So, in conclusion, as I said at the beginning, I doubt if the makers of this Geico commercial really understood what they were doing.
