Mary's School of Prophecy Hermeneutics of End Times Prophecy Pt 3

On this program we will continue our study of hermeneutics and hermeneutics refers to the rules of interpreting usually End Times bible prophecy. It can be studying the rules of any bible understanding, but in this case it's End Times bible prophecy, and let me show the chart here.

These are the seven rules of End Times prophecy, and we've already talked about the first four, and on this program I want to talk about number 5) Extrapolation. And we've already talked about 6) Rearranging the Chapters and Verses, and of course Mystery is something which applies to all End Times prophecy. That's because it's a work of the Holy Spirit.

So before we begin I want to say our prayer. This is our prayer to Our Lady of All Nations and we'd like to start our lessons with saying this prayer. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father. Send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary be our Advocate. Amen.

Extrapolation is one of the characteristics of the hermeneutics of End Times prophecy, and the example I always give is the sin of Onan and Er. As you know Jesus said the End Times would be as in the days of Noah and he said it would be as in the days of Lot, and there's two certain characteristic about those two prophecies. Number 1 is that those are sexual sins and number 2; there's a kind of a diminishing, in other words at Noah's time **all** of the people were judged by Almighty God. At Lot's time it was **only** the people of Sodom and Gomorrah.

So the sin of Onan would fit in to that sequence even though Jesus did not say it would be as in the days of Onan. The sins of Onan and Er were sexual sins. They fit the pattern. It's a declining number, in other words we go from the entire world to just two cities and then to just two people, and God executes judgment. So we can through extrapolation say that the End Times would be as in the days of Er and Onan. That is a legitimate interpretation of End Times prophecy. Jesus was giving End Times prophecy and He did not say it would be as in the days of Onan, but we

And of course the sins of Er and Onan were masturbation and contraception. That's one example of extrapolation.

Another example of extrapolation; and I have shown you this before and this is from Jeremiah 23, and this is how we learned that Wormwood in both Jeremiah 23 and in the Book of Revelation is a Catholic priest. He must be, and we deduced that through extrapolation which is also something like solving a mathematical problem, solving for "X" so to speak. So let's look at this chart and you should be familiar with this chart because this is right out of Jeremiah 23.

And those four verses at the top from Jeremiah 23 listed all three types of End Times false prophets. And according to the code word for Protestant, Catholic and Jewish false prophets, on the left, Jeremiah used very much the same phraseology or code words that John did in the Book of Revelation. So in verse number 11, reading that vertical column, we see the word for Protestant as "prophet", and the word for Catholic is "priest", and the word for the Jewish false prophets is "my

house", or in other words as Daniel would say also, "my people".

In verse 33 we see the same three groups the Protestant false prophet is called a "prophet", the Catholic false prophet is called a "priest", the Jewish false prophet is called "this people". In verse 34, we see the same three groups. The Protestant false prophet is called "prophet". The Catholic false prophet is called "priest". By the way priest is always singular in Jeremiah 23. That's because there's only one false prophet that Jeremiah is warning about. And the Jewish false prophet in verse 34 is called the "people" and in the last verse, verse number 15, which is probably the most important verse, and of course 15 is a Rosary number, the term for Protestant is "prophets", plural. Looking at the bottom we find the term for the Jewish false prophet is the "prophets of Jerusalem". Notice by the way that Jeremiah had to add that word "Jerusalem", because if he didn't, prophets alone

And if you solve for "X", and you find out where the word "priest" should be, we find the word "Wormwood", and that is how Jeremiah tells us through extrapolation that Wormwood refers to a Catholic priest. It's not a star that falls or an asteroid or a comet, and that's the same as in the Book of Revelation it's the same Wormwood so that is what I mean by extrapolation, and you can also call it algebra, solving for "X" so to speak and I'm going to give you another example.

Now the next one we haven't discussed on this program and I've taken this chart from the video that I did. And that is, that in the End Times there are four evil entities which I'm sure you all know, the Antichrist, the False Prophet, the Scarlet Beast or the Beast from the abyss or the One World Communist tyranny in other words and Satan. Those are the four evil entities of the End Times and John expresses them usually and very often, maybe all the time, in a 3 + 1 combination. In other words, three of them will have similar or identical characteristics, and the fourth one will be different, so to speak the odd man out. And he does this with four different characteristics, and if we do the same thing, we can solve for "X" or "Y" in this, and we can get another indication of who the False Prophet is. So let's take a look at this chart.

And as you can see on the left hand column, we have the category of which ones of those four evil entities go to Hell, and of course the first one is Satan. Of course he falls back into Hell. The False Prophet is cast alive into Hell. The Antichrist is cast alive into Hell, and the Scarlet Beast at the bottom does not go to Hell. So why doesn't the Scarlet Beast go to Hell? Because it's a corporate entity; it's the One World Communist Tyranny. The followers of the Scarlet Beast will go to Hell but the Beast itself does not. So you can see there is a 3 + 1 combination. Three of the four evil entities go to Hell. The fourth one does not.

So now let's look at the next category. The next category is which of the four is called a "Beast". Well the False Prophet is called the "beast from the earth". The Antichrist is called the "beast from the sea", and of course the Scarlet Beast has the name "Beast" right in his title, but Satan is not called a beast. He's the odd man

So now let's look at the third category and that is the horn arrangement that they have. The Antichrist has seven heads and ten horns. The Scarlet Beast has seven heads and ten horns. Satan has seven heads and ten horns. How many horns does the False Prophet have? He only has two horns. So again we see a 3 + 1 combination. So John is setting up a pattern here, and it's so that we can figure out which one is in the next category and that is "Red", which one must be red.

So let's look at that last category, and that is the color red. Well of course the Scarlet Beast is red. The red is right in its name and Satan is red because he's called the Red Dragon, but John never tells us which one, whether the Antichrist is red or the False Prophet is red, but we can through extrapolation figure out which one is associated with the color red, even though John never tells us which one. He tells us of course the Scarlet Beast. He tells us the Red Dragon, but we can figure it out through extrapolation. So let's look at that chart again.

You will notice at the bottom of that chart, the odd man out in the first column was the Scarlet Beast. The odd man out in the second column was Satan. The odd man out with the horns was the False Prophet. So you see a pattern there. There are three of the four evil entities, so that means we can solve for "Y", because the fourth evil entity must fit at the bottom of that column on the right and therefore the fourth evil entity which has not been used up yet must be the Antichrist.

Consequently, now that we have solved for "Y", it's obvious that we can solve for "X". "X" must be the False Prophet. He is the one that is associated with the color red. So through extrapolation we know that the False Prophet must have something red about him and the only religious figures I can think of in the world who are associated with the color red are cardinals in the Roman Catholic Church. And that is what John is telling us. We can figure out through his 3 + 1 system and through the odd man out. It's like algebra. There are two different equations there. We can solve for "Y" and we can solve for "X".

So we know therefore from the Book of Revelation, we know that the False Prophet is a cardinal, and we know from Jeremiah 23 that the False Prophet is a Catholic priest, and I don't think anyone else has ever discovered either of those facts, and of course I think it's pretty clear that that would refer to Cardinal Wormwood, and that would be Jorge Bergoglio, the False Prophet, the current Pope, although I don't believe a true Pope. We do have a true pope, Pope Benedict. Remember when he resigned and everybody said that, oh he's on his last legs; he can't last six months; he's a dying man; he's old, he's frail; he can't be Pope anymore. Well that was six or seven years ago, and I told you at the time I said that it was all nonsense.
