

Mary's School of Prophecy Pope Francis Takes the Daily Sacrifice Away from the Prince

To start the program I'll mention what page we are on. It's volume 2, which is the book titled, "My People Perish for Lack of Knowledge", page 240, paragraph "Daniel Unsealed Chapter 8, Defeat of the Antichrist" for those of you who have your class books in hand. That's basically the chapter we'll be going over tonight.

We should start the program with a prayer to Our Lady of All Nations, because she's the patroness of this program. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary be our Advocate, Amen.

Okay, now I think we can proceed with what we are going to talk about today and that is that Pope Francis is taking the daily sacrifice away from the prince, in other words he is invalidating the Eucharist. And we saw yesterday where he has already done so in the Vatican. That means that there are no valid Eucharists in

the city of Rome, because he is the Bishop of Rome, and he has decreed that, and demonstrated it personally, that people living in mortal sin may receive Holy Communion. And the article in which I read yesterday showed the President of Argentina and his mistress who received Communion in Rome at the Vatican, and I'll show you their picture. And here they are with the Pope and he is divorced, and the two of them are not married, although she is living in the presidential palace with Fernandez.

And I also showed you this picture of where the Fatima Bishop has also decreed that people living in mortal sin may receive Holy Communion in the Diocese of Leiria-Fátima where the shrine of Fátima is located. And of course what this does, it gives Satan a tremendous victory over Mary. It's hard to believe but of course Satan is smart. He chose probably two of the best known sites in all of the Catholic Church, of course the Vatican and Fatima.

And it makes us very nervous whether Mary's prophecy in Portugal, that the dogma of the faith would always be preserved, whether we Catholics will be able to maintain that prophecy. Now the Diocese of Leiria of Fátima is just one diocese in Portugal, so it's possible that in the other dioceses, the dogma of the faith will be preserved. And of course the most important dogma of the faith, as far as the

Catholic Church goes, is that the Holy Communion, the Eucharist is the true Body and Blood of our Lord. That distinguishes the Catholic Church from all other denominations.

So I thought on this program I would go over where this abomination of desolation, the taking away the daily sacrifice from the prince is found in Bible prophecy, because Jesus told us a very famous quote from Matthew 24, "When you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet standing in the holy place, let him who reads understand", and then he gives four different flight patterns, and they apply to the four different groups who will reign with Him during the Millennium, the raptured Protestants, the protected Catholics, the holy martyrs and the converted Jews. And that's not the order that He gives it, nor is that the order in which it will happen in these End Times, but let's look at the chart which shows all of those four abominations of desolation, and I don't have them in chronological order either.

ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

The first one actually is at the bottom and we already looked at the protected Catholics, Daniel 12. Now I'll look at it again. Daniel 12 verse 11. The one that comes after the protected Catholics is Daniel 9 verse 26 and 27 and we have spent quite a bit of time looking at that. That affects the modern nation of Israel. Those are the ones that Jesus said, "Let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains". The raptured Protestants, there is no time given for that because that can happen at any time. That is the primary characteristic of the rapture and the holy martyrs, that's the fourth group in the End Times and I've got them listed at the top. The only reason I have them in this order is because I listed them according to the chapter number in Daniel 8 and we will be looking at that primarily this afternoon, and they are the last group upon whom the abomination of desolation is visited.

So first let's review; we have looked at this many times before, the abomination of desolation for Catholics which is brought in by the False Prophet. And for that we will look at Daniel 10 verse 3 and chapter 12 verse 11, and if you understand the structure, that is if you know how to unseal those two chapters, then you know that

10 and 12 are actually the same chapter. And Daniel 12 must be printed as a chiasm, that is, in the opposite direction of chapter 10. And when you do that, these two verses line up opposite each other. Daniel 10:3 and Daniel 12:11 and they explain each other. In other words if we look at Daniel 10 verse 3, we see that is a perfect description of the Eucharist. "I ate no desirable bread and neither flesh nor wine entered into my mouth." Daniel could not be given a better description of the Holy Eucharist. And what that does, is that explains 12 verse 11; "And from the time when the continual sacrifice shall be taken away". So now when Daniel writes about the continual sacrifice, as we will see in other places in chapter 8, we know what he's talking about. He's talking about the "desirable flesh", in other words the Eucharist.

<p>10:3 I ate no desirable bread, and neither flesh, nor wine, entered into my mouth,</p> <p>neither was I anointed with oil:</p> <p>till the days of three weeks were accomplished.</p>	<p>12:11 And from the time when the continual sacrifice shall be taken away,</p> <p>until the abomination unto desolation shall be set up,</p> <p>there shall be one thousand two hundred ninety days.</p>
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Now the next part which I put in red, "neither was I anointed with oil", that tells us who is going to take this daily sacrifice. And not being anointed with oil refers to Pope Francis who is not truly anointed. He, in other words is the False Prophet. He's a false pope, an anti-pope. And opposite that is the phrase, "until the abomination unto desolation shall be set up". In other words Pope Francis is going to bring in the abomination of desolation. I don't think that is exactly the same as the continual sacrifice being taken away. I think the abomination of desolation is the result of the continual sacrifice being taken away, and that will be brought in by the Antichrist.

So the False Prophet, the one who is not anointed with oil, not truly anointed, will bring in or predict the Antichrist. And then there's always a time frame here, and the "days of three weeks" correlate to the phrase 1,290 days, and of course the three weeks actually equals three years, but even then you'll see that those two numbers are not exact, and very rarely in prophecy is the numbering exact. It's basically three and a half years actually.

So now let's look at what we want to talk about; chapter 8 where we see the abomination of desolation as it affects the holy martyrs, because once the Antichrist comes in to the Vatican which Pope Francis is paving the way for then we will get persecution and killings. That is the characteristic of the Antichrist not the False Prophet, so to show you that, I'm going to jump ahead in Daniel 8 to

verses 23 and 24. `So this verse begins an explanation of the vision by the angel, so he is repeating something we've seen before, but I think this is a good description.

Dan 8:23 And after their reign, when iniquities shall be grown up, there shall arise a king of a shameless face, and understanding dark sentences.

Dan 8:24 And his power shall be strengthened, but not by his own force: and he shall lay all things waste, and shall prosper, and do more than can be believed. And he shall destroy the mighty, and the people of the saints,

Daniel 8:23 “**And after their reign**”, that would be the kings of the Antichrist, “**when iniquities shall be grown up, there shall arise a king of a shameless face, and understanding dark sentences.**” That's Daniel's description of the Antichrist.

Verse 24: “**And his power shall be strengthened, but not by his own force**”, in other words Satan gives him his power, “**and he shall lay all things waste, and shall prosper, and do more than can be believed. And he shall destroy the mighty, and the people of the saints.**”

“Saints” is Daniels code word for the Catholics, and now let's look at the next verse which continues this description.

Dan 8:25 According to his will, and craft shall be successful in his hand: and his heart shall be puffed up, and in the abundance of all things he shall kill many: and he shall rise up against the prince of princes, and shall be broken without hand.

Daniel 8:25 “**According to his will, and craft shall be successful in his hand**”, that's witchcraft, “**and his heart shall be puffed up, and in the abundance of all things he shall kill many:**” that's why I say this has to do with the martyrs, “**and he shall rise up against the prince of princes,**” of course that's Jesus, “**and shall be broken without hand.**”

But how shall he be broken? He shall be broken by Mary's foot. I think that's why it says broken without hand. It also means that it will be a supernatural victory over him, but it is Mary's foot that will crush the head of the serpent.

So now let's look and see where the abomination of desolation is, as far as the holy martyrs go. We can see, even though these verses are not in the correct order, the Antichrist is the one who caused the martyrdom, the killing of the martyrs, and that's the last abomination of desolation in the End Times. And we start in Daniel 8 verse 9.

Dan 8:9 And out of one of them came forth a little horn: and it became great against the south, and against the east, and against the strength.

Dan 8:10 And it was magnified even unto the strength of heaven: and it threw down of the strength, and of the stars, and trod upon them.

“And out of one of them came forth a little horn:” this is out of the ten kings, and the “little horn” is well known as the Antichrist, **“and it became great against the south, and against the east, and against the strength.”**

And I've done videos explaining that that refers to the location of where the Antichrist comes from, and I think that is Turkey. It doesn't necessarily mean he's born there, but there is a relationship between the Antichrist and Turkey I believe and I've done a video on it. So let's look at the next verse.

Daniel 8:10 “And it was magnified”, this is the Antichrist, **“even unto the strength of heaven: and it threw down of the strength, and of the stars, and trod upon them.”**

The stars would be the hierarchy of the Catholic Church, “and trod upon them”, and this is very similar in Revelation. Now maybe I'll look at Revelation, I've got it here. Let's look at Revelation 11: 2

Rev 11:2 But the court which is without the temple, cast out and measure it not: because it is given unto the Gentiles. And the holy city they shall tread under foot, two and forty months:

“But the court which is without the temple,” that's all the externals of the Catholic Church, shall be **“cast out and measure it not: because it is given unto the Gentiles. And the holy city”**, this is Rome; **“they shall tread under foot, two and forty months.”** So this is what that treading underfoot is spoken about in Daniel 8:10. It's the same thing.

Okay let's look at the next verse, Daniel 8 verse 11.

Dan 8:11 And it was magnified even to the prince of the strength: and it took away from him the continual sacrifice, and cast down the place of his sanctuary.

Dan 8:12 And strength was given him against the continual sacrifice, because of sins: and truth shall be cast down on the ground, and he shall do and shall prosper.

“And it was magnified”, this is the Antichrist, “even to the prince of the strength: and it took away from him the continual sacrifice, and cast down the place of his sanctuary.”

Now the “continual sacrifice” has already been taken away by the False Prophet. I think what we are finding out here is that the Antichrist will carry out the taking away of our daily sacrifice. In other words the Antichrist is going to be the enforcer of Pope Francis's rule. I think that is what Daniel is referring to here.

Daniel 8:12 “And strength was given him against the continual sacrifice, because of sins:” in other words we are going to lose our valid Eucharist because of sins, **“and truth shall be cast down on the ground, and he shall do and shall prosper.”**

Dan 8:13 And I heard one of the saints speaking, and one saint said to another I know not to whom, that was speaking: How long shall be the vision, concerning the continual sacrifice, and the sin of the desolation that is made: and the sanctuary, and the strength be trodden under foot?

Dan 8:14 And he said to him: Unto evening and morning two thousand three hundred days: and the sanctuary shall be cleansed.

Verse 13: “And I heard one of the saints speaking, and one saint said to another: I know not to whom that was speaking:” and I believe these are the two witnesses, Enoch and Elijah. **“How long shall be the vision, concerning the continual sacrifice, and the sin of the desolation that is made:”** so first you see the continual sacrifice is taken away, and then the sin of the abomination of desolation. How long shall it be in the sanctuary, **“and the strength be trodden underfoot?”**

Verse 14: “And he said unto him: Unto evening and morning two thousand three hundred days: and the sanctuary shall be cleansed.”

So we can look forward to the eventual resurrection of the Church just as Jesus was resurrected. Now that “evening and morning” means that the day is divided into two parts, so you have to divide 2,300 days by 2 and I think that comes out to 1150 days, and that is the shortest period of all of the timeframes given by Daniel with the four different abominations of desolation. That's why I say that this is the last of the four abominations, because of the time frame, although I don't think any of these time frames are exact. They're meant to be symbolic, but I think you can determine that since that is the smallest time frame that is mentioned, that that is the one that comes last in these End Times.

So first Francis takes the daily sacrifice away from the prince, and we have that right now, and in Malta for example. The Eucharist is no longer valid on Malta, and I don't believe it is valid in the Philippines, although I haven't heard lately. I don't think it will be valid in Germany. The German bishops intend to carry out Pope Francis' initiative of giving that which is holy to the dogs, and as I say that will invalidate the Eucharist.

In Poland, the bishops have said that they will not go along with Pope Francis' *Amoris Laetitia*, but the reason Pope wants these married priests is so he can put pressure on traditional priests, and then I read today that that will be published on the 12th, so that's five days from now, his apostolic exhortation which will allow married priests. They keep saying that it might not, but you and I know. Why would the Vatican get so upset? They went bonkers when Pope Benedict issued his book supporting priestly celibacy, and the reason is of course is because Pope Francis is going to make priestly celibacy optional.

So I think that covers everything I wanted to cover. I think tomorrow I will cover the rapture, the abomination of desolation as it refers to Protestants. Maybe I'll do that, and then we will have covered all four abominations in the last two weeks, and tomorrow is the last class for this week.
