

Putin-Obama Summit at Los Cabos, Mexico

Earlier this week, on June 18th, there was a very important summit meeting between two figures found in Bible prophecy: the last King of the North, as found in Daniel, chapter number 11, (that would be the president of Russia, Vladimir Putin), and the last King of the South, (that would be the president of the United States, Barack Obama). There were several very interesting coincidences about these summit talks, and if there is one thing I have discovered about prophecy, there is no such thing as coincidences.

First of all, these meetings were held on the 42nd anniversary of the prophecies at Bayside New York, which the Blessed Mother gave to Veronica Lueken. One of the most important of these prophecies, is that *'Syria holds the key to world peace. It will be a great destruction of World War 3, in which three quarters of the world will be destroyed'*. I believe people are beginning to realize that Syria does hold the key to world peace. It certainly appears as if Russia is drawing a line in the sand. They did not strenuously object, when Obama removed Mubarak, and when he removed Gadaffi, but they are objecting to the removal of Bashar Assad, the dictator of Syria. I believe Obama will be in deep doo doo if he tries to remove Assad. Another amazing coincidence, about this meeting in Los Cabos, Mexico, is the meaning of the word 'Los Cabos' in Spanish. One of the meanings, is 'The Ends'. I don't believe that is a coincidence either.



Now, I will play for you a few of the clips from this press conference, and you will see that, neither Putin nor Obama, really said anything of importance. They speak strictly in generalities. You would think that Russia and America were the best of allies. You wouldn't understand, unless you read Bible prophecy, that World War 3 is between these two super-powers. First let's hear Putin talk about Russia's entrance into the World Trade Organization: *'Today we had a very meaningful and subject oriented discussion. We've been able to discuss views pertaining to security; we've discussed bilateral economic relations. In this regard, I would like to thank you for the support rendered to Russia with her accession to the World Trade Organization.'*

First of all, please don't blame me for the terrible quality on the video and sound on these clips. They are in the public domain and they are found at the White House channel on YouTube. You would think that the world's super-powers would do a better job at video-taping their own press conference. In this next clip, Vladimir Putin talks about the 'Syrian affair', as he calls it, and he said that he and Obama found quite a few commonalities. *'We also discussed international affairs, including the Syrian affair. From my perspective, we've been able to find many commonalities pertaining to all of those issues.'* Please notice that Putin does not refer to the thousands of troops he is sending into the Syrian area, nor about the helicopters, or the ships, which he is sending. Everything is lovey-dovey, according to this news conference.

Next, Putin invites Obama back to Russia: *'You visited the Russian Federation three years ago. Now welcome again, I invite you to visit Moscow* (Obama's response): *'Thank you very much Mr President. We, in fact, did have a candid, thoughtful and thorough conversation on a whole range of bilateral and international issues.'* As you can see, Putin and Obama emphasized friendship and co-operation. Wouldn't I really love to know what they discussed behind closed doors? Next, Obama talks about the missiles, he is planning to place near Russia: *'We discussed a range of strategic issues, including missile defence, and have resolved to work through some of the difficult problems involved there.'*

In this next clip, Obama thanks Putin and the Russian people, for keeping open supply lines to our troops in Afghanistan. Incidentally, didn't Obama promise to pull our troops out of Afghanistan, after we got Osama Bin Laden? *'I thank the President and the Russian people for the work they've done with us on the border of the distribution*

network that is vital to providing supplies and resources to our brave troops, who are still in Afghanistan.' Of course, we'll never know if Putin drew the line in the sand, as far as Syria goes, or just how far the United States is willing to go.

Instead, in this next clip, President Obama talks about increasing trade with Russia: *'In particular, we discussed the need to expand trade and commercial ties between the United States and Russia, which is still far below, where they should be.'* Well, so far I have not heard either Putin or Obama say anything of substance. In this next clip, Obama says there is still time, that is, space and time, as he says, to resolve the Iranian crisis: *'We emphasized our shared approach when it comes to the Iranian situation, as members of the P5+1, we agreed that there is still time and space to resolve this diplomatically. The issue of Iran's potential development of nuclear weapons, as well as its interest in developing peaceful nuclear power.'*

So, President Obama continues to talk about problems, but never solutions. They talk about what he and Putin discussed, but never their accomplishments. Were there any agreements between these two leaders of the free world? Now this next clip is very important, because Barack Obama talks about the current hot spot, where the Blessed Mother said could be the start of World War 3, and where three quarters of mankind will be killed. Here is where Obama talks about Syria: *'And finally, as Mr President mentioned, we discussed Syria, where we agreed that we need to see a cessation of the violence and a political process has to be created to prevent civil war, and the kind of terrific deaths that we've seen over the last several weeks, and we pledge to work with other international actors including the United Nations, Kofi Annan and all interested parties, in trying to find a resolution to this problem.'*

Now for the bad news. As you can see, this news conference was pretty much of a charade. In this next clip, we will see Obama shake Putin's hand, and after that, I am going to show you what Bible prophecy says about these two men: *'Mr President, I look forward to visiting Russia again, and I look forward to hosting you in the United States. Thank you. Thank you very much.'*

Vladimir Putin and Barack Obama are both loyal sons of the Antichrist. These regime changes in the Middle East are designed to put in anti Christian leaders, and take out people like Mubarak, Gadaffi and Assad who tolerate Christianity. Both Putin and Obama would like to

see the Muslim brotherhood take over the Middle East. However, Putin is going to draw a line in the sand in Syria. He wants to control the future of that country. Personally, I don't believe either one of these leaders trust each other. I think they would stab each other in the back.

And that is what the prophet Daniel says in chapter 11, verse 40. **'And at the time of the end'**, notice this is an End Times prophecy, **'shall the king of the south'**, that is Barack Obama, **'push at him'**, that means provoke, **'and the king of the north'**, that is Vladimir Putin, **'shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen; and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries'**, the countries here refer to Britain and America, **'and shall overflow and pass through.'** Now this provoking, by the King of the South, that is Obama, started back in the fall of 2010, when he sent an aircraft carrier group near North Korea, and North Korea responded with the first salvo of World War 3, on November 23rd of 2010.

So in conclusion, I believe it was the mission of Putin and Obama at this Press conference in Los Cabos, Mexico to obfuscate the issue of Syria, rather than to enlighten us. They wanted to reassure us, and at the same time they are drawing a line in the sand. And I believe President Obama will cross that line. I believe Daniel is a far more accurate source of information than any news conference these world leaders try to perpetrate on the rest of us. And for you in my audience, please don't suppose that this war in the Middle East is a fulfillment of Ezekiel 37 and 38. This war in the Middle East is a conclusion of the 'Goat versus the Ram' war in Daniel, and the 'Babylon versus the Beast' war in Revelation.
