THE MORNING CRY OF THIRDEAGLE



Welcome once again to our **W**orld **F**amily **R**osary **N**etwork, where we give praise and honor to the Blessed Virgin Mary, because she is the woman prophesied way back in Genesis 3, verse 15, to crush the head of the serpent. And no Christian denomination, including my own Roman Catholic Church, teaches that truth any longer. That's because all of Christianity is under the great delusion of these End Times: including the Protestants, including the Orthodox, including EWTN, Father Mitch Pacwa, Cardinal Burke, Taylor Marshall, Mel Gibson, Mother Miriam, Our Sunday Visitor—and the list goes on and on. They all say that Jesus crushes the head of the serpent. But that is a huge theological and scriptural error. GOD does <u>not</u> say to the serpent in Genesis 3:15, "I will put enmities between you and <u>Me</u>." He says, "I will put enmities between you and the woman."

Nowhere in the Bible is there ever any physical contact between *Jesus* and an evil entity. The physical contact is always between the woman and either s*tan or the Antichrist. And we see that, for example, when Jahel drives a tent peg through Sisara's temples. We see it when Judith cuts off Holofernes' head with two sword strokes. We see it most clearly in the Book of Esther, where there *is* physical contact between Esther and Aman, but never between the King and Aman. And that's to let us know it's Mary who defeats s*tan and the Antichrist. That's why Aman is hung on a scaffold that's 50 cubits high: the 50 cubits represent the 50 Hail Mary's in a 5-decade Rosary; and the noose around Aman's neck symbolizes Mary's scapular.

When David defeated Goliath, everyone understands that David prefigured Jesus. The physical contact was between the stone and Goliath's forehead. And the stone was one of five that David chose. He didn't need five; he only needed one. But he chose five to let us know that Mary's Rosary is the weapon Jesus uses against the Antichrist, along with the shepherd sling, which represents Mary's scapular. Jesus does not pray the Rosary; Mary does not pray the Rosary; we pray the Rosary. Jesus is our Commander-in-Chief and Mary is His 5-star General. The Rosary and the scapular are the two weapons that Jesus uses against s*tan and the Antichrist; both evil entities will be defeated the same way. That's why in Genesis 3:15 it's the seed of the woman who defeats the seed of the serpent. The serpent is s*tan; the seed of the serpent is the Antichrist. The woman is Mary; the seed of the woman is the Remnant catholic church. We are involved in defeating the seed of the serpent. We are also known as the stone cut from the mountain without hands, in Daniel 2. The mountain is the Roman Catholic Church; the stone, cut from the mountain without hands, is the Remnant catholic church. And our destiny is to become a great mountain ourselves and to fill the whole earth.

It will be a tremendously humiliating experience for the serpent. Everything that happens to the serpent in Genesis chapter 3 is a humiliation: the serpent has to crawl on its belly all the days of its life; it has to eat dirt all the days of its life; it's banished from the company of other animals—and its head is crushed by a little teenage Jewish girl, whom we know as the Blessed Virgin Mary. If it suddenly took Almighty GOD to defeat s*tan, he could brag for all eternity—he could say, "Look at me! I'm #2 in the universe! I'm greater than any of the Apostles; I'm greater than Mary; I'm greater than any of the Angels." But he can't say that. The way GOD is directing this operation, s*tan comes in dead last. And I don't see why the Protestants or the Orthodox or EWTN, etc., can't figure that out.
