

William Tapley Unseals Daniel Chapter 7

People often ask me, 'How near are we to the end? How much time do we have left?' Well I'm here to tell you today, that those questions are no longer relevant: we don't have any time left. We are at the end, right now, and God is sending us many, many signs that we are at the end. And one of those very sure signs is that your Co-Prophet is unsealing the prophecies of Daniel.

The angel tells Daniel that his prophecies will be sealed up until the very end: chapter 12, verse number 4: **'But you, O Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, even to the time of the end.'** Again in verse number 9: **'And he said go your way, Daniel, for the words are shut up and sealed until the time of the end.'** My discoveries of Daniel's secrets have gone a long way in unsealing his prophecies.

But how did Daniel seal up his prophecies? This is the very interesting part. As I have been explaining, in this series on the four Abomination of Desolation, which Daniel describes in his last five chapters, he uses many Hebrew literary devices, such as 'pairs', 'parallelism', 'chiasms', and so on. And each chapter uses a little different formula.

On this particular program, I want to talk about Daniel, chapter 7, which is not part of the Abomination of Desolation series, but it does lead up to those chapters. And once again, Daniel uses a completely unique verse structure, and once we understand the structure, we find that there is a prophecy in the structure itself, and thus we can understand the entire prophecy.

In order to understand the hidden structure of Daniel chapter number 7, first you must recognize that he uses the word 'four', two times in each of three different verses; verses number 6, 17 and 23, and in order to figure out how he has arranged these verses for our understanding of the secret prophecy, you must line those verses up, in a horizontal line, and let the other verses follow where they may (see chart below). Nowhere else in chapter 7 does Daniel the word 'four' or 'fourth' twice in a single verse

Verse number 6: **'After this I beheld, and lo, another like a leopard which had upon the back of it, four wings of a fowl, the beast had also four heads and dominion was given to it.'** We know from my previous programs, that this refers to Barack Obama, because he is

our 44th president. Verse number 17: ***‘These great beasts, which are four, are four kings which shall arise out of the earth.’*** Notice how Daniel has to express this in an awkward fashion in order to get in his two ‘fours’. He could have just said, for example, *‘these great beasts are four kings’*; but no, he had to get in two ‘fours’, because he is tying these verses together very much on purpose.

And verse 23: ***‘Thus he said, the fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces’.*** Notice again how Daniel used a rather awkward phrase, in order to squeeze in two ‘fours’. He could have just said, ‘The fourth kingdom upon earth shall be diverse from all kingdoms’, but he had to get in those two ‘fours’ in order to relate verse 23 with verse 17 and verse number 6. The awkwardness itself alerts us to Daniel’s plan.

In order to get all these verses to line up in a logical pattern, so that verses 6, 17 and 23 are in a horizontal line, then verses 1 through 5 must appear on the upper left, just above verse number 6, followed by verses 7 through 11. And then we have to jump to the center section for verses 12 through 16, just before verse 17, then we have to skip the lower middle space, and jump up to verse 18 through 22 on the upper right, before verse 23, and then we conclude with verses 24 through 28 on the lower right (see chart).

How do we know Daniel did not want these verses rearranged in a chiasm? In other words, verses 12 through 16 could have been placed in reverse starting at the center bottom: 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and still have verses 6, 17 and 23 line up. And the same way with all the verses on the right side of the column: verses 18 through 28 could have been arranged upside down, and still the three key verses would line up.

So Daniel has to verify how he wants these verses rearranged. He does this by having verses 24 through 28 at the bottom right relate to verses 7 through 11 on the bottom left. In fact, we will find that verse 24 on the right follows verse 7 on the left, better than its usual successor, verse number 8. Let's take a closer look. Verse 7: ***‘After this I saw in the night visions and beheld a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and exceeding strong; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and broke in pieces, and stamped the rest with its feet: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.’***

Now the next verse that follows numerically does make sense, verse number 8: **'I considered the horns...'**, but verse number 24 actually follows better: **'And it had ten horns and the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise.'** Notice that verse 24 follows verse number 7 much more logically, and the same with the next verses: 8 on the left and 25 on the right. Verse 8: **'I considered the horns and behold there came up among them another little horn before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots.'** (By the way, this 'little horn' is the Antichrist. The three horns plucked up are Britain, America and Russia) **and behold in this horn were eyes, like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking great things.'** The next verse is about judgment, verse 9: **'I beheld till the thrones were cast down.'** But if we look at verse number 25, it follows much more logically: **'And a mouth speaking and he shall speak great words against the most High'**. In other words, Daniel is verifying with these verses, that this is the structure he wants as I have already explained.

Next, we find that verse number 9 on the left is about judgment, and verse 26 on the right starts: **'But the judgment shall sit...'** Verses 10 followed by verse 27 is not quite as obvious, but verse 28 definitely follows verse number 11. Verse 11: **'I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spoke: I beheld even till the beast was slain and his body was destroyed and given up to the burning flame.'** Now this activity comes at the very end and Daniel says so in verse 28: **'Here thereto is the end of the matter...'** This is a much better conclusion to verse number 11 than verse number 12 as found in your Bibles. So this is how Daniel sealed up the prophecies of chapter number 7, until this time of the end.

This hidden verse structure hides two very important prophecies. First of all, in the structure itself, notice there are 6 verses above the verses 6, 17 and 23: 6-6-6, and those 6 verses are followed by 5 verses, 7 through 11 and 24 through 28, and that is the exact same message that Daniel has given in each of his last six chapters, the 'vision' chapters, that the Antichrist, 666 will be defeated by Mary's Rosary, which is symbolized by the number 555. I know this is very difficult for many of you to understand, but this is why the angel told Daniel to seal it up until the time of the end.

In fact, the entire book of Daniel follows this same basic pattern. Don't forget, chapters 10 and 12 are actually one and the same chapter. And thus we have the first 6 historical chapters of Daniel followed by the 5 vision chapters, and therefore, once again, we see that 6, the number of the Antichrist is followed by 5, the number of Mary's Rosary. And Jesus follows this exact same pattern in the verse structure of Matthew chapter 24 and Ezekiel follows the same pattern in his chapters 38 and 39. And all of these examples verify the prophecy, way back in Genesis 3:15, that Mary and her seed will crush the Serpent and his seed, the Antichrist. But of course, Satan does not want you to know, how his head will be crushed and how his Antichrist will be defeated.

The other purpose of this hidden structure is to understand better the prophecy about the little horn and the One World Communist tyranny. And that's why these last 5 verses on either side of the structure explain each other, and add to our understanding of the prophecy. Now there is more than one way to read the verse sequence. And so we see how Daniel sealed up the prophecy of chapter number 7, according to the directions of the angel, and this prophecy is being unsealed now. We have no more time left. This is the End Time. As the angel said, Daniel's prophecies would be sealed up until the very end. That 'very end' is now. There is no more time left.
