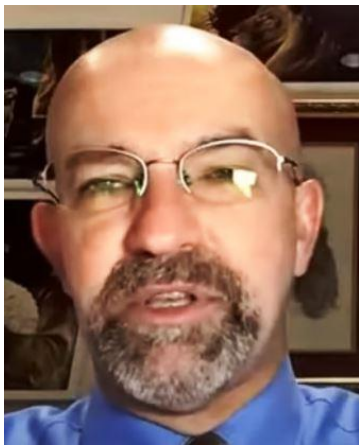


## Why Doesn't Prophet Coverstone Know Who Knocked On His Door?

This will be a special program because I will be doing an interpretation of Dana Coverstone's very latest video called, "Who Are You?" and I know he posted one this morning also, but it's an older dream. I don't think he explained that too well. The newest dream that he has received is the "Who Are You?" Dream, and I don't think he's too sure about his interpretation, and his interpretation; his and Cherie Goff's interpretation is totally incorrect, because this was a warning to Dana from Almighty God.

I believe the warning is to Dana, because he is abandoning his calling. His calling is to be a true prophet of these End Times and Jeremiah in chapter 23 says there would be some true prophets. I mean there's a lot of false ones, as Jesus prophesied. Many would come in his name, in other words claiming to be Christian, and we saw that before the election. How many of them told you that Donald Trump would be inaugurated? They said no problem, absolutely sure, positive thing, and he wasn't, but Dana Coverstone got it right in his Data Dream, and I interpreted that dream correctly. In fact I broke it down if you remember correctly because I understood what Dana was prophesying. So he is a true prophet but I am afraid. And this is a warning, a brotherly warning to Dana. And I don't do this out of any spite or anything, because I mean if he's out of a job, I'm out of a job. I mean my job is to interpret his dreams, but if he's not getting true dreams I can't interpret them.

Last month he received two dreams and he published them in a video, but he said he received a dream I believe between those two dreams, which he says he has a problem with. Well it is not his job to determine if his dreams are a problem. His job is to get the dream out there. It's up to the people, as both Cherie Goff and Dana Coverstone admit that his dreams are for the people, but he is withholding this one dream, and I believe God is not pleased. And what Dana is doing instead, is he's

trying to be a co-prophet. I don't know why in the world he would want to be a co-prophet instead of a prophet, but that's what he's doing on his channel. He's interpreting for example the Book of Revelation. He does a terrible job. I mean any time you talk about prophecy is good. I shouldn't criticize him too much, but his interpretations are all off, and Cherie Goff is just as bad, if not worse as far as interpreting. And he depends on her. He really thinks that she's doing a great job. Well neither one of them understands this, "Who Are You?" Dream, and that's what I'm going to be talking about on this program.

So first I want to give you a timeline and I think it is significant and I'm not sure of these times. If somebody knows what the actual times are, let me know. So this is the timeline. I'm going to show you on the screen.

### **DREAM TIMELINE**

May 17 – May 21 "TESTING FLOOR" Dream

Friday June 4 "WATCHMEN AND FIRE WIND" Dream

Mystery Dream ... Between those two dreams

"Who Are You?" Dream ... No Date Given - Posted 6 / 30

Today: "WALL STREET BARTER" Dream June 7 – 15  
BEFORE or AFTER the Mystery Dream?

So from May 17 to 21 and I'm sure this is right because he said so, he received the "Testing Floor" Dream, and on Friday June the 4<sup>th</sup> he received the "Watchmen and Fire Wind" Dream. Now I believe he has indicated that he received a Mystery Dream between those two dreams. Now it may have been after those two dreams. In any event I believe that the Mystery Dream explains those two other dreams, but I'm guessing on that. I don't know.

Why doesn't he reveal what those dreams are? That dream, the Mystery Dream and the next dream that he posted was the "Who Are You?" Dream which is what we're going to talk about in this program, but he did

not give a date for it, but I believe it was very recent, maybe in the last two or three days. He posted it the day before yesterday.

Now today he posted the “Wall Street Barter” Dream which he says he received from June 7<sup>th</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup> in other words after the “Watchman and Fire Wind” Dream, but before the “Who Are You?” Dream. The question is, did he post this dream before or after the Mystery Dream? And I really don't know, and I don't think Dana Coverstone himself has told us exactly when this Mystery Dream was given.

I think it's kind of significant because I don't think he received any true dreams after the Mystery Dream, in other words he has dropped the ball on this, and that's what the “Who Are You?” Dream is about. It's a warning to Dana Coverstone that he must release that Mystery Dream. And if he doesn't do that, if he concentrates on his interpreting of Bible prophecy, he's going to lose the mission that he does have, which is that of being a true prophet.

How many true prophets are there on YouTube? There's very, very few. And so anyway let's go through this dream, and I believe you will see that God is warning Dana Coverstone in this “Who Are You?” Dream that he must return to his original mission. So here is the first part of the dream.

### **Dana Coverstone's “Who Are You?” Dream**

**“I dreamt I was sitting at my desk in the office right where I'm sitting now facing this direction. You can see the open door behind me right there where the pen is pointing; that's the door in question I'm going to talk about. And my office door was closed and I hardly ever have my office door closed. If you've seen me do it from this angle, that door is always open. I have my computer where I'm sitting and that office door is open for a reason so that anyone walking in can see what's on my computer. It's about accountability and plus it's just the way I chose to set the office up.”**

So this is very important. Dana Coverstone is sitting at his computer when he receives this message from the Lord. Now he says it's not from the Lord. I think you'll see that it is. He says it's demonic, and so does

Cherie Goff, but they are mistaken. The reason it's important that he's sitting at the computer, is because this is what he is doing that our Lord is not happy with. He is spending all his time at the computer doing his "From the Perch" programs and he does a program just about every day.

I think he's been seduced by his own channel, and he's doing very well with it. I can't complain about that and he is doing a whole series on the Apocalypse. And I would say that the reason the Lord is not happy with his computer work is that 90% of it is not going to publish his real prophecy, and he has dropped the ball and not publishing the Mystery Dream. That's what he's got to do. Let's look at the second part of the "Who Are You?" Dream.

**"But in this dream the office door was closed and it was a sunny day outside so the office was brightly lit. It was about as bright as it is right now. And there was a knock at the door and I asked who it was and there was no answer. So I just kept sitting and facing my computer, whatever I was doing,"**; now evidently it's not very important what he was doing. I am sure he would remember it, and that's I think the point; **"and waiting and the knock came again and I asked who it was".** Count the number of times by the way that he asks the question. **"and still got no answer. So, at this point I stood up at my desk and I asked that the one knocking answer who they were and the knock came again and it I stated clearly that I would not answer the door until I knew who it was. So there was no response and the knocking continued."**

So as I said, how many times did he ask who it was? It was four times, and of course, four is the most important End Times number in Bible prophecy. That's why for example there are four horsemen in the Apocalypse. That's why there are four mysteries in Mary's End Times Rosary. And in this next part of the dream you'll see that there are four offices. So let's look at the next part of the dream.

**"Now the way my office" number one, "is set up just to my right, to your left, is a door that enters into our secret place prayer room" number two, "so I've got instant access to our prayer room. Out of that door is the entrance into the secret place into the hallway. I can**

**go around enter another office” number three, “area which opens into another smaller office,” number four, “where I can see my door basically through that angle. And so I went through that. There was no response so I went out that way. I came back in that other entrance and in my dream I went through the door out the secret place to another door that leads to the other office where I can also see the typical entrance into my office. And what I saw was just a white and seemingly bloodless, very, very pale almost eerie hand, just a hand that was knocking on my door.”**

Now when he mentioned that part of it; what he saw; the disembodied hand; what would you immediately think of? Where in the Bible is there also a disembodied hand? I’m sure most of you would immediately say, well it's in Daniel 5, the writing on the wall. Remember the hand writes on the wall, “Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin”? Four words by the way; notice that.

I am sure that Dana Coverstone is being warned just like King

Belshazzar was being warned. And what does Daniel interpret those four words? He says, you have been weighed in the balance and found wanting. Is that what God is telling Dana Coverstone? I believe there is a connection between the writing on the wall and the four words. And I think that's the reason there were four wizards and four rooms, is to tie in to the writing on the wall.

And what does Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin mean? ‘Mene’ means numbered, and it's repeated twice. That refers to two of the three groups who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium. One of the numbered groups would be raptured Protestants and another of the numbered groups would be the converted Jews. Most people think the 144,000 refers just to the converted Jews in the Book of Revelation but there are three different groups of 144,000. The ‘Tekel’ says you are weighed in the balance and found wanting. Now being weighed in the balance

refers to the protected Catholics in the desert. Weighing in the balance means that the food will be rationed. We will be living hand to mouth so to speak. That's what the 'Tekel' refers to. That's the third group that will reign with Jesus. 'Upharsin' means divided. And that refers to the martyrs, because their bodies are parted from their spirit.

And of course Daniel understood that prophecy and he said it referred to King Belshazzar. Your days are numbered. You have been weighed in the balance and are found wanting. This day your kingdom will be taken from you and given to the Medes and the Persians. And of course that came very true. Daniel's interpretation of the dream was correct, just as my interpretation of Dana's dream is correct.

It's interesting that the dream that Dana and Cherie Goff describe, as you can see, is a short dream. It takes him I think a little under four minutes or maybe a little over about four minutes of that entire video. Thirty five minutes are about their interpretation of the dream. You can see he's way out of kilter. He thinks that he and Cherie Goff talking about the meaning of the dream is more important than the dream. It isn't Dana. You could have cut that video down about five minutes and gotten the important part of the message out. Your false interpretation that somehow this writing on the wall is demonic; now that is false.

Okay, so let's look at the next part of the dream because it's a very interesting dream isn't it?

**“So it kind of brings to life the Addams family,”** This is what the hand reminds him of, **“you know, and just the hand that would knock or move or do things, that's what it looked like.”** I think I remember saying that. **”Okay? Maybe I watched too much TV,”** You think? **“I don't know but that's what I saw. And so I loudly said, who are you. I didn't ask who it was, I said, who are you and the hand that was in the process of knocking stopped and just rested itself on the door. And then I stated again who are you but a little bit louder a little bit more firm and then the hand began to fade into almost like a wisp of smoke.”**

So who is this hand? Who is the person connected to this hand? Well we know in the Bible that Jesus knocks at the door. He says, "I stand at the door and knock."

Well Cherie Goff did get that connection, but she says, well if Jesus can knock the door so can the Devil. Well that may be, but where in the Bible does the Devil knock at the door?

We know Jesus knocks at the door. I think that this Man in White certainly is, if not Jesus, from Jesus. He's the one knocking on the

door. Notice that Dana said four times "Who is it?" in the previous section, and then in this time he says "Who are you?" after he sees the disembodied hand.

So it's a total of six times that he asks, and I think that's a reference to the Antichrist. So why would I make that connection? Because in Daniel's interpretation of the writing on the wall, the 'Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin', King Belshazzar symbolizes the Antichrist and that's why he's afraid of those four words Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin. Those four words symbolize the four groups who survive the Antichrist and reign with Jesus in the Millennium. That's why he is so afraid of them. Those are the ones who he cannot defeat symbolically speaking. And I think that's another reference from Dana's dream to the writing on the wall and that is the number six which refers to the Antichrist.

Now is Dana afraid? We know King Belshazzar was afraid. I think Dana is afraid. Why does he go out the side door to see who it is? Why is he afraid of this knocking on the door? I mean, why does he have to know who it is? Why didn't he just say "Come in?" You know if somebody knocked on your office, wouldn't you just say, "Come in?" You might not. You might want to know who it is, or you might say, "Who is it?", and the person doesn't answer. That makes him afraid. This is I think Dana's problem. He wants to know too much about the dreams, so he wants to know who it is; who's giving him the dreams, and Jesus is not going to answer. And this is where he's going to lose his prophetic ability. Okay let's look at the next part of the dream.

**“At this point, I went back the way I had come and I approached the entrance door to my office and I began to pray over it. And I was just, I don't even remember what I was ... I had my hand on the door, I was anointing it, I was praying over it and I anointed the door and I asked the Lord to protect the gate into my office and that was the word I used in the dream, protect the gate into my office. And then I opened the door slowly and I examined the office room where the knock had been coming and the hand had been. And I walked out and I shut the door and then I anointed the outside of the door while it was closed and then I woke up.”**

I think Dana is definitely fearful now. This is of course in his dream and his dream I think he's fearful. And he did not publish this “Who are you?” Dream. He wasn't going to, and Cherie Goff at least talked him into publishing it. She thought it was important, and it is important but she wanted him to publish it because she thought that it shows the devil trying to seduce Dana Coverstone leading him astray and I don't think it's that way at all.

So who is the man knocking on the door with the white hand? Has any of you been thinking about that? Who can this person be? I'm sure it's the Man in White. He's got a white hand. Cherie Goff said it's bloodless, so he doesn't have the blood of Jesus. Well it was seemingly bloodless. That had to do with a color. In other words it's white. It's a white hand because it belongs to the Man in White who appears in all of Dana's dreams. Why wouldn't Dana assume that the hand in white belongs to the Man in White, since the Man in White appears in practically all of his dreams? Why wouldn't he assume that he's appearing in this dream also? I believe that's who it is.

And the Man in White, as Dana says, certainly in his most recent ones, I think he said it in today's one about the Barter dream, I think he mentioned that the Man in White represented Jesus. And that would be consistent with the Bible where Jesus says, I knock on the door. So the Man in White represents our Lord and that's who is knocking on the door, and who Dana Coverstone is very apprehensive about. So I'm warning you Dana and I'm not doing this out of any kind of spite or



anything. I'm hoping that you go back and concentrate on your calling. The Lord has given you an amazing gift.

Jeremiah 23 says there would be true prophets in these End Times, so don't be like King Belshazzar. King Belshazzar did not understand the writing on the wall although maybe it's all right for you not to understand the knocking, but at least King Belshazzar recognized that Daniel gave the correct interpretation. The king did not know it and neither do you Dana understand it, and I do understand it, and you don't have to give me half; let's see, I think the king gave Daniel one third of the kingdom or something. So you don't have to do that Dana. You don't have to give me one third of the kingdom for correctly analyzing your dream, but I sure hope you wake up and understand you've got to release that Mystery Dream. You've got to let people know what that is. I'm sure that is why you have been chastised by our Lord. The Man in White is knocking on your door. Now I think that is the end of the dream.
