Is the Trump - Netanyahu Peace Plan in Bible Prophecy?

On this program we will be discussing a fulfillment of Bible prophecy which we see going on right now in Washington DC when tomorrow at noon, President Trump says he will announce his Middle East Peace Plan which I think is found in Daniel 9:26 and 9:27. Those are probably the two most important verses in all of the Bible as warnings to the End Times nation of Israel. Now as I said before, I doubt if Israel is going to listen to this broadcast. If they don't listen to the Jewish teenager Natan, who had a near-death experience not that long ago, maybe two and a half years ago, I doubt if they're going to listen to me. So this message is especially for you remnant Catholics, because I think we will need to know the timing of these events, and that's what Daniel 9 is really all about, especially 9:26 and 9:27.

And the reason we have to be alert is because YouTube and elsewhere are inundated with false prophets who totally misinterpret Daniel 9:26 and 9:27, and the reason is because they don't follow the rules of End Times prophecy. Before you can interpret, you must unseal. The angel told Daniel to seal up his prophecy and Daniel wanted to know what the prophecies meant, all of his vision prophecies, and the angel told Daniel, he said, "Go your way Daniel, the prophecies are for another time." And those times are those that we are in right now, the End Times. That's what the prophecies are for.

So we'll go over 9:26 and 9:27 and I've done this many times before, but I think I have finessed the verses a little bit better than I ever have before, and if you want to follow it, it's in my third volume if you have the volume number 3, and a lot what I will be talking about today starts on page 150, but I've done many programs on Daniel 9:26 and 9:27. And Catholic Crusader said, "Refer to your volume 4 textbook page 227".

If you've been following it, it's very important. Both Netanyahu and his opponent Benny Gantz, they are in Washington right now. They will be meeting with Donald Trump. They already met today with him, and if you want the very latest, I was going to run off the latest but it changes every 20 minutes or so, so if you wanted to find out exactly what's going on and what they did today, just Google "Trump Netanyahu Peace Plan or Middle East peace" or anything like that and at least every 15 or 20 minutes some major news story is published on this meeting because it is very significant.

I titled this program, "Is the Trump - Netanyahu Peace Plan in Bible Prophecy", and that's what I think we're going to try to determine today, because I think it is. And I called it the Trump - Netanyahu Peace Plan because, if I am reading the news stories correctly, the peace plan is basically a Netanyahu peace plan. It respects the nationhood of Israel. It doesn't concede anything to the Palestinians. I think they will reject this peace plan. Donald Trump doesn't think they will, because there's a lot of money in it for them if they don't, but I don't think that. Their whole idea is that there's no such thing as a nation of Israel, and they call it the nation of Palestine, so I don't think there can ever be reconciliation between those two. In fact Donald Trump was saying that as a businessman, whenever they had a

difficult deal to make, he said in fact inevitably they would say, well this deal is almost as hard as Israel and Palestine making a deal. That was the ultimate difficult deal and I can see why. In any event Donald Trump has taken the attitude with this peace plan to go it alone without Palestine, and if they get on board good, and if they don't, good. It doesn't matter. I think Donald Trump and Netanyahu are on the same page and that is the preservation of Israel as a nation, but we will see in Daniel 9:26 and 27 and that isn't going to happen. And it doesn't matter what the Palestinians do or don't do, the person who is going to undermine the peace plan is called "the prince who shall come", and that doesn't have anything to do with Palestine.

As I say, the false prophets get it all wrong. They tried to give Israel pillows and cushions, people like John Hagee, Irvin Baxter or JD Farag, they think the Ezekiel 38 war is about to occur and it's not. The Daniel 9 war is about to occur, and I think we can go to it right now.

So here are the two verses I want to look at. These are the two critical verses. Most Bible scholars understand that these verses are critical. The only problem is they don't know how to interpret them. They don't realize you have to unseal them before you interpret. And the key to understanding all of Daniel chapter 9 especially 26 and 27 is that those two verses are not in chronological order. They are always interpreted falsely assuming that they are in chronological order, but if you understand the structure of Daniel 9, you'll know that these are paired verses, 9:26 and 9:27 actually tell the same story.

They are parallel verses and they're in pairs, and most of chapter 9 is in pairs. Daniel 9:11 and 12 are End Times prophecies. Daniel 9:16 and 17 same chapter, that's Daniel's lament, and the two most important are the two verses which I'm going to show you now, and I've colour-coded these, so that you can see that there are four elements in each chapter and in each verse, and they relate to each other. And what I have discovered, I've been working at in the last three or four days is exactly what order to read these, and I didn't pay attention before to the exact order, but I think I have figured it out. And I have put a letter, an alphabetical letter before each part of each verse, so that we can know what order to read them chronologically so that we can determine this.

We now should know that verse 27 not follow verse 26 chronologically, but the parts contained within each verse, they do if you read them correctly, and now we can understand this correct chronology if we realize that 9:26 and 27 are a prophecy of Jesus Christ as well as an End Times prophecy, and that's true with just about all of Daniel. There is a near time fulfilment of the prophecy and an End Time fulfilment, and the near time fulfilment gives us clues to understand the End Times fulfilment. So if we read Daniel 9:26 and 27 as a prophecy of Jesus, I think we will see that I now have this chronology in correct order.

So now let's read first Daniel 9:26 and 27 as a prophecy about the coming of our Messiah Jesus Christ, and as such, it's an amazing prophecy in itself, so here are the two verses.

So as you can see, I've got each verse, 26 and 27 divided into four different sections, and I have put an alphabetical letter before each of those four sections. And as you can see, part A) actually starts in Daniel 9:27 and then it switches over to 9:26, and then it goes down to the C), which is just below B), and then it goes over to 9:27 and so on, and as you can see it goes back and forth.

So let's see if we look at these verses as a prophecy of our Messiah Jesus, is it accurate? In other words, Daniel 9:27, part A); **“And he shall confirm the covenant with many in one week.”** In other words the “he” is Jesus. The covenant that He confirms is the Messianic covenant. The “many” would be the Jews who accepted Him, and “in one week” means the beginning of the 70th week of Daniel.

I should have put Daniel 9:24 and 25 together and maybe I'll do that for tomorrow's program because this is going to go on for several days I'm sure. I'm following this very closely, the meeting with Netanyahu and Trump in Washington, and tomorrow at noon they will be releasing their peace plan.

So now we've determined that Daniel 9:27 A) refers to Jesus at the beginning of the 70th week of Daniel, and He confirms the Messianic covenant. So now let's look at 9:26 B). **“And after sixty-two weeks the Anointed One shall be cut off but not for himself.”** Again this refers to Jesus but this refers to when He was crucified. So in A) on the right, we see that He begins his ministry and in B) He is cut off and crucified so, so far I think that I have the chronology correct. And the important thing to note, is that in both in 26 and 27, the first person mentioned is the Anointed One, is Jesus, and in the End Times we'll see that it's the same person also. And this is where the false prophets make their big error. They don't realize that 9:26 and 9:27 are telling the same story.

So now let's look at the second part in each verse. So now you move down to C). **“And a people of the prince who shall come, shall destroy the city, and the**

sanctuary.” Every Bible scholar will tell you that this prince is the Roman general Titus who destroyed the city of Jerusalem in 70 AD. Notice that this prince does two things. He destroys the city and the sanctuary, whereas in both A) and B) the Anointed One, the Messiah did one thing. He confirmed the Covenant at A) and He was cut off in B), but here we see the prince who comes, the Roman General Titus does two things. “And the people of the prince”, would be the Roman legions, except a lot of Bible scholars believe that the Roman legions consisted of paid mercenaries, mainly people from Persia, in other words Syrians or people in around, the same people today who are threatening Israel.

So now we go back over to 9:27 which I have marked as D); **“and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease.”** C) and D) are describing the same event, the Roman General Titus destroying the city and the sanctuary, and I think I have those in correct chronological order. The middle of the week would be the 70th week of Daniel. “In the midst”, there are different words in different translations for “midst”. Some say, “In the middle”, and there are different words. I think “midst” is probably best, because it is not specific and we know that the Roman General destroyed Jerusalem in 70 AD which was approximately 35 years after Jesus was crucified.

So now let's look down look at E), on continuing with 9:27, **“and there shall be in the temple the abomination of desolation:”** and going back to 9:26 we see in F), **“and the end thereof shall be with a flood.”**

Continuing now with G), **“and after the end of the war the appointed desolation”**, and then concluding these two verses with H), **“and the desolation shall continue even to the consummation, and to the end.”**

So I think you can see that, that way of reading and breaking up those verses is now chronologically correct, and the key to understanding, is that the two verses tell the same story. The false prophets, even now you can go to their channels and they are talking about the Antichrist signing a peace treaty with Israel. That's what they say this is all about, but this is not. This is the Anointed One.

So now, let's look at these things as possibly fulfilled by either Donald Trump or Netanyahu, the same verses, because what we looked at was the near time fulfilment of the prophecy which was perfect, as far as the near time goes. The desolation has continued for Israel until the end. In other words there's been no third temple. By the way that's a prophecy that there will be no third temple. So now, let's look and see how either Netanyahu or Donald Trump will fulfill this prophecy and that's why this peace treaty tomorrow is so significant.

So now we start again with 27, part A) of that verse, **“And he shall confirm the covenant with many in one week”**. Now this is not the same covenant. This is not the Messianic covenant. This would be the Abrahamic covenant. In other words the covenant that gave the land of Canaan to Israel in perpetuity for all time. I think we could say that both Donald Trump and Netanyahu are going to do this. They are doing it. In fact I believe Benjamin Netanyahu **has** been doing this.

Next, we go over to B) in 26. **“And after sixty-two weeks the Anointed One shall be cut off but not for himself.”** So the Anointed One; the same person in B) is the same as the person in A), the one who is confirming this covenant, this Abrahamic covenant for the End Times nation of Israel shall be cut off. Now does that refer to Donald Trump losing an election? Or does it refer to Benjamin Netanyahu losing an election coming up on March 3rd, because the term “cut off” in the near time fulfillment referred to Jesus being crucified. In the End Times, does it refer to Netanyahu losing his election? In other words we're going to see that 9:26 and 27 are fulfilled very soon. This very well could be the time marker, tomorrow at noon. This would be the time marker that begins the fulfillment of this prophecy.

So now let's look at the bad news. After either Trump or Netanyahu loses the election, Israel will have the same thing that happened to Jerusalem from the Roman General Titus. In other words, look at 9:26 C). **“And a people of the prince who shall come, shall destroy the city, and the sanctuary.”** Now I have suggested for many years here on YouTube that, “the prince who shall come” is Vladimir Putin. “And a people”, would be similar to the people with the Roman General Titus, in other words mercenaries. In other words they were not Romans and in the End Times I don't think they will be Russians. I think they will be Iranians, in other words Persians, the same as in the near time fulfillment. But as you can see, they come and destroy the city and the sanctuary. In other words they destroyed Jerusalem and Israel.

Let's look at part D) of verse 27; **“and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease.”** This is the abomination of desolation as it affects Israel. I used to think it was the same as for Catholics, but it's not. There are four different abominations of desolation in Daniel. This is the abomination of desolation as it affects the modern End Times nation of Israel. Let's go back to that.

And then we go to part E) in 9:27; **“and there shall be in the temple the abomination of desolation”**. Many translations don't use the word “temple”. I don't think it should be “temple”, because as we found from the near time interpretation, there won't be any third temple despite what the false prophets tell you, like Paul Begley and all of the other ones I've told you. They all say that there will be a third temple in Jerusalem. That is not true. We know from the near time prophecy that the desolation continues to the end. There will be no third temple. And as I say, a lot of translations do not even use the word “temple”, but this is the abomination of desolation warned about by Daniel that Jesus refers to, and this specifically is the desolation that affects the End Time's nation of Israel.

Let's look at F); **“and the end thereof shall be with a flood.”** That means that it will be quick, this desolation of Israel. And moving down to G); **“and after the end of the war”**, this is the Daniel 9 war; it will be part of World War 3, **“the appointed desolation”**. And looking at H); **“and the desolation shall continue even to the consummation, and to the end.”** It's interesting that H) actually is a fulfillment of both the near time interpretation and the End Times interpretation, because the desolation for Israel continues to the very end, and we know that only a remnant of Israel will be saved out of this abomination.

And this is why Israel will be destroyed, and you won't find any of the false prophets warning Israel. The false prophets, what should they be doing? They should be telling Israel they need to repent. They need to convert to Judaism and you won't find the false prophets saying that anyway. That's because they're false. They feed Israel pillows and cushions. The only true prophet I have seen for Israel in the last several years is the Jewish teenager Natan. As I say, I don't expect Israel to listen to me, but the problem is, they're not going to listen to Natan either, and therefore this is going to happen.

So what we will be very possibly seeing tomorrow is the beginning of this timeline, the timeline to the destruction of Israel. And I have said before that the beginning of the seven years of tribulation could have been when Netanyahu was elected. That was in 2009, or later I said it could be when Netanyahu addressed Congress, or it could be when the United Nations had that resolution a couple of years ago. Now it's beginning to look as if tomorrow could be the start of this 70th week of Daniel, the start of the Tribulation period, and we will soon find out if Netanyahu is cut off, if he loses his election, that the second and third part of Daniel 9:26 and 27 are following very quickly.

So I'm asking all of you to keep me apprised. My sister called me up and alerted me that Donald Trump was holding a press conference with Benjamin Netanyahu. I switched to that quickly. If you want to watch that, you can go to the White House Channel; it's still available. The camerawork from the White House is terrible. It's unbelievable. You would think they would hire a few professional people, because maybe they have Democrats running it still over there. Believe me, this is very significant for Israel and our interests in it is not so much that we are going to be destroyed but it will show that we are in the End Times when one of the four the abomination of desolation affects Israel.

Now tomorrow at noon I'm going to listen to Donald Trump's announcement for the peace plan and then at 5 pm we will be just discussing that, and I will be also on the lookout for what the false prophets tell you. I sure hope they have learned by now that in Daniel 9:26 and 27 there is no Antichrist, and the one who confirms the covenant is the good guy, he's the Anointed One, because 9:26 and 27 as I have said all along on this channel they are not in a chronological order, they are parallel verses.
