

## One World Religion Will Be Protestant



Several of my subscribers have asked me to talk about, first of all, why the One World Religion will be Protestant in nature, and secondly, how we as Catholics must flee this Abomination. And as you know, Pope Francis, on the 21st of April, allowed a woman in Argentina, who is married to a divorced man outside the Church, to receive Holy Communion. And I believe the entire

Church will adopt this policy in October, at least as an option. And of course, this will make the Catholic Church Protestant which is why I say the One World Religion will not be Catholic.

In other words, if Pope Francis had been the pope when Henry VIII wanted to marry six different women, he would have still been allowed to receive Communion: he would not have been excommunicated. And that means that all you people who are currently living in English speaking countries such as England, Wales, Scotland, even the United States, Canada, Australia or New Zealand; you would all be living in Catholic countries. You are currently living in Protestant countries for one reason: Henry VIII wanted to have six wives.

And Jesus prophesied all of this would occur. He said, '**when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet, then you must flee.**' Matthew 24:18, '**And he that is in the field** (now this field symbolizes the Catholic Church) **let him not go back to take his coat.**' The opposite of a fertile, green field would be a desert and in the book of Revelation John says that is what the woman must flee to Revelation 12:14, '**And there were given to the woman** (this is the remnant church) **two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the desert,**' this is the opposite of a green, fertile field, 'unto her place, where she is nourished for a time, times, and half a time,' that would be forty-two months, "from the face of the serpent,' and the serpent, of course, is Satan. Notice John says '**on the two wings of an eagle.**' That means the two wings must be different.

And there have been quite a few interpretations of what John is talking about. Some say they represent the Old and the New Testaments. Some say they represent the two witnesses, Enoch and Elijah. However, I believe a much better interpretation is that the two wings of

the eagle, which carry the remnant Catholics to their safety, represent Mary's Rosary and Scapular.



These are the same as the two weapons which David used to defeat Goliath which are symbolized by the shepherd's sling, that would be Mary's Scapular, and the five smooth pebbles which represent Mary's Rosary. Now, we as Catholics, should not be surprised at our fate in these End Times because Jesus prophesied that his temple would be destroyed. John 2, verse 19: ***'Jesus answered, and said to them: Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.'*** Here Jesus is not just prophesying about his crucifixion and resurrection, he is also giving us an End Times Prophecy about his Temple, in other words, about His Body the Church, which will be destroyed for three days, in other words, three years.

Now, that's not quite the same as 42 months, but Jesus could possibly be figuring from this October when the entire Church will undoubtedly adopt Pope Francis's idea of giving Communion to divorced and remarried Catholics, at least as an option. And now this prophecy of the remnant Catholics fleeing from the Temple of God which is the Church in the End Times, is also found in Revelation 11, verse 1: ***'And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and it was said to me: Arise, and measure the temple of God (this is the same temple Jesus is talking about in the End Times, this is the Catholic Church) and the altar and them that adore therein (those who adore in the End Times are the remnant Catholics) but the court, which is without the temple, cast out, and measure it not: because it is given unto the Gentiles (this is what Jesus means when he says it will be destroyed) and the holy city they shall tread under foot 42 months.'***

The 'holy city' in these End Times is not Jerusalem; the 'holy city' refers to Rome because it is the headquarters of the Roman Catholic

Church. The 'great city' in Revelation 11 refers to Jerusalem because in the End Times, Jerusalem will be a Sodom and an Egypt. It will become the eventual capital of the Antichrist.

And Daniel also talks about the remnant Catholics fleeing their church. Daniel 12, verse 7: **'And I heard the man that was clothed in linen... that it should be unto a time, times, and half a time** (that is the same as the forty-two months) **and when the scattering of the band of the holy people shall be accomplished** (the holy people refer to the remnant Catholics, and their scattering means they must leave the externals of the Catholic Church) **all these things shall be finished.'** And that refers to Armageddon.

And Daniel talks about the same thing in chapter 10, verse 7: **'And I Daniel alone saw the vision: for the men that were with me** (this refers to the remnant Catholics) **saw it not: but an exceeding great terror fell upon them, and they fled away, and hid themselves.'** This sounds very much like the early Christians fleeing into the catacombs. Several of my Catholic subscribers have asked me, 'when I flee the Church, should I join a Protestant denomination?' But that would be like jumping out of the frying pan into the fire. As I said, the One World Religion will be Protestant in nature even though it will be headed up by Pope Francis.

Now you may not have to flee into the desert immediately. It's possible that your own parish priest may not apostatize. It's possible he will be among those whom the False Prophet, Wormwood, does not make bitter. And of course we need to remember that when the Antichrist takes over, there will only be two denominations so to speak: those who take the mark and those who refuse. And those who refuse will all be forced into a spiritual desert and very possibly a physical desert as well.
