

La Salette: Enoch and Elijah Return Pt 7

This is the seventh and final part in my series on the amazing prophecies which the Blessed Mother gave to two shepherd children, Melanie Calvat and Maximin Giraud, at La Salette, France, back in 1846. And the keys to understanding these prophecies are, first of all, that it is Apocalyptic Literature and it follows the same hermeneutics; in other words, you need a Co Prophet, the symbolic interpretation comes ahead of the literal interpretation, and numerology is very important. Second of all, you need to understand the true chronology; you need to realize that Mary broke up this prophecy into seven different sections. And third, you need to understand this is primarily a warning to the Catholic Church.

Before I do part seven, however, I want to review the first six sections of this amazing prophecy, beginning back in 1858 with part one. In the very first paragraph of the first section, Mary reveals this is Apocalyptic Literature by employing Sacred numerology because she lists 7 sins of the priests, and, of course, we know 7 is a very important End Times number. She also says that God is going to bring vengeance on the clergy and she uses the word "vengeance" 4 times, another very important End Times number. Following the 7 sins of the priests, which she enumerates, she talks about the seal and bowl judgements. Mary also talks about 35 years of tribulation, and of course, we have to look at the symbolic interpretation of that number: Mary is really talking about 3.5 years of tribulation, in other words, one-half of the seven years of Tribulation; and she ends by talking about the Wrath of God, and we know from Bible prophecy that the Wrath of God is also known as the "great and terrible day of the Lord", and that always refers to Armageddon.

So, Mary establishes in part one, the pattern she will use throughout the prophecies of La Salette: she begins with a specific date, in this case 1858, and she ends with an End Times prophecy, in this case a description of Armageddon. This is the first of 4 times she refers to Armageddon. Mary begins the second part with another specific year, this time 1859. She warns Pope Pius IX about Napoleon 3rd. She says Italy will be punished by war and, of course, that was with World War 1 and World War 2. She says that punishment came because they stole the Papal states. And she ends this section by warning the last Pope against the performers of miracles, of course, they would be the Antichrist and the False Prophet.

Mary begins part three with a specific date again, 1864. She talks about apostasy within the Church. She talks about UFOs, alien abductions and zombies. She says there will be a frightful crisis in the Church. I believe this refers to Vatican II. And she says they will be an attempt on the Pope's life. Of course, this is a prophecy of Pope John Paul II. And she finishes this section again with another End Times event, and that is the One World Government. Part four begins again with another specific year, this time 1865. She talks about sinners entering into convents and that is one of the strategies of Satan in the End Times. She speaks about World War 2 and a general war which will follow; I believe this is World War 3. She says that Paris will burn but this has also not yet occurred.

And, once again, Mary finishes with an End Times prophecy, and this is the second time she refers to Armageddon and she also refers to the Millennium. This is very important, especially for Catholic theologians who tend to confuse prophecies of the Millennium with Millenarianism. Millenarianism is a false doctrine and condemned by the Church. The Millennium, however, is a true prophesy, and referred to eight times in the book of Revelation. Thus, the first 4 sections begin with a specific year which Mary herself gives and notice, by the way, that end times number of 4.

The fifth section, however, begins with a year that we have to determine from the facts given and that specific year was 1870. Mary then talks about a forerunner of the Antichrist, a series of wars, and she refers to Armageddon for the third time. However, this is the first time that she ends a section not with an End Times event. But it's interesting that she says, "before this there will be a false peace". In other words, when Mary goes back in the chronology, she announces that she is going back. Which, by the way, verifies that all the all the other sections are in their true chronology.

And next, part number six begins again with a specific date, in this case the birth of the Antichrist, which we surmised would be between 1945 and 2001, somewhere in that time frame. Mary says the seasons will be altered. Personally, I think we are seeing that this year, at least I know where I live. She says that Rome will lose the faith and become the seat of the Antichrist. That's one of the most famous warnings in the La Salette prophecies.

At one time, I did not believe that Mary ever referred to the rapture in her prophecies, but here she says that God will take care of his faithful

servants and men of good will. Notice that duality. There are two ways that God will take care of us; one is for the protected Catholics in the desert and one is for the remnant Protestants who will attend the Marriage Supper of the Lamb in heaven, also known as the Rapture. And, Mary ends this section by an exhortation of the faithful to stand up and fight in these End Times.

So now, we are up to the 7th and last section where Mary talks about the return of Enoch and Elijah, which is the starting date for this part 7. She also speaks about a frightful hail of animals and she says that Enoch and Elijah will be killed. Mary then gives her most crucial warning: "only faith will survive". If you get nothing else out of these La Salette prophecies, please remember those 4 words, they are critical: "only faith will survive". Then, for the 4th and last time, Mary talks about Armageddon. Again notice, that End Times number. And, she speaks about the Millennium again. Please don't listen to the false prophets who say there will be no Millennium. They are thinking about Millenarianism, which is a false doctrine, but there will be a thousand years of peace.

And now, let's look at, specifically the 7th part of the prophecy of La Salette. And I've named this 7th and final section of the La Salette prophecies after the two great prophets, Enoch and Elijah who will return and, in fact, I believe they already have returned. **"The church will be in eclipse"**, and remember, as I said before, the La Salette prophecies are primarily a warning to the Catholic Church. **"The world will be in dismay. But now Enoch and Elijah will come filled with the spirit of God."** Now, I believe Enoch returned on November 23rd, 2010, with that attack by North Korea on South Korea, and I believe Elijah returned on Mount Carmel on December 3rd, which was Chanukah, during that forest fire in Israel. So, the starting point for part 7 would be the Fall of 2010.

Mary continues: **"they will preach with the might of God, and men of goodwill will believe in God and many souls will be consoled. They will make great progress through the virtue of the Holy Spirit and condemn the diabolical errors of the antichrist. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth. There will be bloody wars and famines, plagues and infectious diseases** (I believe these are the trumpet, seal and bowl judgments) **it will rain with the frightful hail of animals"**. And I believe we've already seen that beginning this year, in fact, beginning at the end of last year. **"There will be thunderstorms which will shake cities, earthquakes which will swallow up**

countries. Voices will be heard in the air". And I believe this refers to demons. **"Men will beat their heads against walls, call for their death, and on the other hand, death will be their torture. Blood will flow on all sides. Who will persevere if God does not shorten the length of the trial?"** And, of course, Jesus promised that for the sake of the elect He would shorten these days.

"At the blood, tears and the prayers of the righteous, God will relent; Enoch and Elijah (however) will be put to death". That occurs at the mid tribulation point. **"Pagan Rome will disappear. Fire of heaven will fall and consume three cities"**. Now, I put a question mark here because I believe the cities are symbolic of three countries. **"All the universe will be struck with terror and many will let themselves be led astray because they have not worshipped the true Christ who lives among them. It is time; the sun is darkening; only faith will survive"**. And, as I said before, if you get nothing else out of these La Salette prophecies, remember those 4 words: "only faith will survive".

And Mary continues: **"Now is the time, the abyss is opening. Here is the king of kings of darkness"**, and, of course, that would be Satan. **"Here is the beast** , that would be the Antichrist, **"with his subjects calling himself the savior of the world. He will rise proudly into the air to go to heaven. He will be smothered by the breath of the archangel, Saint Michael."** and, of course, this refers to Armageddon, and this is the 4th time Mary has referred to that event. It's interesting that she says that Saint Michael will crush satan. I think Mary is too modest to refer to the rosary and the scapular which, as I have said many times, is found in Scripture as the two weapons which Jesus will use. However, that Saint Michael is involved can also be verified in Daniel, chapter 12, verse 1.

And we continue: **"he will fall, and the earth, which will have been in a continual series of eruptions for three days, will open up its fiery bowels and he will have plunged for eternity with all his followers into the everlasting chasms of hell"**. And this can be verified in Revelation, 20:10, where, very interestingly, we read that the Antichrist and the False Prophet will be cast alive into hell! They don't even have the benefit of dying! **"And then water and fire will purify the earth and consume all the works of men's pride and all will be renewed. God will be served and glorified."**

This renewal occurs after Armageddon and is part of the Millennium where God will be served and glorified. This is Mary's second reference to the Millennium. One of the primary reasons I did this series on Mary's amazing prophecies at La Salette was to make Catholics, especially, more aware of these warnings from heaven concerning the Catholic Church; they're extremely important in these End Times and they correlate exactly with prophecies in the book of Revelation and also with prophecies in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
