

## Mary's School of Prophecy Jeremiah 23 – Pt 10

This will be the last program in our series on Jeremiah's amazing chapter number 23, which is an End Times prophecy, a dual End Times prophecy. It gives a prophecy of the Jews returning to Israel, which has already come true, and it has a **very** End Times prophecy about the three categories of false prophets, the false Catholic prophet, singular, who is Wormwood the False Prophet, and the false Protestant prophets of whom there are many, all over here on YouTube, and the false Jewish prophets, who are leading Israel astray. And Jeremiah warns all three groups that God is going to send them to Hell. And first of all before we start, we should pray the prayer given by Our Lady of All Nations and Catholic Crusader sent this, so join with me.

In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen. Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations, that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster and war. May the Lady of All Nations, the Blessed Virgin Mary be our Advocate. Amen.

And notice that Our Lady is the Lady of all nations, not the Lady of the United Nations or the One World Religion or the One World Government as the FP likes to say; PF the FP; Pope Francis, the False Prophet.

Let's first review Jeremiah's Cryptogram.

And this is the secret hidden way that Jeremiah sealed up his prophecy. We've already reviewed the first four lines, and tonight we're going to review line number 5, which we have already done quite a bit on, and then we are going to complete our study of Jeremiah 23.

5. Behold the days come, saith the Lord, and I will raise up to David a just branch: and a king shall reign, and shall be wise, and shall execute judgement and justice in the earth.

10. Because the land is full of adulterers, because the land hath mourned by reason of cursing, the fields of the desert are dried up: and their course is become evil, and their strength unlike.

15. Therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts to the prophets: Behold I will feed them with wormwood, and will give them gall to drink: for from the prophets of Jerusalem corruption has gone forth into all the land.

20. The wrath of the Lord shall not return till he execute it, and till he accomplish the thought of his heart: in the latter days you shall understand his counsel.

And the key verse in the last line is verse number 15, as I've said several times already. **“Therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts to the prophets:”** that would be the false Protestant prophets, **“Behold I will feed them wormwood,”** that's the False Catholic Prophet, the False Prophet of the End Times, the Beast from the earth, **“and will give them gall to drink:”** this is God speaking. He is going to appoint the False Prophet, just as He appoints the Antichrist; **“for from the prophets of Jerusalem corruption has gone forth into all the land.”**

And I pointed out yesterday, that the reason Jeremiah includes the false Jewish prophets in that particular verse, is because he is setting up an extrapolation here, so that we can figure out who Wormwood is. This is like solving an algebra problem.

Verse number 11 lists all three categories of false prophets. So does verse 33, 34 and 15, except that in verse 15 where we would ordinarily find “priest”, we find the word “wormwood”, and that's how we can solve the equation that wormwood must be a priest. And we know from the Book of Revelation that Wormwood, that is, the False Prophet is associated with the color red. That means he must be a cardinal. And here from Jeremiah we know that Wormwood is a Catholic priest, and the only false Catholic prophet mentioned in Jeremiah 23.

So let's go over the last four verses of the bottom line.

25. I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, and say: I have dreamed, I have dreamed.  
30. Therefore behold I am against the prophets, saith the Lord: who steal my words every one from his neighbor.  
35. Thus shall you say every one to his neighbor, and to his brother: What hath the Lord answered? and what hath the Lord spoken?  
40. And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame which shall never be forgotten.

25. **“I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, and say: I have dreamed, I have dreamed.”** Because they dream, that refers to the false Jewish prophets, the false rabbis in Israel.

30. **“Therefore behold I am against the prophets,”** prophets without any modifier would be the false Protestant prophets, **“saith the Lord: who steal my words every one from his neighbour.”** And it's interesting to me that that is a characteristic of the false Protestant prophets; for example that the Whore of Babylon is the Catholic Church. I don't know if Dave Hunt started that or somebody else, but whoever started it, they all run with it. They think that, well if he said it, it's just as good as Gospel, and of course they're all fooled and it's very dangerous.

“My people perish for lack of knowledge”. If you don't know who the Whore of Babylon is, how are you going to be able to go out from her? And John says, you must go out from her, if you want to avoid her plagues, and John mentions all the plagues, which are pretty terrible.

So let's look at the last part of the bottom line, the fifth line. Verse 35: **“Thus shall you say every one to his neighbour, and to his brother: What hath the Lord answered? And what hath the Lord spoken?”** We don't want to know what **you** say. We want to know what the Lord says.

And here we find God's final ultimate punishment on the false prophets, verse number 40. Remember the first verse was, “Woe to the pastors”, and now we find what God is going to do to these false pastors. We've gone through 40 verses and here is the final judgement.

40: **“And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame which shall never be forgotten.”** So what does that mean that this perpetual shame which shall never be forgotten? That can only mean they go to Hell. When God forgives sins, He forgets them. That's the point of this verse. God is not going to forget what these false prophets have done. That means they go to Hell. That's the only way that you can interpret that.

So now I thought we'd go through and look at the punishments, the specific punishments that God mentions in the entire chapter 23 of Jeremiah. And here are the first five punishments and we find them in verses 2, 12, 19, 29 and 34.

**2 behold I will visit upon you for the evil of your doings, saith the Lord.**

**12. Therefore their way shall be as a slippery way in the dark: for they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evils upon them, the year of their visitation, saith the Lord.**

**19. Behold the whirlwind of the Lord's indignation shall come forth, and a tempest shall break out and come upon the head of the wicked.**

**29. Are not my words as a fire, saith the Lord: and as a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?**

**34. And as for the prophet, and the priest, and the people that shall say: The burden of the Lord: I will visit upon that man, and upon his house.**

2. **“Behold I will visit upon you for the evil of your doings”**. So God is going to visit upon the false prophets for the evil of their doings. Verse 12: **“Therefore their way shall be a slippery way.”** I should count these. I think that's the second punishment; **“for they shall be driven on”**, that's third; **“and fall therein”**, that's four; **“for I will bring evils upon them, the year of their visitation, saith the Lord.”** I think that would be count 5.

The year of their visitation is a very scary prophecy, because that means there is a particular pin point in time when these punishments are going to come upon the false prophets. And in Daniel 9 verse 27 I believe it is, the end comes upon Israel like a flood. It's going to be sudden, and Natan says the same thing in his prophecies, and the IDF will be overrun in two days. So let's continue on with the punishments in verse number 19:

**“Behold the whirlwind of the Lords indignation shall come forth, and a tempest shall break out and come upon the head of the wicked.”** Now that is a pretty good explanation of the year of their visitation. Notice that verse 19 follows verse 12 in this new arrangement and explains that.

Verse 29: **“Are not my words as a fire, saith the Lord and as a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?”**

So there's two more. Let me see, we're up to 7 different evils that will befall the false prophets, and verse 34:

**“And as for the prophet, and the priest, and the people”**, again notice all three categories of false prophets here. **“that shall say: The burden of the Lord: I will visit upon that man, and upon his house.”** The Lord is going to visit punishments upon the false prophets.

39. Therefore behold I will take you away carrying you, and will forsake you, and the city which I gave to you, and to your fathers, out of my presence.

15. Therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts to the prophets: Behold I will feed them with wormwood, and will give them gall to drink: for from the prophets of Jerusalem corruption has gone forth into all the land.

20. The wrath of the Lord shall not return till he execute it, and till he accomplish the thought of his heart: in the latter days you shall understand his counsel.

40. And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame which shall never be forgotten.

Verse 39: **“Therefore behold”**, here's another punishment, **“I will take you away carrying you, and will forsake you, and the city which I gave to you, and to your fathers, out of my presence.”**

I'm not sure exactly which city this is. In the End Times, the holy city is Rome and the great city is Jerusalem, just the reverse of in John's time. Nobody understood that they still don't. Most people in the Catholic Church don't understand that, but the holy city which is trampled underfoot for 42 months refers to Rome, the same as Mary when she says Rome will lose the faith and become the seat of the Antichrist. So whether this city is Rome that Jeremiah is prophesying about or Jerusalem I'm not quite sure.

Verse 15: **“Behold I will feed them wormwood.”** That's another punishment, **“and will give them gall to drink”**, another punishment, **“for from the prophets of Jerusalem..”** etc.

Now verse number 20: **“The wrath of the Lord shall not return till he execute it, and till he accomplish the thought of his heart: in the latter days you shall understand his counsel.”**

So that's a pretty clear explanation that this prophecy of Jeremiah 23 is for the latter days. And how are we going to understand the counsel? Because the prophecy is sealed up, as found in your scriptures. The only way is for a co-prophet such as myself to interpret it **after** the prophecy is unsealed, and this prophecy was not unsealed until 2016. Obviously we are at the very end. We are in the latter days, and God says it will be at that time that it will be revealed. And let me go back to the punishment verses. **“You shall understand his counsel.”** That is when we will understand it, and John says in the Book of Revelation, you need wisdom and understanding, not just wisdom, but you need understanding as well. And the only way we can understand Jeremiah 23 is through his cryptogram.

Verse number 40: **“And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame which will never be forgotten.”** So there are two more categories of punishment and I have not gone through and listed all the punishments. I think I counted them once I think there are 12 different punishments that will come upon the false prophets of these End Times, and of course the worst one is, that they will go to Hell.

And Zachariah says the false prophets will be killed by their own families and that is going to happen. I know the false prophets probably say, “It doesn't matter if I say that the Whore of Babylon is the Catholic Church. What difference does that make?” Well it makes a big difference, because it means that the people you convinced of that, they are not going to be prepared. They will think that because they are not in the Catholic Church, they won't receive the plagues, and when they start receiving the plagues, they will be very angry and upset at the false prophets, who did not

warn them. They thought that they were safe not being Catholic. And Jeremiah and Zechariah saying, when they found out that they have been deceived by the false prophets, as the Bible says, "My people perish for lack of knowledge", and this channel is telling you the truth. The Whore of Babylon is primarily the United States and Britain. We are the Whore of Babylon, and the Scarlet Beast that we sit upon represents international Communism, and we will be burned with fire in one hour by the Scarlet Beast.

And the final One World system will evolve after that destruction, and that will be the eighth and final beast the Scarlet Beast, also known as the fourth beast in Daniel. And Jesus Himself will destroy that with his weapon which is Mary's Rosary, and that's why I call this program Mary's School of Prophecy.

Some people think that World War 3 will not come until there is a great warning, that God will warn us before World War 3, and I don't believe that. He has already given us enough warnings. I think World War 3 will break out and the warning will be that mankind has to stop World War 3.
