

Daniel Unsealed, Chapter 8, Defeat of the Antichrist

This is the second program in my series on the unsealing of the prophecies of Daniel, and that is his last six chapters which are the vision chapters. And we've already looked at chapter number 7 and today we're going to unseal the prophecies of Daniel chapter number 8. And I am doing this on my new website, thirdeaglemedia.com where you can download the file so that you can actually unseal the prophecies yourself.

And I used to think I could do all of my co-prophecies on YouTube, but in Matthew 24, Jesus said you must read and understand Daniel, and that 'reading' part you cannot do with my videos. And by the way, that also indicates that his prophecy was for the End Times because at the time Jesus was addressing the crowds, very few of them could read. And in fact, it wasn't until our own End Times that the majority of people could read and therefore, Jesus' prophecy is for you and me in the these End Times.

And in fact, the angel tells Daniel that his prophecies are sealed up until the time of the End, and the only way you can understand the prophecies is to unseal them. And please, don't listen to the false prophets who try to tell you they can explain Daniel to you. They cannot do that because they do not know how Daniel sealed up his prophecies; and here is how he did it for his chapter number 8. First, you need to go to my new thirdeaglemedia.com website and under 'Daniel Unsealed', chapter number 8, download page 2 and 3 and attach them together. Now you can use a blue tape, but I did that for demonstration purposes, cellophane tape is better. And once you have attached the two pages together, be sure to mount them on a piece of cardboard. I use simple grocery store cardboard for backing and that firms up the two sheets of paper.

Now, let's take a closer look at how Daniel sealed up the prophecies in Chapter number 8. There are 27 verses in Daniel, chapter number 8, and he sealed up his prophecy by means of a hidden chiasm. That means verses 1 through 13 should be placed on the left side, and on the right side, verses 15 through 27 in reverse sequence. And at the bottom is verse number 14 which is a bridge verse between verse 13 on the bottom left and verse 15 on the bottom right. And we know this is how Daniel wanted these verses to be arranged so that we can understand the prophecy, by having certain words repeat themselves;

for example, in verses 1 and 2, the word is 'vision.' He uses the word 'vision' once in verse 1 and twice in verse number 2, and he repeats the same pattern in verses 27 and 26. The word 'vision' is used once in verse 27 and twice in verse 26. This is how Daniel lets us know these verses are meant to be lined up opposite each other.

Daniel still must provide more verification because among other possibilities you could arrange the 27 verses into three sets of 9 verses each; therefore he also verifies that 11, 12 and 13 on the left are associated with verses 17, 16 and 15 on the right. And he does this again through repetition of various words. In this case, 'strength' and 'continual sacrifice' are repeated in verses 11 and 12, but in verse 13 that pattern is reversed: 'continual sacrifice' and 'strength.' And he follows the same pattern in verses 17, 16, and 15. The words 'man' and 'vision' are repeated in verses 16 and 17 but reversed in verse 15, 'vision' and 'man.' And since the last three verses on the left side correlate to the last 3 verses on the right side, therefore we know this is the only way the chiasm can be arranged in Daniel chapter number 8.

In addition to arranging these verses according to a hidden chiasm, Daniel divides them into separate groupings according to subject matter. In other words, verses 1 and 2 and 27 and 26 are introductory and closing verses of the chapter. Then we have six verses, that is 3-8, which describe the Ram-Goat War. And then we have 5 verses, 9 through 13, which describe the Antichrist. Now I've used color coding here because he repeats some of these topics on the right hand side, and I've used blue to indicate the Ram-Goat War, green to indicate the Antichrist, and red to indicate the opening and closing verses.

Please remember, this color coding and the underlining of various words are not meant to aid the prophecy but rather simply here to show you how Daniel arranged this structure. And now the fourth color coding are these five verses which describe the conversation between the angel and Daniel and I have these printed in black. And so, on the right side we see a similar pattern to that on the left, two verses at top, three verses which describe the Antichrist combined with three verses which describe the Ram-Goat War for a total of six, and then five verses as I say, a conversation between the angel and Daniel.

And the meaning of this verse structure, as we will find in all of Daniel's vision chapters, is that the Antichrist will be defeated by Mary's Rosary.

First of all, we have two verses on each side which add up to 4, or in this case, it could be 2 plus 2 which indicates humanity, followed by 6 verses on the left and 6 verses on the right and of course 66 refers to the Antichrist, and they are followed by and therefore defeated by 5 verses on the bottom left and 5 verses on the bottom right and of course 55 indicates Mary's Rosary. The single verse at the bottom, the bridge verse, verse number 14, which gives the timing of the events and which follows the reign of the Antichrist, symbolizes the Millennium or the one thousand years of peace.

In addition to the verse structure having meaning itself, there is a great deal of emphasis on the bottom verse number 14 which is the hinge verse between the left side and the right side of the chiasm. And verse number 14 reads: **'And he said to him: unto evening and morning 2300 days and the sanctuary will be cleansed.'** Not only is it important because the verse gives the timing of this particular Abomination of Desolation, but the number 23 is another number of the Antichrist; and that is one reason we know that chapter number 8 is about the Antichrist. 23, as I have said many times, symbolizes two over three, in other words, man over God and two-thirds equals the decimal .666 which is the number of the Antichrist.

I believe the reason no Hebrew or Christian Bible scholar has ever been able to unseal Daniel is because it was not necessary until now in these End Times. Now we know, for example, that there are 4 different Abominations of Desolation; they affect 4 different groups; they are instigated by 4 different individuals, and in Chapter number 8, we now know that the Antichrist is the one who instigates this particular Abomination of Desolation and his victims are the holy martyrs. And I have explained that on other videos.

All I wanted to do on this program is to explain Daniel's hidden structure and how he sealed up the prophecies. So, be sure to go to my thirdeaglemedia.com website and you can download those two pages, connect them together, put them on a firm background, and then you can study how Daniel sealed up all his prophecies and you can understand them to your satisfaction much better. In fact, it's impossible to understand Daniel as printed in your Bibles because they are sealed up as the angel told Daniel.
