

Where is the Abraham Accord Found in Bible Prophecy?

Welcome to Revelation Unraveled. I'm your host William Tapley. This week there was a very significant development in the Middle East peace process and that was when Donald Trump announced a peace treaty between the United Arab Emirates and Israel. And I knew I had to do a video on that because the false prophets are out in force misinterpreting Bible prophecy and assigning this peace treaty to the wrong place in Daniel chapter number 9. And I checked out videos by Irvin Baxter, Steve Cioccolanti and John Hagee. They all commented on it, but they are all restricted by a false interpretation of Daniel 9, because they believe the Antichrist signs a peace treaty with Israel, and they all have been teaching that for many years. I mean Irvin Baxter has been on shortwave radio for at least 25 years teaching that the Antichrist signs a peace treaty with Israel, and that's because they don't understand how to interpret the great prophet Daniel.

As with all End Times prophecies, you must unseal the prophecy before you can interpret it. The angel told Daniel to seal up his prophecies. In other words you cannot understand the prophecy as printed in your Bibles, and Daniel chapter 9 is all about Israel. So when anything happens with Israel in these End Times, you always have to check and see; is that found in Daniel chapter number 9? And I have done many, many videos on Daniel 9 since I came on YouTube over 12 years ago. And the main error the false prophets make is they assume that Daniel 9 is in chronological order, and the two most important verses, Daniel 9:26 and 9:27, they assume follow one after the other, and that is false. If you understand how Daniel sealed up the prophecy, then you know that Daniel 9:26 and 9:27 tell the same story. And we can look at both the near time fulfillment of the prophecy, which was about Jesus Himself, and that is a great fulfilment of the prophecy. It shows that Daniel was a great prophet, just by that fact alone, but it also shows in the End Times that the fulfillment will occur just as it occurred in the near time.

So let's take a look at Daniel chapter number 9 verses 26 and 27, and I have colour coded these verses so you can see that each verse is divided into four sections, four main actions, and those four actions relate to each other.

In other words don't look at the actions in Daniel 9:27 as following 9:26 chronologically because actually they tell the same story, and they are about a good guy, who in the near time fulfillment was Jesus, and a bad guy who in the near time fulfillment was the Roman General Titus, who destroyed Jerusalem in 70 AD.

So let's go through these verses, and we can get an idea of what the End Times fulfillment will be like if we look at the near time fulfillment. The near time meaning near to Daniel's time, and I have adjusted these a little bit. So let's read them the way I've got the lettering. In other words, I believe there is a chronological sequence if you read it the way I have put the letters.

In other words the first part should read, ***“And he shall confirm the covenant with many in one week”***. That would be part A of Daniel 9:27.

The “he” refers to our Lord Jesus Christ. He confirmed the covenant with many for one week and that refers to Jesus’s short ministry and the covenant He confirmed was the Messianic Covenant, in other words, a promise by God to send a Saviour to the Jewish people into the world at large. And the first part of Daniel 9:26 also tells about Jesus. It doesn't precede Daniel 9:27 or follow it, although I think in this case you could say it follows it a little better.

Part B: ***“And after sixty-two weeks”***; this refers to the time span of Jesus’s ministry, ***“the Anointed One”***, that was Jesus Himself, ***“shall be cut off but not for himself.”***

And of course being cut off for Jesus referred to his crucifixion and He was not cut off for Himself but for all of mankind. He is the Saviour. He died for our sins. Now in the End Times, this good person, this first person spoken about must be someone who was contemporary, probably in Israel, and I have said for a long time I believe that the anointed one is Benjamin Netanyahu, the prime minister of Israel, and “anointed” does not necessarily mean that he's divine. It simply means that he has a divine mission, and all leaders of the world have a divine mission to one degree or another, because they are appointed by God.

All leaders are appointed by Almighty God, all national leaders and certainly Benjamin Netanyahu has a divine appointment if he is fulfilling Daniel 9:26 and 9:27 and I think he will be cut off. I think he will be martyred, but the covenant that he is confirming is not the Messianic Covenant of course because he's not the Messiah. I believe the covenant that he is confirming is the Abrahamic Covenant wherein God promised the land of Canaan to the Jews in perpetuity, and I believe this Abraham Accord which Donald Trump announced is part of this confirming of the covenant.

It is not between the Antichrist and Israel. Please don't listen to the false prophets when they give false prophecy like that. It has consequences. The Bible says that my people perish for lack of knowledge and if you don't understand Daniel 9:26 and 9:27 especially you people in Israel, you won't know what's coming next,

because what's coming next is the bad guy. So let's read part C and D of Daniel 9:26 and 27.

“And a people of the prince who shall come, shall destroy the city, and the sanctuary”.

That amazing prophecy of Daniel was fulfilled 70 years after Christ when the Roman General Titus destroyed Jerusalem. And part D of Daniel 9:27.

“And in the midst of the weak he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease.”

And of course Titus did that. He stopped the Jewish sacrifice in the temple. That is not necessarily the same week as the week in A, the first sentence part of Daniel 9:27. In fact I believe they are two different weeks. They don't have to be the same week. And notice that Jesus the Messiah or in the End Times, Benjamin Netanyahu or someone else, I'm not sure, the Anointed One. He does one thing. That's because he represents the divine. He is either cut off or he confirms the covenant. Notice that the bad guy Titus, and in the End Times, we'll discuss that in a moment, does two things. He destroys the city and the sanctuary and he causes the sacrifice and the oblation to cease. That's because he represents the forces of mankind in these End Times.

I have always suggested that this bad guy in Daniel 9:26 and 28 is Vladimir Putin. Now I don't know that for sure. It could be the leader of Iran. It could be some other world leader. It could be the leader of Turkey for example, and I've never said definitively, but it's someone like that, and that is next on the horizon for Israel, because the One World people, the Democrats, the Liberals, the Scarlet Beast whatever you want to call them, they do not want peace in the Middle East. What Donald Trump did by brokering this peace deal, he did not make the Democrats happy at all. In fact I don't think you'll ever hear any Democrat come out in support of this Abrahamic Accord. They don't want peace in the Middle East. Look at Obama's record. Did he ever do anything for peace in the Middle East? I don't think so.

So continuing on with Daniel 9:26 and 27 with a true and accurate interpretation because, as I say, these two verses tell the same story. And after the bad guy destroys the city and the sanctuary and causes the sacrifice and the oblation to cease in the End Times, Israel will be ruled by her enemies, and that's because they have abandoned the law of God, and therefore God will confirm His covenant and that agreement is that if they do not follow the Ten Commandments, then they will be ruled by their enemies. And that is about to happen to Israel unless they repent. They have to repent just like every nation in the west must repent.

Let's look at E. ***“And there shall be in the temple the abomination of desolation”.***

Temple in this case refers to Judaism. I don't believe there is any specific temple it refers to. Some of the false prophets say there will be a third temple rebuilt in

Jerusalem. Please don't wait for that. Please don't wait for the Antichrist. These prophecies can be fulfilled any anytime. The prince that shall come; he does not have to wait for the Antichrist confirming a covenant. This covenant has already been confirmed and is being confirmed by Netanyahu and President Trump. They are confirming the covenant, the Abrahamic covenant, and it's no accident that this accord was called the Abraham Accord.

Let's look at F. ***“And the end thereof shall be with a flood.”*** That means the destruction that is about to come upon Israel will be severe, sudden and overwhelming.

And let's look at the bottom line. ***“And after the end of the war”, this is World War 3 in the End Times, “the appointed desolation, and the desolation shall continue even to the consummation and to the end.”***

So this is the abomination of desolation which Jesus warned about, as it affects Israel. As you know if you've watched my videos at all for the last 12 years you know there are four different abominations of desolation in Daniel. One of them affects the nation of Israel. That's this one in Daniel 9. The first one has already occurred; the abomination of desolation as it affects the Catholic Church, and that's when Pope Francis took the daily sacrifice away from the prince, in other words when he invalidated the sacrifice of the Mass, the daily sacrifice when the Body and Blood of our Lord are consecrated by priests. That is no longer possible in many churches, unless your priest or bishop denounces Pope Francis and I don't see that happening in most places. And the only reason I mentioned that, it doesn't really affect the Abraham Accord that we're talking about today, but I mentioned it because that comes first in the chronology and I told you this many, many years ago here.

The second abomination of desolation is about to occur to Israel and that is when the prince who shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary and that comes next. And none of these false prophets who have been commenting on President Trump or the Abraham Accord are warning you, but that's the job of a true prophet or a true co-prophet, and that is to say, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth and that's my job and I am fulfilling my job.
