

President Obama Meets With Pope Francis

This will be just a brief commentary on President Barack Obama visiting Pope Francis at the Vatican on Thursday. And as far as Bible Prophecy goes, our main concern should be: is Pope Francis the False Prophet? And if so, what will they discuss? Now I have not made a determination whether he is a False Prophet or not. He would have to fulfill quite a few particular Bible prophecies to qualify and he has not fulfilled any of them, however, this meeting with Barack Obama may give him the first opportunity.

As I have said previously on this program, I thought his first opportunity would be to take the Daily Sacrifice away from the Prince as proposed by Daniel and described in his chapter 10, verse number 3. Daniel says, ***'I ate no desirable bread and neither flesh nor wine entered into my mouth.'*** That is a description of the Eucharist and in these End Times the False Prophet will take that away from the Prince who is Jesus Christ.

At this month's meeting of the German Bishops, Cardinal Walter Kasper proposed exactly that: he said that the Holy Eucharist should be given to divorced and remarried Catholics. That would reduce the Sacrament to a sacramental, and that meeting has come and gone and I have not heard a thing about it. Maybe some of you in my audience could clue me in. How did they vote? For some reason or other, this has been kept a big secret. Will they suddenly pop that surprise on us on April 13th, which is Palm Sunday, and the date I been giving as the very likely start of the Great Tribulation. If Pope Francis approves giving Communion to divorced and remarried Catholics, that would fulfill Bible prophecy, and in my mind, that would mark him as the False Prophet (1).

However, there is one more very important prophecy about the False Prophet: he will cause everyone to take the Mark of the Beast. Some people think the Antichrist causes everyone to take the mark but, if you check Bible prophecy, you will see that it is the False Prophet. And that is where Barack Obama's meeting with Pope Francis this week may come into play because Obamacare includes an RFID chip which certainly is one form of the Mark of the Beast.

The American Catholic Bishops do not oppose Obamacare on that ground; they oppose it because it forces Catholics to pay for

contraception, sterilization, and abortion drugs. Those are all moral evils, however, if President Obama can somehow convince Pope Francis to call off the American Bishops, maybe he'll offer them some kind of a deal. *'Maybe I'll give you all kinds of money grants that will more than make up for what it would cost you to pay for contraceptive, sterilization and abortion coverage'*. And maybe Pope Francis will tell the American Bishops to lay off Obamacare and retract all of those lawsuits.

If he does that, the RFID chip would have smooth sailing because the American Catholic Bishops really don't have a clue as far as Bible Prophecy goes. I mean, I applaud their opposition to contraception, sterilization and abortion drugs, none of which are healthcare, and all of which actually harm the health of women and of course they are all moral evils.

So I am asking you my subscribers to keep your eyes and ears open because if the Pope and the President do reach some kind of accord on Obamacare, I doubt if they will make a big noise about it. They will keep it secret and the American Bishop's opposition will kind of melt away. But that would be another very good indication that Pope Francis is the False Prophet.

On the other hand, if he sticks to his guns it could well be that Pope Francis is actually Petrus Romanus, a good Pope, one who will feed his flock during the Great Tribulation.
